

# **CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS**


WOF = Width of fabric | LOF = Length of fabric | \*Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated in pattern

### **BLOCK ASSEMBLY**

- Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all L 6-1/2" and 4-3/4" squares.
- Place a marked  $\mathbf{L}$  6-1/2" right sides together on (1)  $\mathbf{D}$  6-1/2" square. Stitch 1/4" on both sides of the drawn line, cut on the line, and press units open. Make (16) UNIT 1.
- 3. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (8) UNIT 1, perpendicular to the seam line.
- Place a marked UNIT 1 right sides together with an unmarked **UNIT 1**, alternating L sides. Stitch 1/4" on both sides of the drawn line, cut on the line, and press units open. Square up to measure 5-1/2". Make 16 **UNIT 2A**.
- Repeat steps 2-4 to make a total of (16) each UNIT 2B, 2C and 2D.



- 6. Place a marked L 4-3/4" square on the bottom left corner of (1) H 5-1/2" square. Stitch on the drawn line, trim seam allowance to 1/4", and press open to make **UNIT 3**. Make (32).
- 7. Place a marked L 4-3/4" square on the upper right corner of (1) **UNIT 3**. Stitch on the drawn line, trim seam allowance to 1/4", and press open to make **UNIT 4A**, measures 5-1/2" square. Make (32).
- In the same way, make (32) **UNIT 4B** using  $\mathbf{G}$  5-1/2" squares.
- Lay out (4) UNIT 2A, (2) each UNIT 4A and 4B, and (1) 5-1/2" **K** square into (3) rows of (3). Sew into rows and join the rows to make **BLOCK 1**, measures 15-1/2" square. Make (4).
- 10. In the same way, make a total of (4) each BLOCK 2, BLOCK 3, and BLOCK 4.


















## QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper placement and rotation.

11. Lay out the blocks into (4) rows of (4) blocks each, noting orientation. Sew the blocks into rows and join the rows to complete the quilt center.

BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements.


Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper placement and rotation.

- Sew (1)  $\mathbf{F}$  2" x (60-1/2") strip to each side of the quilt, then sew (1)  $\mathbf{F}$  2" x (63-1/2") strip to the top and bottom.
- Measure sides of quilt (ours are 63-1/2") and trim (4) **C** 6-1/2" x LOF strips to fit.
- 14. Sew (1) C 6-1/2" x (63-1/2") strip to sides of quilt. Sew (1) A 6-1/2" square to each end of remaining C strips, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

#### **FINISHING:**

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with G fabric.
