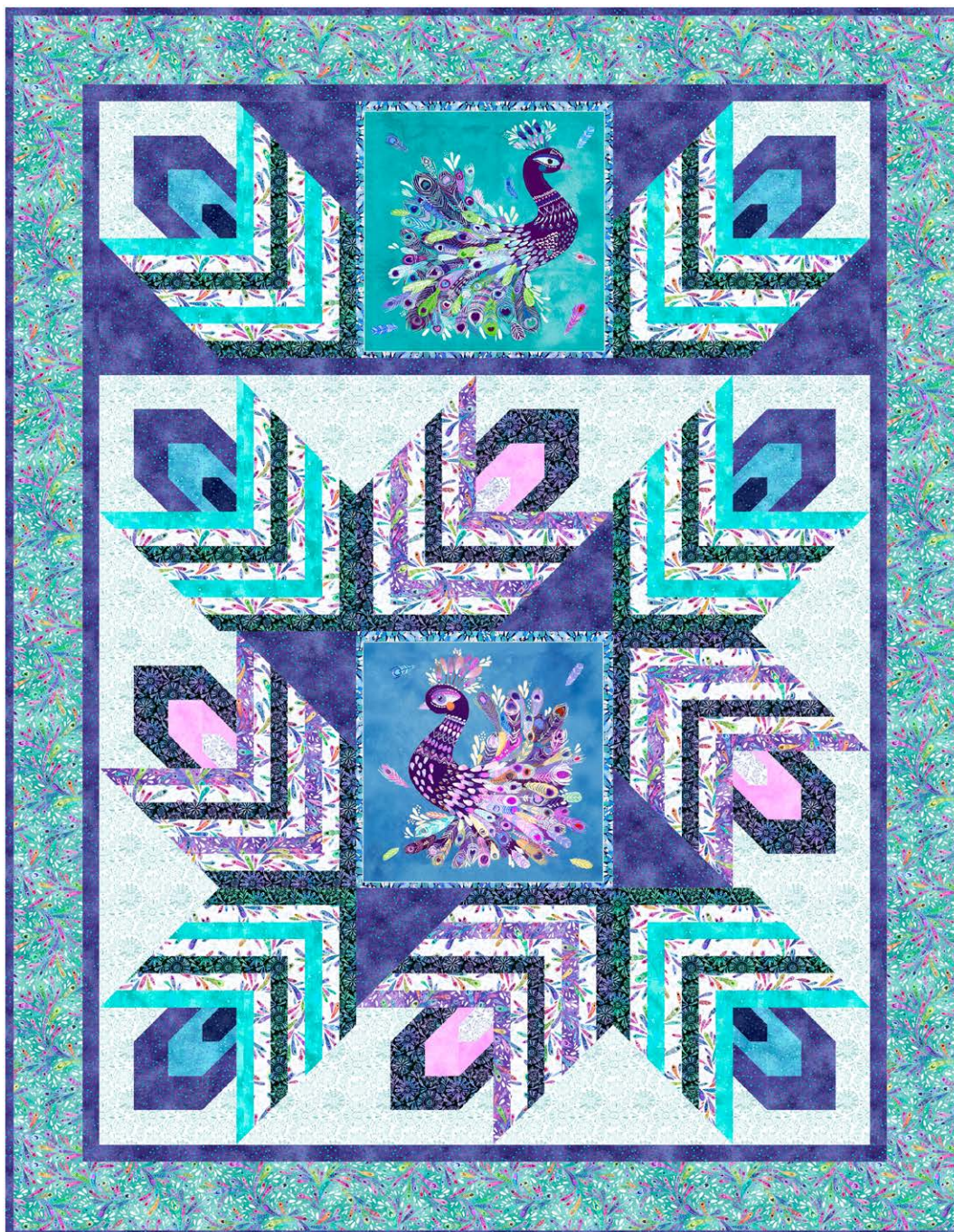

## Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric **WOF** (perpendicular to selvages) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

### Fabric A:

- Cut five 1 1/2" strips; subcut four 1 1/2" x 13 1/2", four 1 1/2" x 12 1/2", four 1 1/2" x 9 1/2", and four 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips.

### Fabric B:

- Cut six 4 1/2" strips. Sew strips together end to end. Trim seams to 1/4" and press open. From this pieced strip, cut two 4 1/2" x 63 1/2" and two 4 1/2" x 55 1/2" strips. (Outer Borders)

### Fabric C:

- Cut twenty 1 1/2" strips; subcut ten 1 1/2" x 14 1/2", ten 1 1/2" x 13 1/2", ten 1 1/2" x 12 1/2", ten 1 1/2" x 11 1/2", ten 1 1/2" x 10 1/2", and ten 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" strips.

### Fabric D:

- Cut one 2 1/2" strip; subcut six 2 1/2" squares.

### Fabric E:

- Cut one 3" strip; subcut two 3" squares, one 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangle, and four 2 1/2" squares.
- Cut one 2 1/2" strip; subcut three 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles and four 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles.
- Cut seven 1 1/2" strips; subcut four 1 1/2" x 15 1/2", four 1 1/2" x 14 1/2", four 1 1/2" x 11 1/2", and four 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips.

### Fabric F:

- Cut ten 1 1/2" strips; subcut six 1 1/2" x 15 1/2", six 1 1/2" x 14 1/2", six 1 1/2" x 11 1/2" and six 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips.

### Fabric G:

- Cut one 2 1/2" strip; subcut four 2 1/2" squares.

### Fabric H:

- Cut three 7 1/2" strips; subcut twelve 7 1/2" squares. Trim remainder of strip to 6 1/2" wide and subcut ten 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.
- Cut four 2 1/2" strips; subcut ten 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" pieces and twenty 2 1/2" squares.

### Fabric I:

- Fussy cut two panel blocks to 15 1/2" square keeping design centered within each square.

### Fabric J:

- Cut eight 1 1/2" strips; subcut six 1 1/2" x 13 1/2", six 1 1/2" x 12 1/2", six 1 1/2" x 9 1/2", and six 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips.

### Fabric K:

- Cut two 7 1/2" strips; subcut eight 7 1/2" squares and three 3" squares.
- Cut three 2 1/2" strips; subcut six 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" pieces, six 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" pieces, and six 2 1/2" squares.
- Cut seven 2 1/2" strips. (binding)
- Cut seven 1 1/2" strips. Sew strips together end to end. Trim seams to 1/4" and press open. From this pieced strip, cut two 1 1/2" x 61 1/2", two 1 1/2" x 47 1/2", and one 1 1/2" x 45 1/2" strips. (Inner Borders)

### Fabric L:

- Cut one 3" strip; subcut three 3" squares and six 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" pieces.
- Cut one 1 1/2" strip; subcut twelve 1 1/2" squares.

### Fabric M:

- Cut one 3" strip; subcut two 3" squares, four 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" pieces, and eight 1 1/2" squares.



## Piecing Instructions:

1. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side then draw 2 lines  $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of first line on the following squares:

- all **Fabrics L** and **M** 3" squares

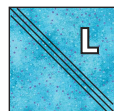

2. Arrange a marked **Fabric L** 3" square right sides together with a **Fabric K** 3" square aligning all edges. Stitch along the 2 outside lines. Cut along the center line. Press the 2 triangle sets open. Centering seam, trim each to 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Make a total of 6 Unit 1a. In the same manner, make 4 Unit 1b with fabrics indicated.

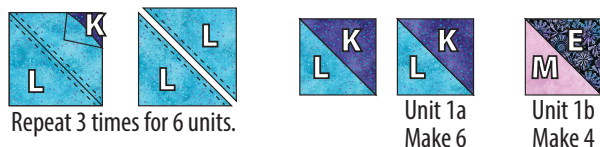

3. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of:

- all **Fabrics L** and **M** 1- $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
- all **Fabrics E, H, and K** 2- $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
- all **Fabrics H** and **K** 7- $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

4. Arrange 2 marked **Fabric L** 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares on opposite corners of a **Fabric D** 2- $\frac{1}{2}$ " square as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to  $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press corners out. Make a total of 6 Unit 2a (2- $\frac{1}{2}$ " square unfinished). In the same manner, make 4 Unit 2b with fabrics indicated.

5. Arrange a marked **Fabric K** 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square on end of a **Fabric L** 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4- $\frac{1}{2}$ " piece as shown. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to  $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press corner out. Make a total of six Unit 3a (2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4- $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished).

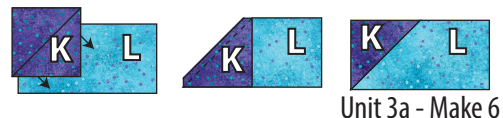

6. In the same manner, make six Unit 3b and four each Units 3c and 3d with fabrics indicated.

7. In the same manner, make six Unit 4a and four Unit 4b with a marked **Fabric H** 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square and **Fabric K** or **E** 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " piece.

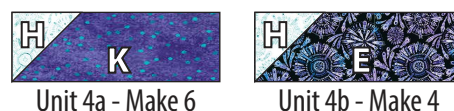

8. Sew a Unit 1a to a Unit 2a as shown. Add a Unit 3a to top as shown. Make a total of 6 Unit 5a (4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square unfinished). In the same manner, make 4 Unit 5b with units indicated.

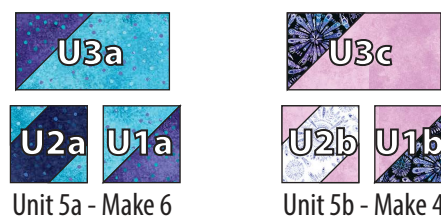

9. Stitch a Unit 5a to a Unit 3b as shown. Add a Unit 4a to top as shown. Make a total of 6 Unit 6a (6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square unfinished). In the same manner, make 4 Unit 6b with units indicated.

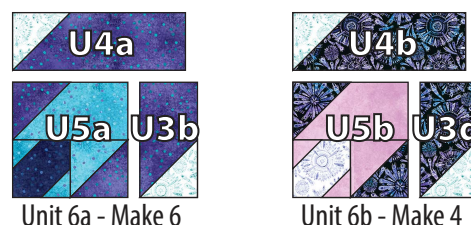
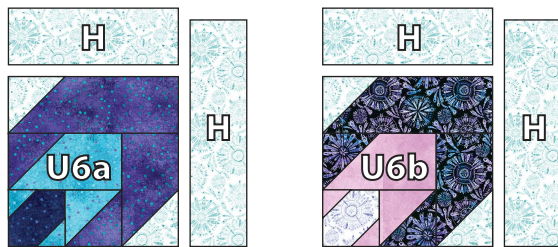

10. Sew a **Fabric H** 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" piece to top of a Unit 6a as shown. Add a **Fabric H** 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" piece to side as shown. Make a total of 6 Unit 7a (8 1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 4 Unit 7b with fabrics and units indicated.

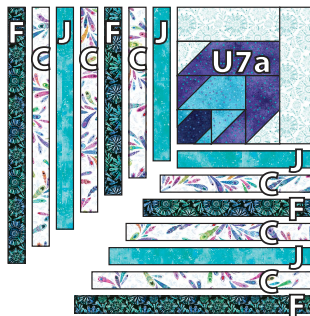


Unit 7a - Make 6

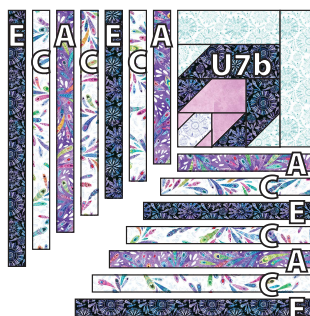
Unit 7b - Make 4

11. Stitch a **Fabric J** 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strip to bottom of a Unit 7a. Add a **Fabric J** 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" strip to the left side. Continue to add the strips shown, each strip being 1" longer than the previous bottom or left strip ending with **Fabric F** 14 1/2" and 15 1/2" strips. Make a total of 6 Unit 8a (15 1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 4 Unit 8b with unit and strips indicated.



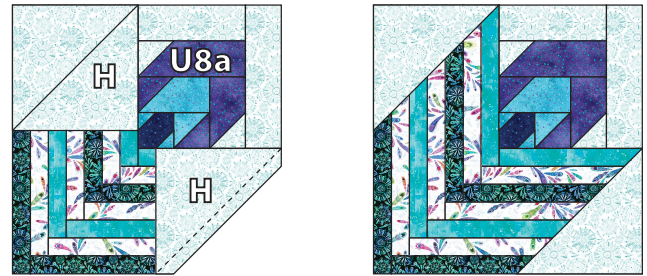
Unit 8a - Make 6

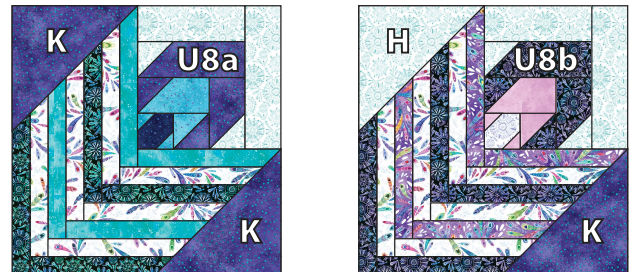
12. Arrange 2 marked **Fabric H** 7 1/2" squares on opposite corners of a Unit 8a as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press corners out. Make a total of four Block 1 (15 1/2" square unfinished).

13. In the same manner, make two Block 2 and 4 Block 3 with units and fabrics indicated.

## Quilt Assembly:

1. Arrange Blocks 1 and 3 and one **Fabric I** panel block in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together completing quilt center (45-1/2" square unfinished). Press.
2. Arrange two Block 2 and one **Fabric I** panel block in a row. Stitch into row. Stitch **Fabric K** 1 1/2" x 45 1/2" strip above quilt center, then add the row of blocks above that (45-1/2" x 61 1/2" unfinished). Press.
3. Sew **Fabric K** 1 1/2" x 61 1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Press. Add **Fabric K** 1 1/2" x 47 1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt. Press.
4. Sew **Fabric B** 4 1/2" x 63 1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Press. Add **Fabric B** 4 1/2" x 55 1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt. Press.

## Finishing:

1. Press 108" backing well and trim to 63" x 79".
2. Layer quilt, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Trim layers even with quilt top squaring corners.
5. Join seven 2 1/2" **Fabric K** binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Attach binding using your favorite method.
6. Make a label and sew to the back of quilt.

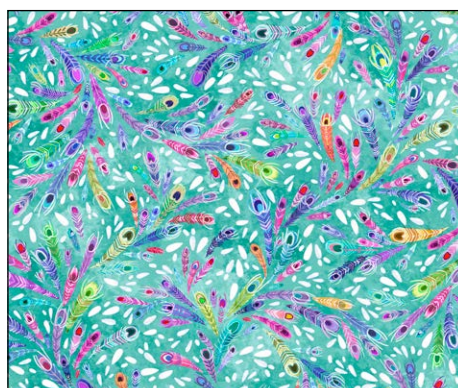

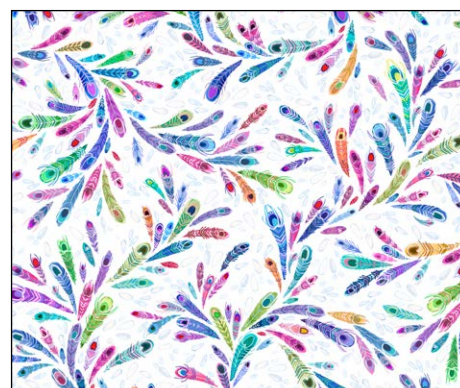

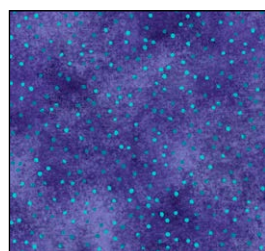

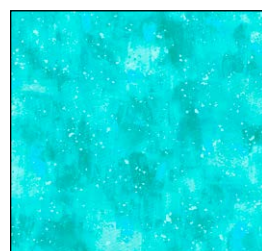
