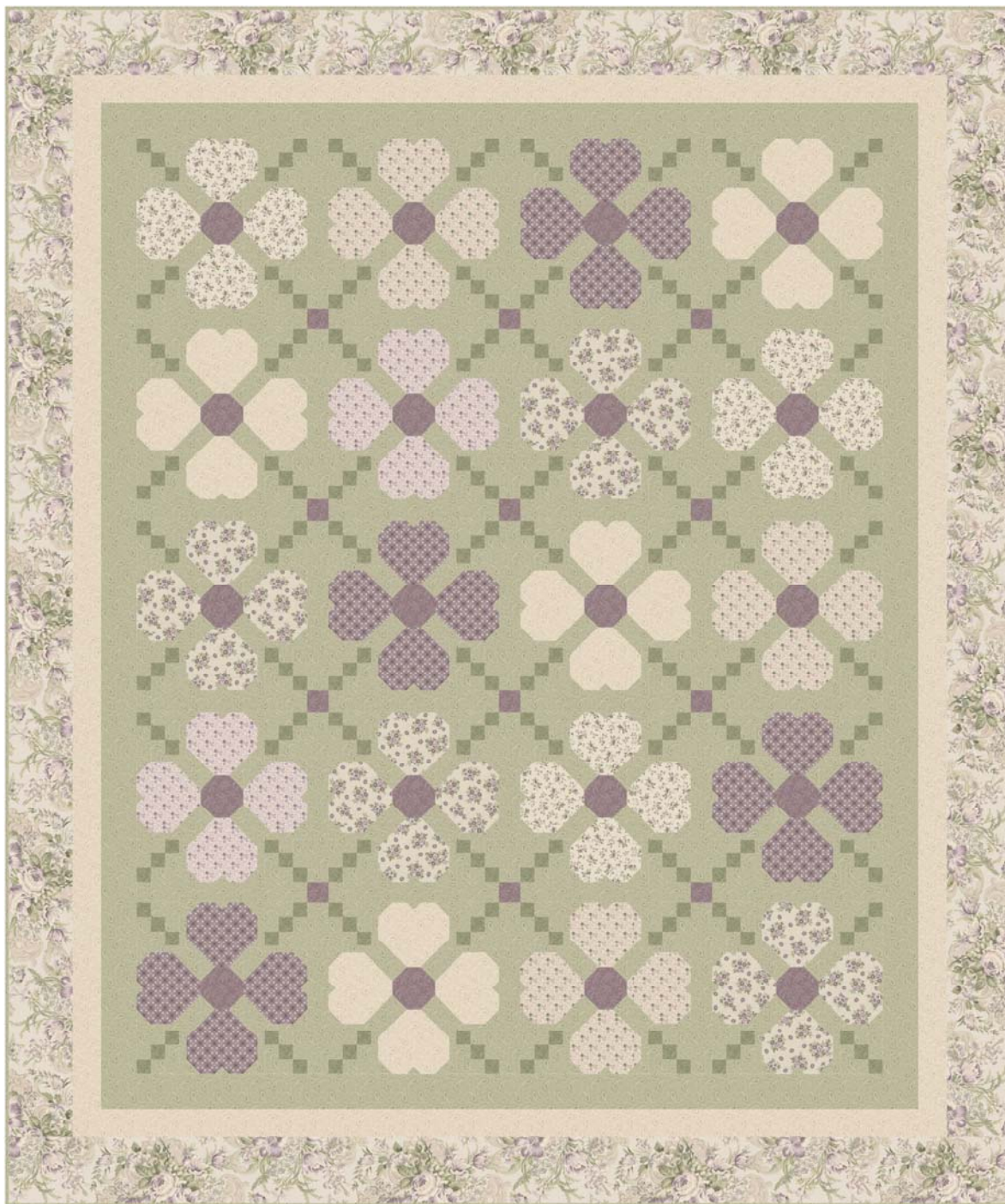

Flower Garden Quilt 1d




Finished quilt size: 70 1/2" x 84"

Finished block size: 12" x 12"

Backing: 78" x 92" (5 1/8y of 42" wide fabric, or 2 1/4y of 108" wide fabric)

 Fabric A R541200D-Cream	1 1/4y	a. Outer border (8) 5" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 5" x 71" and (2) 5" x 75 1/2" strips.
 Fabric B R541201D-Cream  Fabric H R541205D-Cream	1/3y	a. Pieced blocks (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (6) 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles. (1) 4" x WOF strip. Subcut (12) 3" x 4" rectangles. (1) 5" x WOF strip. Subcut (12) 3" x 5" rectangles.
 Fabric C R541202D-Cream  Fabric J R541206D-Purple	1/2y	a. Pieced blocks (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (8) 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles. (1) 4" x WOF strip. Subcut (12) 3" x 4" rectangles. (2) 5" x WOF strips. Subcut (16) 3" x 5" and (4) 3" x 4" rectangles.
 Fabric D R541203D-Green	1/2y	a. Pieced blocks (11) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Reserve for strip piecing.
 Fabric E R541203D-Purple	3/8y	a. Pieced blocks (2) 3 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (20) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares. b. Cornerstones (1) 2" x WOF strip. Subcut (12) 2" x 2" squares.

 <p>Fabric F R541204D-Cream</p>	<p>1 1/8y</p>	<p>a. Pieced blocks (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (8) 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles. (1) 4" x WOF strip. Subcut (12) 3" x 4" rectangles. (2) 5" x WOF strips. Subcut (16) 3" x 5" and (4) 3" x 4" rectangles. b. Inner border #2 (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 2 1/2" x 62" and (2) 2 1/2" x 71 1/2" strips.</p>
 <p>Fabric G R541204D-Sage</p>	<p>4 5/8y, includes binding</p>	<p>a. Pieced blocks (4) 1" x WOF strips. Subcut (160) 1" x 1" squares. (16) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (400) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares. (8) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Reserve for strip piecing. (10) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (160) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares. (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Reserve for strip piecing. (2) 3 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (80) 1" x 3 1/2" rectangles. (2) 4" x WOF strips. Subcut (80) 1" x 4" rectangles. b. Sashing rectangles (1) 12 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (20) 2" x 12 1/2" rectangles. (4) 2" x WOF strips. Subcut (11) 2" x 12 1/2" rectangles. c. Inner border #1 (7) 3" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 3" x 58" and (2) 3" x 66 1/2" strips. d. Binding (9) 2 1/4" x WOF strips. Piece strips to make a binding strip.</p>
 <p>Fabric I R541205D-Lilac</p>	<p>1/4y</p>	<p>a. Pieced blocks (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles. (2) 3" x WOF strips. Subcut (8) 3" x 4" and (8) 3" x 5" rectangles.</p>

Constructing pieced blocks

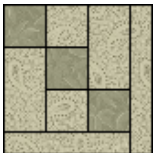
1. Sew together (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric D and (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric G strips, along the long sides, to make a strip set. Make a total of (7) strip sets. Subcut (160) A units at $1\frac{1}{2}$ " intervals for all pieced blocks.



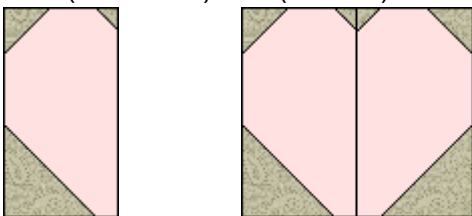
2. Sew together (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric G strips to the opposite long sides of (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric D strip to make a strip set. Make a total of (4) strip sets. Subcut (80) B units at $1\frac{1}{2}$ " intervals for all pieced blocks.



3. Sew (2) step 1 units to the opposite long sides of (1) step 2 unit. Sew (1) 1 " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G rectangle to the right of sewn unit, followed by (1) 1 " x 4 " Fabric G rectangle to the bottom. Unit measures 4 " x 4 " unfinished. Make a total of (4) units.

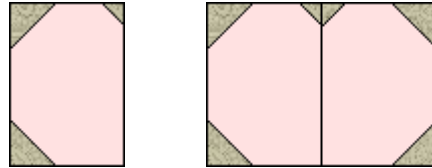


4. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong sides of (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G square. Place square, right sides together, at the top left corner of (1) 3 " x 5 " Print rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with (1) 1 " x 1 " Fabric G square at the top right corner, and (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G square at the bottom left corner of the same Print rectangle. Make a mirror-imaged unit, and sew together both units to make a combined unit. Unit measures $5\frac{1}{2}$ " (horizontal) x 5 " (vertical) unfinished.



Make a total of (2) combined units.

5. Use the same method outlined in step 4 to attach (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G squares to the top and bottom left and (1) 1 " x 1 " Fabric G square to the top right corners of (1) 3 " x 4 " Print rectangle. Make a mirror-imaged unit, and sew together both units to make a combined unit. Unit measures $5\frac{1}{2}$ " (horizontal) x 4 " (vertical).

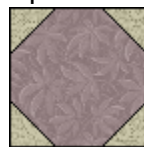


Make a total of (2) combined units.

6. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Print rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with another $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G square at the opposite corner of the same Print rectangle. Make a total of (2) units.



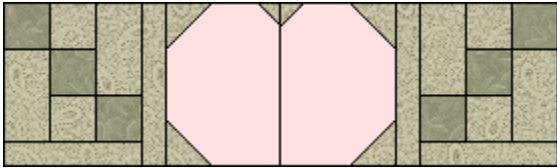
7. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E square. Sew on drawn line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with (3) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G squares at the remaining corners of the same Fabric E square.



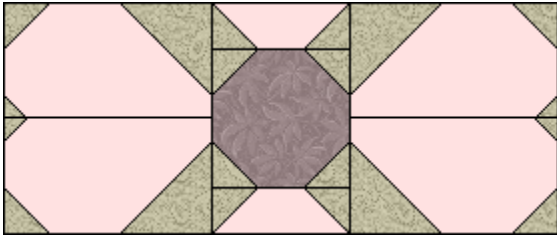
8. Sew (2) step 6 units to the opposite sides of step 7 unit.



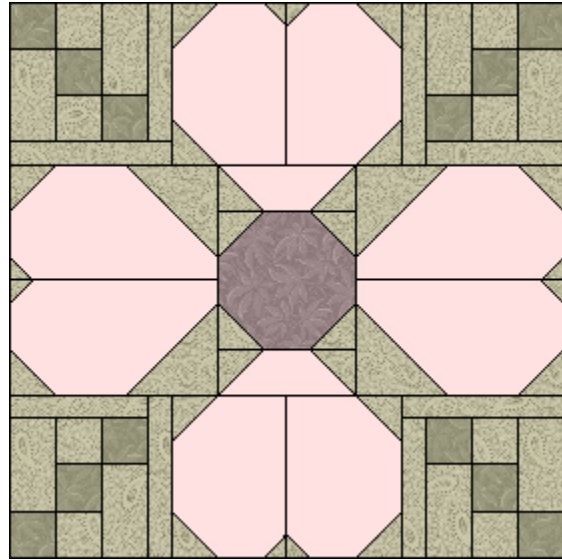
9. Sew (2) step 3 units to the opposite sides of (1) step 5 unit to make a row unit. Make a total of (2) row units.



10. Sew (2) step 4 units to the opposite sides of (1) step 8 unit to make a row unit.



11. Sew together step 9-10 row units to complete (1) pieced block. Block measures 12 1/2" x 12 1/2" unfinished.

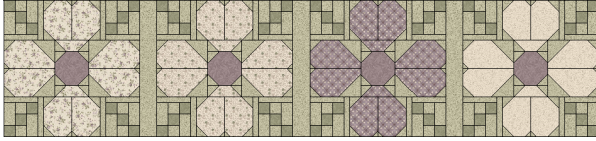


12. Make a total number of blocks for the following Prints:

<p>B 3 blocks</p>	<p>C 4 blocks</p>	<p>F 4 blocks</p>	<p>H 3 block</p>	<p>I 2 blocks</p>	<p>J 4 blocks</p>
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Quilt top assembly

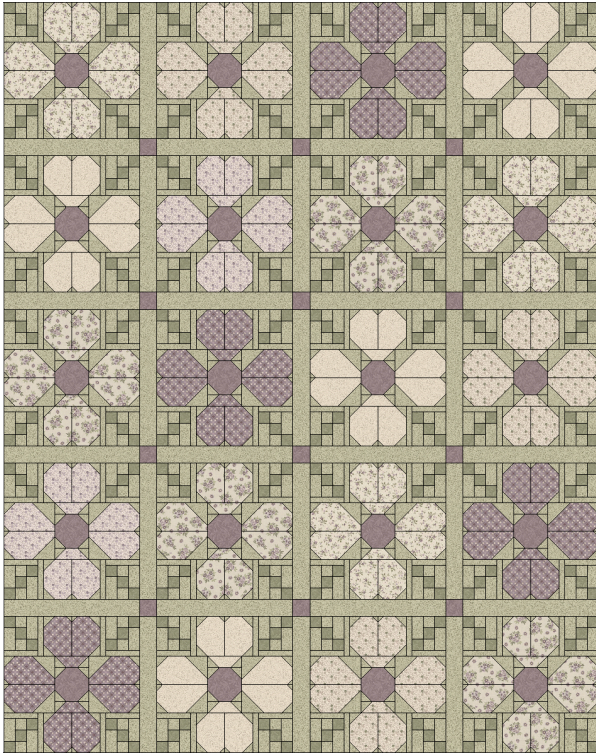
1. Pieced rows. Arrange and sew together (4) pieced blocks, alternating with (3) 2" x 12 1/2" Fabric G rectangles to make a pieced row. Make a total of (5) pieced rows. Row 1 is shown below.



2. Pieced sashing rows. Arrange and sew together (4) 2" x 12 1/2" Fabric G rectangles, alternating with (3) 2" x 2" Fabric E squares, to make a pieced sashing row. Make a total of (4) pieced sashing rows.



3. Quilt center. Sew together pieced rows, alternating with pieced sashing rows, to complete quilt center.

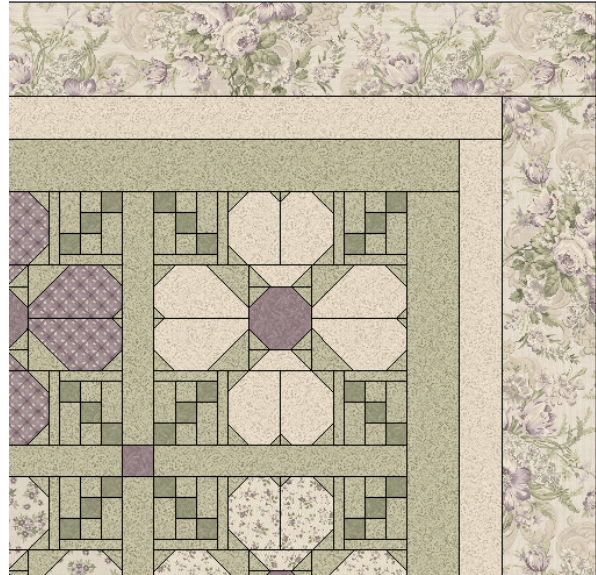


Note: Border strips are sewn longer lengths first to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by shorter strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.

4. Inner border #1. Fabric G.
(2) 3" x 66 1/2" strips, then (2) 3" x 58" strips.

5. Inner border #2. Fabric F.
(2) 2 1/2" x 71 1/2" strips, then (2) 2 1/2" x 62" strips.

6. Outer border. Fabric A.
(2) 5" x 75 1/2" strips, then (2) 5" x 71" strips to complete quilt top.



Finishing

1. Layer backing, batting and quilt top.
2. Baste the layers together. Quilt as desired.
3. Bind to complete the quilt.
