### Fabric Requirements

Fabric 3:	½ yd	Pink Tossed Pandas SB20427-520	Soft Green Tossed Pandas SB20427-835
Fabric 4:	½ yd	White Irregular Dot SB20171-100	White/Lilac Squiggle SB20053-106
Fabric 5:	½ yd	Pink Squiggle SB20053-520	Pink Hearts & Bees SB20208-520
Binding:	½ yd	White Freehand Stripe SB20105-100	Pink Susy Bees SB20197-520

### Cutting

WOF = width of fabric • HST= half square triangle • All seams ¼"

Center: Fabric 1 (panel) — Square and trim to 34 ½" x 42 ½"

Pieced Border Blocks:

Fabric 2 — (4) 3 ½" x WOF

Subcut (40) 3 ½" x 3 ½" squares Cut each diagonally for (80) A triangles

Fabric 3 — (4) 4" x WOF

Subcut (38) 4" x 4", B squares


Fabric 4 — (3) 3 ½" x WOF

Subcut (36) 3 ½" x 3 ½" squares Cut diagonally for (72) A triangles

#### Center Sashing:

Fabric 5 — (2) 2" x 34  $\frac{1}{2}$ " for top and bottom sashing of panel

— (3) 3 ½" x WOF, trim selvages, stitch short ends together, and subcut into (2) 3 ½" x 45 ½" for right and left sashing



#### Sashing

- 1. Stitch 2" x 34 ½" Fabric 5 sashing strips to top and bottom of panel.
- Stitch 3 ½" x 45 ½" Fabric 5 sashing strips to sides of panel.







Pieced Border Blocks

Use A triangles and B squares. Make (4) corner blocks and (34) side blocks referring to the diagrams below.



Version A

Stitch 2 triangle A pieces to opposite sides of square B



Stitch remaining triangle A pieces to center square Finished block size: 5 1/2"

To easily center triangles on the square:

- 1. Fold square in half right sides together. Crease on all 4 edges.
- 2. Fold each triangle in half wrong sides together and crease.
- 3. Match creases and pin, then sew.

#### Assemble Pieced Border


Stitch blocks together to form pieced border.

Top & bottom borders: (8) blocks

Side borders: (9) blocks plus (2) corner blocks

## Final Assembly

- 1. Stitch top and bottom pieced borders to sashed center panel, followed by side pieced borders.
- 2. Layer quilt top with batting and backing.
- 3. Quilt as desired.

- 4. Square quilt.
- 5. To prepare binding, trim selvages from binding strips and stitch together on short ends.
- 6. Bind as usual.
