⊁ Fussy cut (16) 3½" x 3½ centers from the Amazing Grace floral fabric for all the block centers.





STEP ONE: MAKE (8) HALF SQUARE TRIANGLES FOUR AT A TIME


- ♥ Use the (2) 8" x 8" squares to make the HST. Refer to the cutting instructions to see which fabrics to use for the HST.
- ♥ Place the light square on top of the darker square right sides together (RST)
- ▼ I use a small OmnigridTM ruler that has a centerline ¼" from both sides of the ruler. Place the ruler diagonally on the **wrong** side of the light fabric and draw a faint line on **each** side of the ruler using a marking pencil or chalk
- ♥ Stitch directly on top of each of the drawn lines



Cut each set of the squares apart **horizontally** and **vertically** as shown. The cuts will be exactly 1/2 the size of the square




X Cut each of the 4 squares **diagonally** between the stitching lines into 2 half-square triangles



- ♥ You will have a total of (8) HST. You will be using (4) HST's in each block.
- Open, and then press toward the dark triangle in the direction of the arrows
- \times Trim the HST to $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ ".

STEP TWO: PUT THE BLOCK TOGETHER USING THE DIAGRAM BELOW

- Stitch the 3½" x ½" rectangles together first. Press in the direction of the arrow.
- Next, stitch the HST to the rectangles. Press in the direction of the arrows.
- Then stitch the rows together and press the seams OPEN.



CUTTING DIRECTIONS FOR THE REST OF THE QUILT

	Cut (1) strip 1½" x WOF	Subcut the strip into (25) 1½" x 1½" squares	For the posts Need (25)
	Cut (5) strips 2½" x WOF	Piece together to make (2) strips 2½" x 41½" for the sides Piece together to make (2) strips 2½" x 45½" for the top & bottom	For the 1 st border
	Cut (5) strips 1½" x WOF	Piece together to make (2) strips 1½" x 45½" for the sides Piece together to make (2) strips 1½" x 47½" for the top and bottom	For plaid inner border
	Cut (5) strips 4½" x WOF	Piece together to make (2) strips 4½" x 47½" for the sides Piece together to make (2) strips 4½" x 55½" for the top and bottom	For the final border

PUTTING THE QUILT TOGETHER

- ▶ Stitch together in rows. Press in the direction of the arrows. The interior of the quilt will measure 41½" x 41½" before the borders are attached.
- ▼ In each 'round' of borders, stitch the sides on first then the top and bottom.
- Press all of the border seams in the direction of the arrows.



▼ The quilt will measure 55½" x 55½".
