BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Refer to **BLOCK DIAGRAMS**

- 1. Sew (2) **H** 2-1/2" squares on opposite ends of (1) **F** 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" rectangle to complete **UNIT 1**, make (26).
- 2. Sew (2) **F** 2-1/2" \times 7-1/2" rectangles on opposite sides of (1) **A** 7-1/2" square to complete **UNIT 2**. Repeat with **B**, **C** and **D** 7-1/2" squares, make (4) each.
- 3. Sew (2) **UNIT 1** to top and bottom of (1) **UNIT 2** to complete **BLOCK 1**, make (1). Repeat with **B**, **C** and **D UNIT 2**, make (4) each **BLOCK 2**, **BLOCK 3** and **BLOCK 4**. Square to 11-1/2".





BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Refer to **BLOCK DIAGRAMS**

- 4. Sew (1) **H** 2-7/8" HST on (1) **F** 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" rectangle to make a
- **UNIT 3**, make (8).
- 5. Sew (1) H 2-7/8" HST and (1) H 2-1/2" square on opposite ends of
- (1) **F** 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" rectangle to make a **UNIT 4**, make (8).
- 6. Sew (1) **UNIT 3** on one side of a **G** 7-1/2" HST and (1) **UNIT 4** on an adjacent side to make a **SETTING TRIANGLE**, make (8).
- 7. Sew (2) **H** 2-7/8" HST on opposite ends of (1) **F** 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" rectangle to make a **UNIT 5**, make (4).
- 8. Sew (1) **UNIT 5** on long edge of (1) **G** 8-1/4" QST to make a **SETTING CORNER**, make (4).

QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to **QUILT DIAGRAM** for proper placement and rotation.

- 9. Sew (2) **H** 2" squares on opposite ends of (1) **G** 2" x 11-1/2" rectangle to make a **UNIT 6**, make (2).
- 9. UNIT 6 make (2)

10. Alternately join (4) H 2" squares and (3) G 2" x 11-1/2" rectangles to make a UNIT 7, make (2).

11. Alternately join (6) H 2" squares and (5) G 2" x 11-1/2" rectangles to make a UNIT 8, make (2).



- 12. Arrange and stitch **BLOCKS A**, **B**, **C** and **D**, **SETTING TRIANGLES**, **SETTING CORNERS** and **G** 2" x 11-1/2" rectangles in diagonal rows with **UNITS 6**, **7** and **8** between each row.
- 13. Trim corners of **H** 2" squares even with quilt center.


BORDER ASSEMBLY: Refer to **QUILT DIAGRAM** for proper placement and rotation.

- 1. Join (2) E 5-1/2" x WOF strips together on short ends to make a border strip, make (4). This will allow sufficient length for centering or fussy positioning and mitering corners.
- 2. Arrange and stitch (1) border strip on each side of quilt, starting and stopping 1/4" from end of quilt center.
- 3. Stitch miter corners and trim excess border fabric to complete the quilt top.

FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with **H** fabric.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Refer to **BLOCK DIAGRAMS**

- 1. Sew (2) **H** 2-1/2" squares on opposite ends of (1) **F** 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" rectangle to complete **UNIT 1**, make (26).
- 2. Sew (2) **F** 2-1/2" \times 7-1/2" rectangles on opposite sides of (1) **A** 7-1/2" square to complete **UNIT 2**. Repeat with **B**, **C** and **D** 7-1/2" squares, make (4) each.
- 3. Sew (2) **UNIT 1** to top and bottom of (1) **UNIT 2** to complete **BLOCK 1**, make (1). Repeat with **B**, **C** and **D UNIT 2**, make (4) each **BLOCK 2**, **BLOCK 3** and **BLOCK 4**. Square to 11-1/2".





BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAMS

- 4. Sew (1) **H** 2-7/8" HST on (1) **F** 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" rectangle to make a **UNIT 3**, make (8).
- 5. Sew (1) H 2-7/8" HST and (1) H 2-1/2" square on opposite ends of
- (1) **F** 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" rectangle to make a **UNIT 4**, make (8).
- 6. Sew (1) **UNIT 3** on one side of a **G** 7-1/2" HST and (1) **UNIT 4** on an adjacent side to make a **SETTING TRIANGLE**, make (8).
- 7. Sew (2) **H** 2-7/8" HST on opposite ends of (1) **F** 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" rectangle to make a **UNIT 5**, make (4).
- 8. Sew (1) UNIT 5 on long edge of (1) G 8-1/4" QST to make a **SETTING** CORNER, make (4).



BLOCK DIAGRAMS

QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to **QUILT DIAGRAM** for proper placement and rotation.

9. Sew (2) **H** 2" squares on opposite ends of (1) **G** 2" x 11-1/2" rectangle to make a **UNIT 6**, make (2).



10. Alternately join (4) H 2" squares and (3) G 2" x 11-1/2" rectangles to make a UNIT 7, make (2).



11. Alternately join (6) H 2" squares and (5) G 2" x 11-1/2" rectangles to make a UNIT 8, make (2).




BORDER ASSEMBLY: Refer to **QUILT DIAGRAM** for proper placement and rotation.

- 1. Join (2) E 5-1/2" x WOF strips together on short ends to make a border strip, make (4). This will allow sufficient length for centering or fussy positioning and mitering corners.
- 2. Arrange and stitch (1) border strip on each side of quilt, starting and stopping 1/4" from end of quilt center.
- 3. Stitch miter corners and trim excess border fabric to complete the quilt top.

FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with **H** fabric.
