Gone Fishing

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, panels have a coping border added then trimmed so they will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of 6 panels to approximately 11-1/2" square

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 8-3/4" x 90" and (2) 8-3/4" x 76" multi-stripe borders

Fabric C - Cut (2) 7-1/2" strips, subcut (16) 4" x 7-1/2" pieces Cut (2) 4" strips

Fabric D - Cut (9) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabrics E and F - From each fabric: Cut (6) 4" strips


Fabric G - Cut (5) 4" strips

Fabric H - Cut (3) 4" strips

Fabric I - Cut (8) 2-1/4" strips, subcut (12) 2-1/4" x 15" and (12) 2-1/4" x 12" strips


2. Piecing Order:

1. Stitch **Fabric I** 2-1/4" x 12" strips to sides of a **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 2-1/4" x 15" **Fabric I** strips to top and bottom of panel. *Trim bordered panel to 14-1/2" square* (unfinished). Make a total of 6 **Block 1**.




Block 1 - Make 6

2. Sew 1 each **Fabrics C** and **G** 4" strips together lengthwise. Make a total of 2 strip sets. From these, cut (16) 4" wide Unit 1a (4" x 7-1/2" unfinished).

3. In the same manner, make 3 strip sets with fabrics indicated, and cut the number of Units 1b-1d indicated.

4. Stitch a **Fabric C** 4" x 7-1/2" piece to a Unit 1a as shown. Make a total of 16 Unit 2a (7-1/2" square unfinished).

5. Sew 1 each Units 1b and 1c together, alternating **Fabric E** squares. Make a total of 26 Unit 2b (7-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner,





make 14 Unit 2c with 2 Unit 1d.

6. Arrange 1 Unit 2a, 2 Unit 2b, and 1 Unit 2c in 2 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 10 **Block 2** (14-1/2" square unfinished).




Block 2 - Make 10


- 7. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of units, blocks, and borders.
- 8. Arrange remaining Units 2a-2c and all blocks in 6 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Quilt center measures 56-1/2" x 70-1/2" (unfinished).
- 9. Center **Fabric B** 8-3/4" x 90" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and


Fabric B 8-3/4" x 76" borders on top and bottom of quilt center with the narrow stripe next to quilt center. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.



Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric. Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

10. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.






- 11. The quilt measures approximately 73" x 87" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric J**) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- 12. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric D**) and enjoy!!
