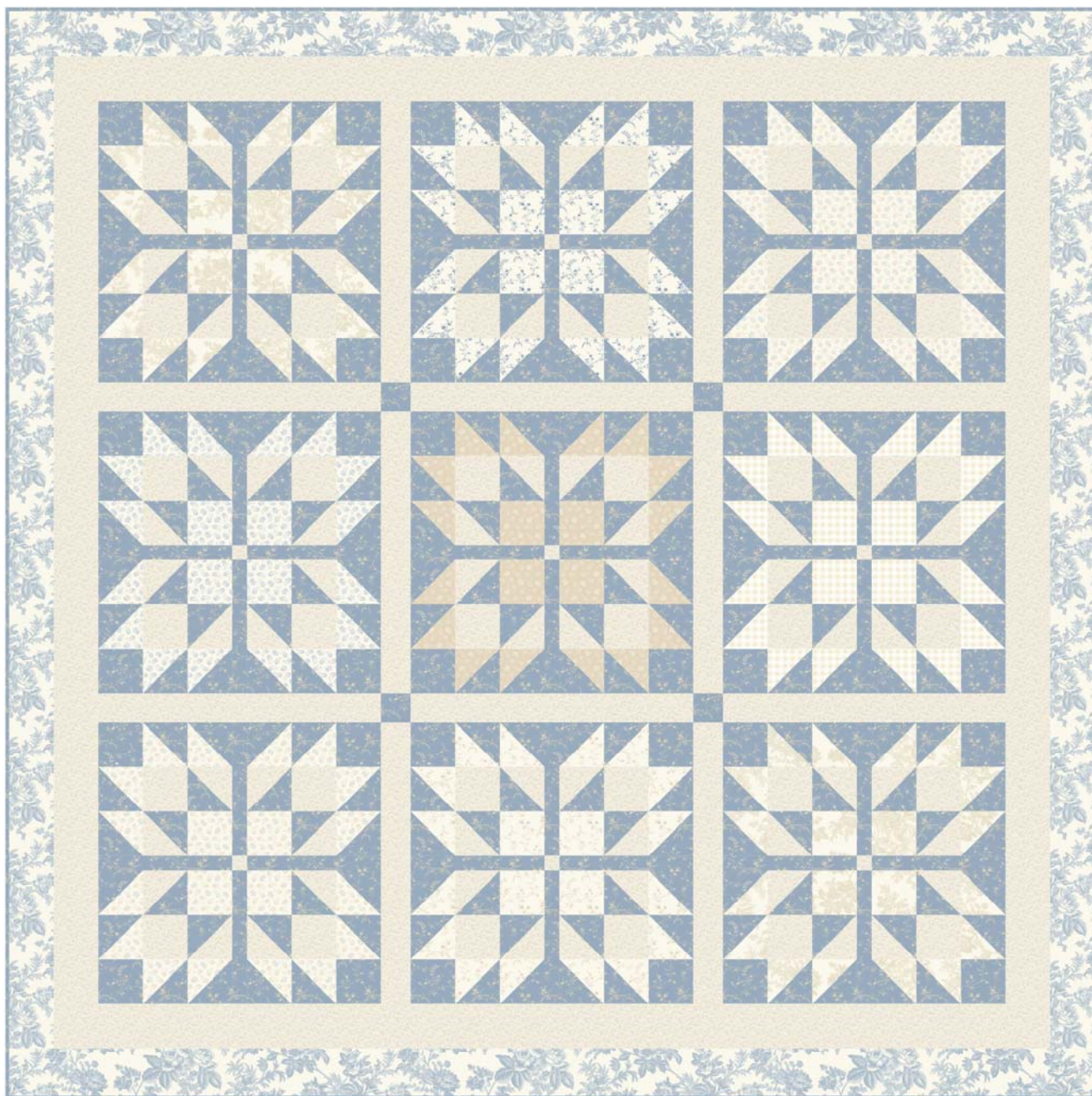

## Constructing pieced blocks

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 4" x 4" Fabric C square. Place square, right sides together, on (1) 4" x 4" Fabric I square. Sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield (2) HST units. Open and press. Align diagonal seam of HST units with the 45 degree line on quilting ruler, trim units to measure  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.



Make a total of (8) units.

2. Use the method outlined in step 1 to make a total of (16) Print/Fabric C HST units, measures  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.



3. Sew together (2) step 1 units, (1)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I and (1)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Print squares to make a four patch unit.



4. Sew (2) step 2 units to make a column unit, sew to the left of step 3 unit. Then sew together (1)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C square and (2) step 2 units to make a row unit, and sew to the top of step 3 unit.

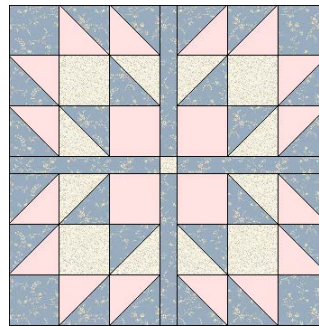


Make a total of (4) units.

5. Sew (2) step 4 units to the opposite long sides of (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C rectangle to make a row unit. Make a total of (2) row units.

6. Sew (2)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C rectangles to the opposite sides of (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I square to make a row unit.

7. Sew step 5 units to the opposite long sides of step 6 unit to complete (1) pieced block. Block measures  $19\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $19\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.



8. Make a total number of blocks for the following Prints:

2 blocks Fabric B	2 blocks Fabric G	1 block Fabric D
1 block Fabric E	1 block Fabric F	1 block Fabric H
1 block Fabric J		

## Quilt top assembly

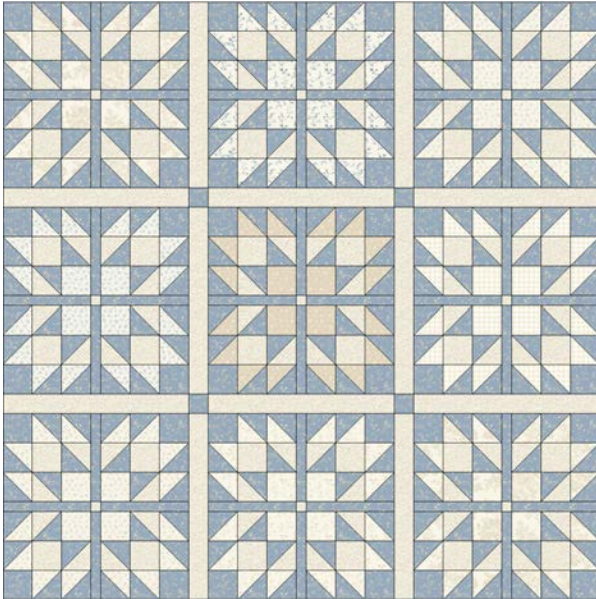
1. Pieced rows. Arrange and sew together (3) pieced blocks, alternating with (2)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $19\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I rectangles to make a pieced row. Make a total of (3) pieced rows. Row 1 is shown below.



2. Pieced sashing rows. Sew together (3)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $19\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I rectangles, alternating with (2)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C squares to make a pieced sashing row. Make a total of (2) pieced sashing rows.

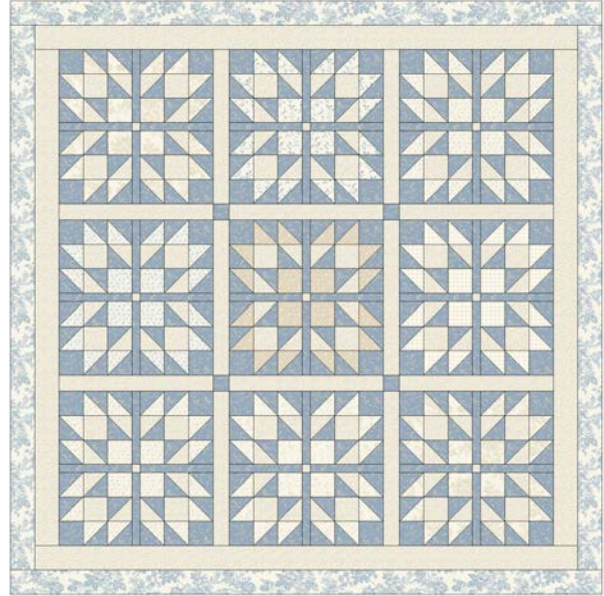


3. Sew together pieced rows, alternating with pieced sashing rows, to complete quilt center.



Note: Border strips are sewn shorter lengths first to the opposite sides of quilt center, followed by longer strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center.

4. Inner border. Fabric I. (2)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $61\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, followed by (2)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $67\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
5. Outer border. Fabric A. (2)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $67\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, followed by (2)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $73\frac{1}{2}$ " strips to complete quilt top.



## Finishing

1. Layer backing, batting and quilt top.
2. Baste the layers together. Quilt as desired.
3. Bind to complete the quilt.
