## Cutting Instructions (Both versions):

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric **WOF** (perpendicular to selvages) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

### Fabric A:

- Fussy cut four 14 1/2" squares each centered on a block panel. **(Blocks)**

### Fabric B:

- Cut four 6 1/2" x Length of Fabric (LOF) strips each centered on the floral band. Sew the strips together end to end matching design as much as possible. Trim seams to 1/4" and press open. From this pieced strip cut two 6 1/2" x 75 1/2" strips. **(Stripe Borders)**

### Fabric C:

- Cut ten 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew strips together end to end. Trim seams to 1/4" and press open. From this pieced strip cut two 4 1/2" x 95 1/2" and two 4 1/2" x 89 1/2" strips. **(Outer Borders)**
- Cut five 9 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut eight 9 1/2" x 15 1/2" rectangles, one 9 1/2" square and four 3 1/2" squares. **(Blocks)**
- Cut one 6 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut four 6 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangles. **(Blocks)**
- Cut two 3 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut sixteen 3 1/2" squares. **(Blocks)**

### Fabric D:

- Cut one 10 1/4" x WOF strip; sub-cut two 10 1/4" squares and sixteen 2" squares. Cut each 10 1/4" square across both diagonals to make eight 10 1/4" triangles. **(Blocks)**
- Cut five 3 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut forty-eight 3 1/2" squares. **(Blocks)**

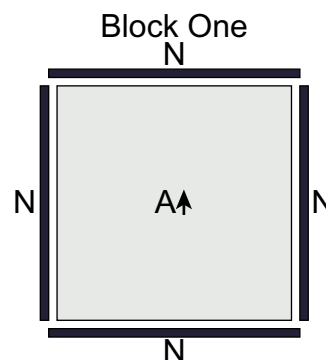
### Fabric E:

- Cut thirteen 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end. Trim seams to 1/4" and press open. From this pieced strip cut two 1 1/2" x 89 1/2" strips, two 1 1/2" x 77 1/2" strips, and two 1 1/2" x 75 1/2" strips. **(Inner Borders)**

## Piecing Instructions (Both Version)

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations while assembling the various components.

1. Sew one 1" x 14 1/2" Fabric N strip to each side of one 14 1/2" Fabric A square. Sew one 1" x 15 1/2" Fabric N strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric A square to make one 15 1/2" Block One square. (Diagram 1) Repeat to make four Block One squares total.

2. Place one 3 1/2" Fabric L square on the left side of one 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" Fabric G strip, right sides together. (Diagram 2) Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. (Diagram 2) Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. (Diagram 3)

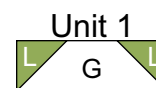

3. Place another 3 1/2" Fabric L square on the right side of the 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" Fabric G strip, right sides together. (Diagram 4) Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner. (Diagram 4) Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip. (Diagram 5)
4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make four Unit 1 strips total.

### Fabric F:

- Cut one 10 1/4" x WOF strip; sub-cut two 10 1/4" squares and eight 4" squares. Cut each 10 1/4" square across both diagonals to make eight 10 1/4" triangles. **(Blocks)**
- Cut three 6 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut sixteen 6 1/2" squares. **(Blocks)**
- Cut fifteen 3 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut eight 3 1/2" x 15 1/2" strips, twenty-eight 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" strips, and four 3 1/2" squares. **(Blocks)**

### Fabric G:

- Cut two 3 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut eight 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangles. **(Blocks)**

### Fabric H:

- Cut one 10 1/4" x WOF strip; sub-cut two 10 1/4" squares and sixteen 2" squares. Cut each 10 1/4" square across both diagonals to make eight 10 1/4" triangles. **(Blocks)**
- Cut five 3 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut forty-eight 3 1/2" squares. **(Blocks)**

### Fabric I:

- Cut seven 3 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut thirty-two 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles and sixteen 2" x 3 1/2" rectangles. **(Blocks)**

### Fabric J:

- Cut nine 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end. Trim seams to 1/4" and press open. From this pieced strip cut two 2 1/2" x 91 1/2" strips and two 2 1/2" x 81 1/2" strips. **(Middle Borders)**

### Fabric K:

- Cut two 10 1/4" x WOF strips; sub-cut six 10 1/4" squares. Cut each square across both diagonals to make twenty-four 10 1/4" triangles. **(Blocks)**

### Fabric L:

- Cut one 4" x WOF strip; sub-cut eight 4" squares. **(Blocks)**
- Cut two 3 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut sixteen 3 1/2" squares. **(Blocks)**

### Fabric M:

- Cut two 3 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut sixteen 3 1/2" squares. **(Blocks)**
- Cut ten 2 1/2" x WOF strips. **(Binding)**

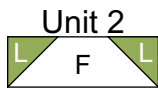
### Fabric N:

- Cut eight 1" x WOF strips; sub-cut eight 1" x 15 1/2" strips and eight 1" x 14 1/2" strips. **(Blocks)**

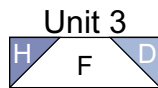
### Fabric O:

- Cut four 2" x WOF strips; sub-cut sixteen 2" x 3 1/2" rectangles and thirty-two 2" squares. **(Blocks)**

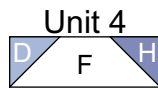
5. Repeat Steps 2-3 and refer to Diagrams 6-14 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make the indicated number of unit strips for Unit 2 through Unit 10.



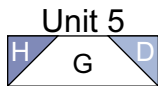

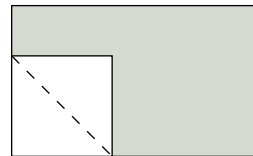
6. Sew one Unit 1 strip to each side of the 9 1/2" Fabric C square. Sew one 3 1/2" Fabric M square to each end of one Unit 1 strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew one newly sewn strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric C square to make one 15 1/2" Block Two square. (Diagram 15)



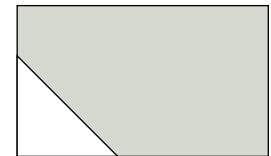

7. Place one 6 1/2" Fabric F square in the lower left corner of one 9 1/2" x 15 1/2" Fabric C rectangle, right sides together. (Diagram 16) Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner. (Diagram 16) Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind

the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. (Diagram 17)

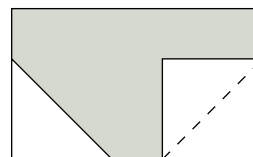

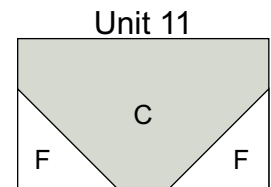

8. Place another 6 1/2" Fabric F square in the lower right corner of the 9 1/2" x 15 1/2" Fabric C rectangle, right sides together. (Diagram 18) Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. (Diagram 18) Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 11 rectangle. (Diagram 19)
9. Repeat Steps 7-8 to make four Unit 11 rectangles total.

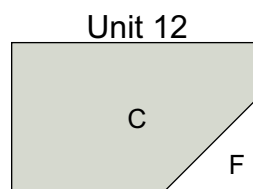

11. Place one 6 1/2" Fabric F square on the right side of one 6 1/2" x 9 1/2" Fabric C rectangle, right sides together. (Diagram 22) Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. (Diagram 22) Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make one Unit 14 rectangle. (Diagram 23) Repeat to make a

second Unit 14 rectangle.

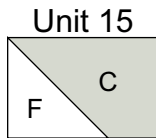

12. Repeat Step 11 and refer to Diagram 24 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make two Unit 15 rectangles.

13. Place one 4" Fabric L square on top of one 4" Fabric F square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square. (Diagram 25) Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line. (Diagram 25) Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 26) to make two half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 3 1/2" to make two Unit 16 squares. (Diagram 27) Repeat to make sixteen Unit 16 squares total.

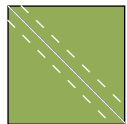

14. Sew one 3 1/2" Fabric F square to the left side of one Unit 16 square to make the top row. Sew one Unit 16 square to the left side of one 3 1/2" Fabric M square to make the bottom row. Sew the two rows together lengthwise to make one 6 1/2" Unit 17 square. (Diagram 28) Repeat to make four unit 17 squares total.



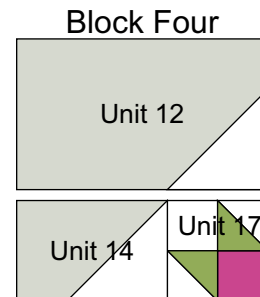

15. Sew one Unit 16 square to each end of one 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" Fabric F strip. Sew one 3 1/2" Fabric M square to each end of one Unit 2 strip. Sew the newly sewn strip to the bottom of the Fabric F strip. Sew one Unit 11 rectangle to the top of the newly sewn strip to make one 15 1/2" Block Three square. (Diagram 29) Repeat to make four Block Three squares total.



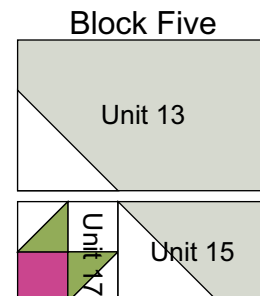

16. Sew one Unit 14 rectangle to the left side of one Unit 17 square. Sew one Unit 12 rectangle to the top of the newly sewn strip to make one 15 1/2" Block Four square. (Diagram 30) Repeat to make a second Block Four square.

17. Sew one Unit 17 square to the left side of one Unit 15 rectangle. Sew one Unit 13 rectangle to the top of the newly sewn strip to make one 15 1/2" Block Five square. (Diagram 31) Repeat to make a second Block Five square.

18. Place one 3 1/2" Fabric C square on the left side of one 3 1/2" x 15 1/2" Fabric F strip, right sides together. (Diagram 32) Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. (Diagram 32) Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. (Diagram 33)

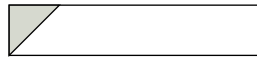

19. Place another 3 1/2" Fabric C square on the right side of the 3 1/2" x 15 1/2" Fabric F strip, right sides together. (Diagram 34) Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner. (Diagram 34) Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 18 strip. (Diagram 35)
20. Repeat Steps 18-19 to make eight Unit 18 strips total.

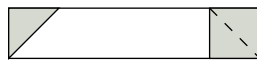
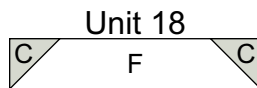
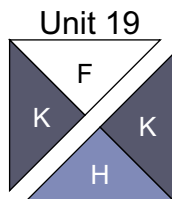

23. Place one 3 1/2" Fabric D square on the left side of one 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" Fabric I strip, right sides together. (Diagram 39) Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. (Diagram 39) Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. (Diagram 40)

24. Place one 3 1/2" Fabric H square on the right side of the 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" Fabric I strip, right sides together. (Diagram 41) Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner. (Diagram 41) Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make one Unit 22 strip. (Diagram 42)
25. Repeat Steps 23-24 to make sixteen Unit 22 strips total.

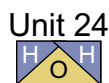

27. Place one 2" Fabric H square on the left side of one 2" x 3 1/2" Fabric O strip, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left

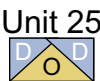
corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.

28. Place another 2" Fabric H square on the right side of the 2" x 3 1/2" Fabric O strip, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make one Unit 24 strip. (Diagram 44)
29. Repeat Steps 27-28 to make eight Unit 24 strips total.

31. Sew one Unit 24 strip to the top of one Unit 26 strip to make one 6 1/2" Unit 27 square. (Diagram 47). Repeat to make eight Unit 27 squares total.



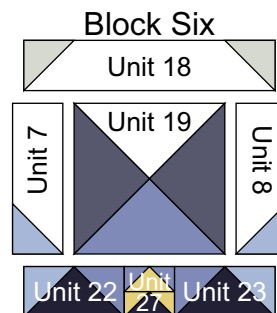

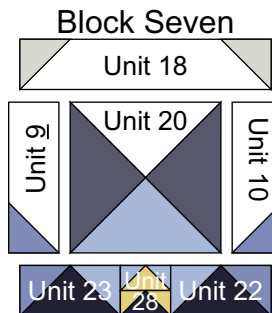

33. Sew together one Unit 7 strip, one Unit 19 square and one Unit 8 strip, in that order from left to right, to make the middle row. Sew together one Unit 22 strip, one Unit 27 square and one Unit 23 strip, in that order from left to right, to make the bottom row. Sew together one Unit 18 strip, the middle row and bottom row, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make one 15 1/2" Block Six square. (Diagram 49) Repeat to make four Block Six squares total.

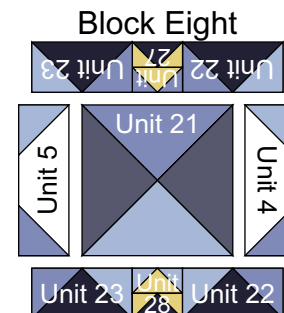

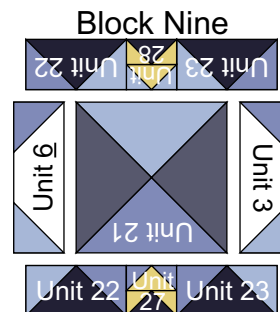

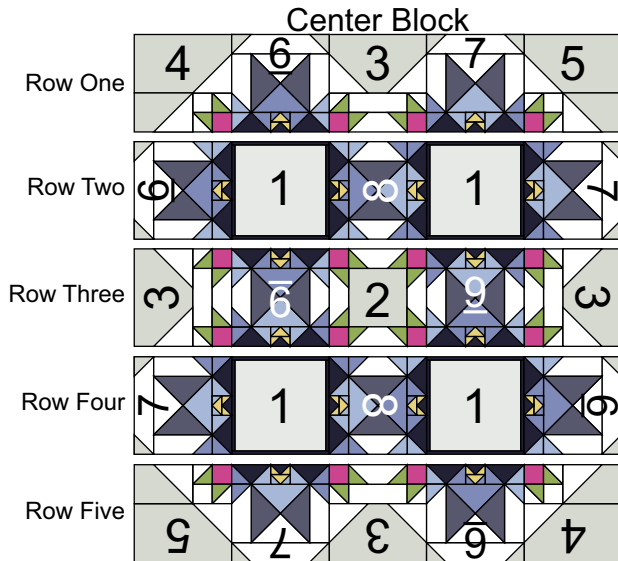

35. Sew together one Block Four square, one Block Six square, one Block Three square, one Block Seven square and one Block Five square, in that order from left to right, to make Row One. (Diagram 53)
36. Repeat Step 35 and refer to Diagram 53 for block identification, placement and orientation to make Row Two through Row Five.
37. Sew together the five pieced Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 75 1/2" x 75 1/2" Center Block. (Diagram 53)

42. Sew one 4 1/2" x 95 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew one 4 1/2" x 89 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

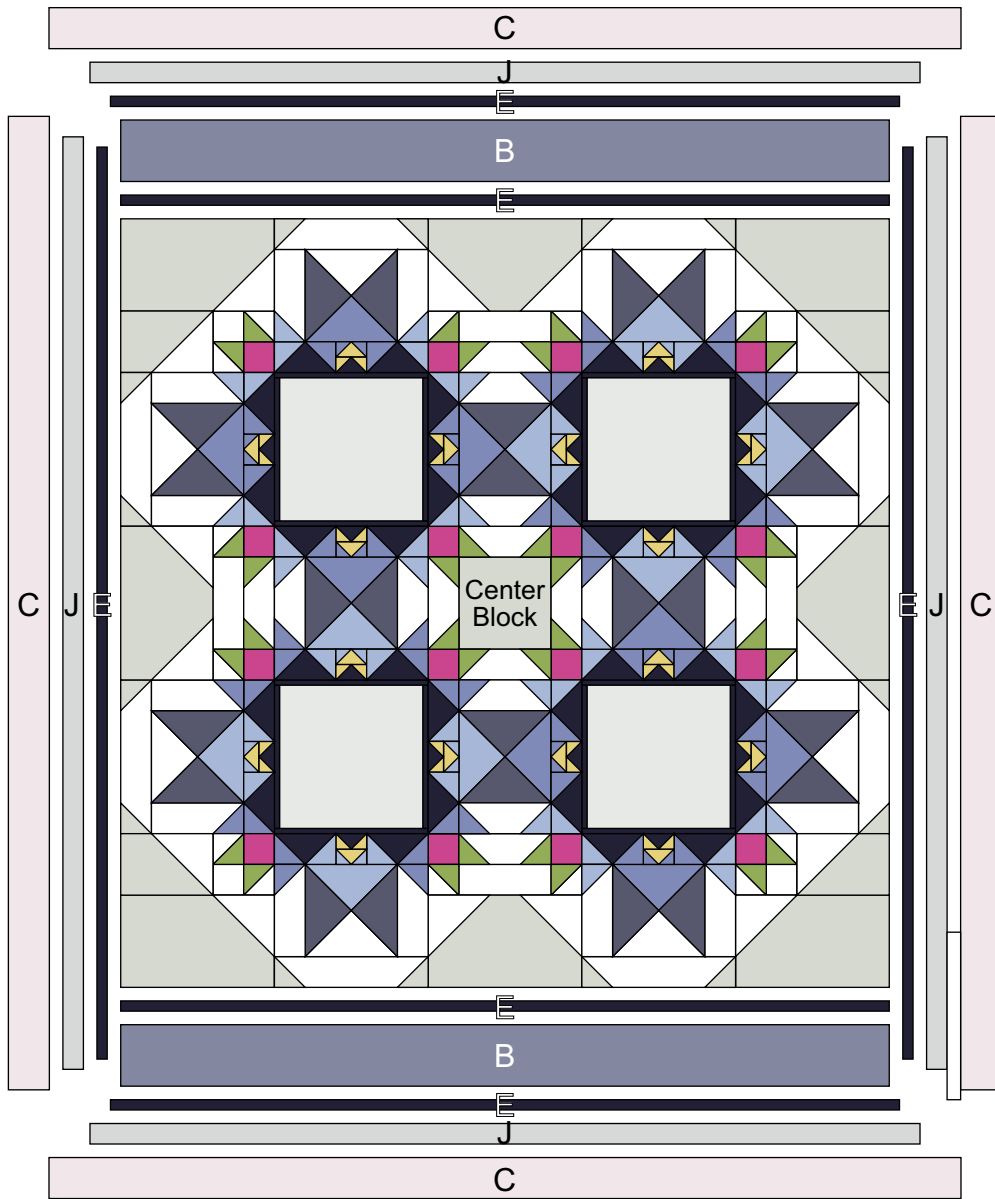
### *Finishing:*

43. Press 108" backing well and trim to 97" x 111".
44. Layer the quilt, batting and backing. Baste layers together.
45. Quilt as desired.
46. Trim layers even with quilt top, squaring corners.
47. Attach 2 1/42" Fabric M binding strips using your favorite method.

### *Quilt Assembly:*

38. Sew one 1 1/2" x 75 1/2" Fabric E strip to the top and bottom of the Center Block.
39. Sew one 6 1/2" x 75 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the Center Block.
40. Sew one 1 1/2" x 89 1/2" Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew one 1 1/2" x 77 1/2" Fabric E strip to the top and bottom of the Center Block.
41. Sew one 2 1/2" x 91 1/2" Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew one 2 1/2" x 81 1/2" Fabric J strip to the top and bottom of the Center Block.

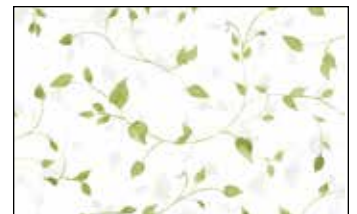
