## Peach Whispers by Beth Grove



Throw Quilt 57" x 70"



Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning. WOF = width of fabric. All instructions include a 1/4'' seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

#### 1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

**Fabric A** - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (4) 5-1/2" x 34" wide floral stripe borders. Sew 2 strips together matching print as much as possible, cut into (1) 5-1/2" x 54-1/2" border. Repeat to make a second border.

**Fabric B** - Cut (2) 5-1/2" strips, subcut (8) 5-1/2" squares

Fabrics C and D - From each fabric: Cut (2) 9-3/4" strips, subcut (8) 9-3/4" squares

**Fabrics E and F** - From each fabric:

Cut (1) 5-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 5-1/2" squares and (4) 5-3/8" squares

Cut (2) 5-3/8" strips, subcut (12) 5-3/8" squares

Cut (1) 3-1/4" strip, subcut (12) 3-1/4" squares

Cut (4) 2-3/4" strips, from 1 strip cut

(1) 2-3/4" x 21" strip

**Fabric G** - Cut (4) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (48) 2-3/4" squares

Fabric H - Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

**Fabric I** - Cut (3) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (32) 2-3/4" squares

Cut (3) 2-3/4" strips, from 1 strip cut (2) 2-3/4" x 21" strips

**Fabric J** - Cut (2) 3-1/4" strips, subcut (24) 3-1/4" squares

Cut (3) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (32) 2-3/4" squares

Cut (4) 2-3/4" strips

Cut (9) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 67-1/2",

(2) 2-1/2" x 57-1/2", and

(2) 2-1/2" x 54-1/2" borders

#### 2. Piecing Order:

1. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of:



all **Fabrics I** and **J** 2-3/4" squares

2. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side then draw 2 lines 1/4" on each side of first line on the following squares:



all **Fabric B** 5-1/2" squares all **Fabrics E** and **F** 3-1/4" squares

3. Arrange a marked **Fabric B** 5-1/2" square right sides together with a **Fabric E** 5-1/2" square aligning all edges. Stitch along the 2 outside lines. Cut along the center line. Press the 2 triangle sets open. Centering seam, trim each to 5" square. Make a total of 8 Unit 1a. In the same manner, make 8 Unit 1b with fabrics indicated.











Repeat 4 times for 8 units.

4. Arrange a marked **Fabric E** 3-1/4" square right sides together with a **Fabric J** 3-1/4" square aligning all edges. Stitch along the 2 outside lines. Cut along the center line. Press the 2 triangle sets open. Centering seam, trim each to 2-3/4" square. Make a total of 24 Unit 2a. In the same manner, make 24 Unit 2b with fabrics indicated.












Repeat 12 times for 24 units.



5. Arrange 2 **Fabric G** 2-3/4" squares, 1 Unit 2a, and 1 Unit 2b in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 24 Unit 3 (5" square unfinished).




Unit 3 - Make 24

6. Sew 1 each **Fabrics E** and **I** 2-3/4" x WOF strips together lengthwise. Make a 21" strip set. From these, cut (16) 2-3/4" wide Unit 4a (2-3/4" x 5" unfinished). In the same manner, make 1 WOF and (1) 21" **Fabrics F** and **I** 2-3/4" strip set and cut (16) 2-3/4" wide Unit 4b.



7. Sew 1 each **Fabrics E** and **J** 2-3/4" x WOF strips together lengthwise. Make a second WOF strip set. From these, cut (24) 2-3/4" wide Unit 5a (2-3/4" x 5" unfinished). In the same manner, make 2 **Fabrics F** and **J** 2-3/4" strip sets and cut (24) 2-3/4" wide Unit 5b.




8. Stitch 2 Unit 4a together, alternating fabrics. Make a total of 8 Unit 6a (5" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 8 Unit 6b, 12 Unit 6c, and 12 Unit 6d with units indicated.






9. Arrange 2 Unit 3, 1 Unit 6a, and 1 Unit 6b in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 8 **Block 1a** (9-1/2" square unfinished).



10. In the same manner, make 4 each **Blocks 1b, 2a**, and **2b** with units indicated.



11. Mark the 4-7/8" center point on







all sides of a 9-3/4" **Fabric C** square as shown. Draw diagonal lines from mark to mark. Trim corners from square. Repeat for a total of 8 trimmed **C** squares (6-7/8" square unfinished).

Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

12. In the same manner, mark and trim 8 **Fabric D** 9-3/4" squares.



13. Arrange 1 each marked **Fabrics I** and **J** 2-3/4" squares on opposite corners of a **Fabric F** 5-3/8" square as shown. Stitch along





Units 7a and 7b Make 16 each

marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press triangles out. Cut the **Fabric F** square in half diagonally (parallel to the seams) creating 1 each Units 7a and 7b (5-3/8" x 5-3/8" x 7-5/8" unfinished). Make a total of 16 each Units 7a and 7b.

14. In the same manner make 16 each Units 8a and 8b with fabrics indicated.

15. Sew 2 each Units 7a and 7b to edges of a **Fabric D** 6-7/8" square (trimmed in Step 12). Make a total of 2 **Block 3a** (9-1/2" square unfinished).

16. In the same manner, make 2 each **Blocks 3b-3h** with fabrics and units indicated.



- 17. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.
- 18. Arrange blocks in 6 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together completing quilt center (54-1/2" square unfinished).
- 19. Sew **Fabric J** 2" x 54-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center. Add **Fabric A** 5-1/2" x 54-1/2" borders above and below the **J** border.
- 20. Sew **Fabric J** 2" x 67-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric J** 2" x 57-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- 21. The quilt measures approximately 5 7-1/2" x 70-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric K**) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- 22. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric H**) and enjoy!!
