### Yardage & Cutting, cont:

- Twirling Leaves White on White-16328-09 1-3/8 yds  
Cut (9) 6-7/8" squares  
(144) 2-7/8" squares
- Daisy Scroll Royal - 16327-56 1/2 yd  
Cut (9) 6-7/8" squares
- All About Daisies Med Blue - 16325-52 1 yd  
Cut (9) 10-7/8" squares
- Twirling Leaves Lt Blue -16328-05 1 yd  
Cut (9) 10-7/8" squares
- All About Daisies Stripe - 16326-55 2-1/2 yds  
(includes Binding)  
Cut (4) 6-1/2" VERTICAL strips  
centering motif  
Cut (4) 2-1/2" VERTICAL strips of White  
for binding
- Backing 5-1/8 yds

Binding Miter Tool

### Construction:

This project uses precise 1/4" seams. To test your seam allowance, accurately cut (2) 1-1/2" x 3" rectangles. Stitch them together along the 3" length. Measure across the unit. It should be exactly 2-1/2" wide. If not, adjust your seam and repeat.

- Place (1) Yellow or Green 2-7/8" square right sides together with the same size Twirling Leaves White on White square. Draw a diagonal line. Stitch an accurate 1/4" on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the diagonal line to make two half square triangles. Press gently. They measure 2-1/2" square. Use all of the 2-7/8" squares. Make the quantity indicated below each.



### Yardage & Cutting:

Number in parenthesis is the quantity to cut

- Twirling Leaves Lt Yellow - 16328-03 1/4 yd  
Cut (27) 2-7/8" squares
- Tartan Plaid Lemon - 16329-31 1/4 yd  
Cut(27) 2-7/8" squares
- Dancing Scroll Yellow - 16350-33 1/4 yd  
Cut (27) 2-7/8" squares
- Tartan Plaid Leaf - 16329-41 1/4 yd  
Cut (27) 2-7/8" squares
- Dancing Scroll Green - 16350-44 3/8 yd  
Cut (36) 2-7/8" squares



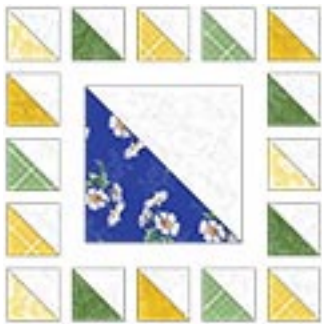
2. Repeat Step 1 using (9) 6-7/8" squares each of Twirling Leaves White on White and Daisy Scroll Royal to make (18) blocks. They measure 6-1/2" square.



3. Repeat Step 1 using (9) 10-7/8" squares each of All About Daisies Med Blue and Twirling Leaves Lt Blue to make (17) blocks. They measure 10-1/2" square.



4. Surround each of the (18) Step 2 6-1/2" triangles with 2-1/2" triangles from Step 1, with color placement as shown. Press gently. These blocks measure 10-1/2" square from raw edge to raw edge.



5. Lay out the blocks and stitch your quilt together.

6. Center and stitch the All About Daisies Stripe Borders to the quilt, starting and stopping the stitching at the 1/4" seam allowance at each corner. There should be at least 7" of border extending beyond the stitching at each corner.

7. To miter these corners, direct the seams toward the borders. Place a corner on the ironing board so the horizontal border is across the board and the vertical border is on top, and extending upwards.



8. Fold the vertical border under and diagonally from the point where the stitching ended. It will be lying right sides together on top of the horizontal border. Use a ruler if you need to check that it's a 45° angle. Once you are satisfied, smash the fold with a hot iron.

9. Making certain that nothing shifts, stitch in the crease of folded border, from the 1/4" seam allowance to the outer corner, without stitching through any seam allowances. When you are satisfied, trim the excess to about 1/4" and press these seams open.

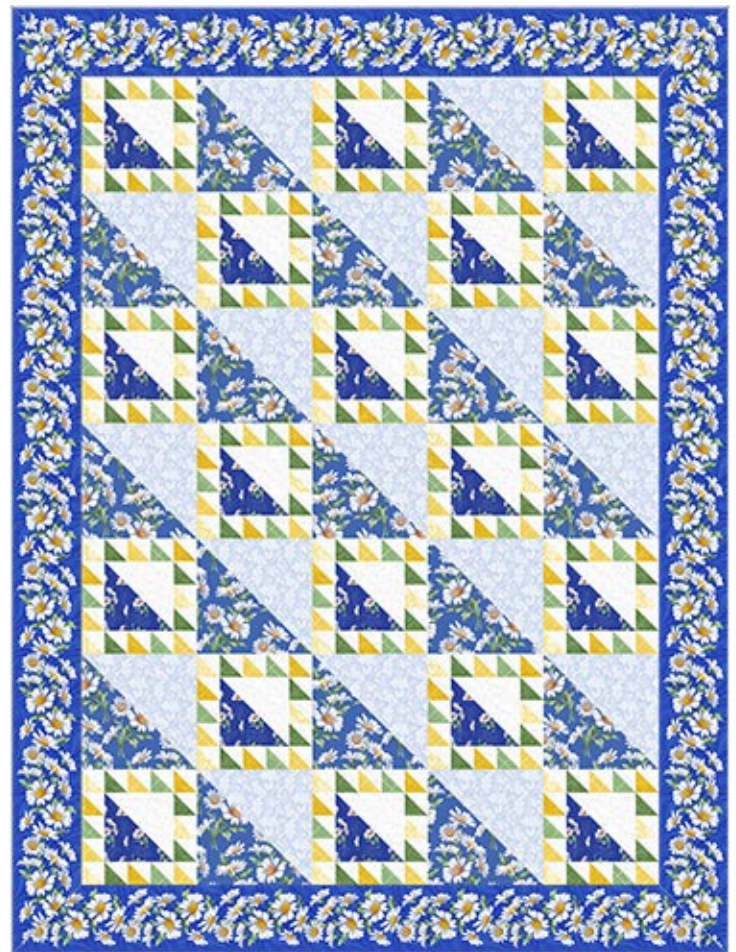


10. After careful pressing, prepare to quilt your masterpiece. Choose a pleasant allover quilting pattern or outline and detail the shapes.

11. Bind and miter the corners with the 2-1/2" Binding strips, following the directions with the Binding Miter Tool from Animas.
