This project uses 8 different fabrics for the quilt topper.

Different backing and binding optional.

See chart below for fabric quantities

2¼ yd background fabric

½ yd binding, 3¾ yd backing

Please read instructions carefully before starting the construction of this quilt. If desired, wash and iron your fabrics before starting to cut.

OUILT FACE MATERIALS

Cutting dimensions include 1/4" seam allowances.

 $\frac{1}{2}$ yd each of 8 different printed fabrics (see chart below) 2-13 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares from each fabric

4-34" x 6" strips from FABRIC A. C. F. G (for stems)

4- ¾" x b" strips from FADRIU A, U, F, U (for stems)

From background fabric cut: 32- 4½" squares 16- 4" squares

ASSEMBLY DIRECTIONS

- 1. Place two $13\frac{1}{2}$ " printed fabric squares right sides together. Draw a diagonal line and sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " along each side of the line. Cut along center line and press to make half square triangle blocks. Trim to $12\frac{1}{2}$ " square. [fig 1]
- 2. Cut the 16-4" squares from BACKGROUND FABRIC in half on the diagonal [fig 2]. Sew each $^{3}4$ " x 6" strip FABRIC A, C, F, G to one triangle. Press to the stem. Sew the second triangle to the stem. Press, square up to $3\frac{1}{2}$ ". [fig 2]
- 3. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 41/2" squares. Pin square to each corner of a leaf block that does not have a seam. Sew on the line. [fig 3]
- 4. Pin the $3\frac{1}{2}$ " stem square to one corner with a seam. Sew diagonally, trim the corner and press flat. [fig 3]
- 5. Arrange blocks according to QUILT LAYOUT DIAGRAM. Sew 2½" x 12½" sashing strips between leaf blocks to make rows.
- 6. Sew 54½" x 2½" sashing between rows to complete quilt top.
- 7. Sew $58\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " sashing strip to the left and right sides of quilt top.
- 8. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Baste, quilt and bind.
