

Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric **WOF** (perpendicular to selvedges) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

Fabric A:

 Cut two 6" x WOF strips; sub-cut eleven 6" squares. (Blocks)

Fabric B:

Cut two 6" x WOF strips; sub-cut nine 6" squares.
 (Blocks)

Fabric C:

- Cut four 6" x WOF strips; sub-cut nineteen 6" squares. (Blocks)
- Cut eight 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew strips together end to end. Trim seams to 1/4" and press open.
 From this pieced strip cut two 4 1/2" x 77 1/2" strips and two 4 1/2" x 70 1/2" strips.

(Outer Borders)

Fabric D:

 Cut three 6" x WOF strips; sub-cut sixteen 6" squares.(Blocks)

Fabric E:

 Cut two 6" x WOF strips; sub-cut eleven 6" squares. (Blocks)

Fabric F:

 Cut two 6" x WOF strips; sub-cut eleven 6" squares. (Blocks)

Fabric G:

 Cut two 6" x WOF strips; sub-cut eleven 6" squares. (Blocks)

Fabric H:

Cut two 6" x WOF strips; sub-cut eight 6" squares.
 (Blocks)

Fabric I:

Cut two 6" x WOF strips; sub-cut seven 6" squares.
 (Blocks)

Fabric J:

 Fussy cut two 14 1/2" squares each centered on a block. (Blocks)

Fabric K:

Cut two 6" x WOF strips; sub-cut seven 6" squares.
 (Blocks)

Fabric L:

Cut two 6" x WOF strips; sub-cut seven 6" squares.
 (Blocks)

Fabric M:

- Cut two 6" x WOF strips; sub-cut ten 6" squares.
 (Blocks)
- Cut nine 2 1/2" x WOF strips. (Binding)
- Cut eight 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew strips together end to end. Trim seams to 1/4" and press open.
 From this pieced strip cut two 1 1/2" x 75 1/2" strips and two 1 1/2" x 62 1/2" strips.

(Inner Borders)

Fabric N:

Cut two 6" x WOF strips; sub-cut ten 6" squares.
 (Blocks)

Fabric O:

Cut two 6" x WOF strips; sub-cut eleven 6" squares.
 (Blocks)

Fabric P:

- Cut two 6" x WOF strips; sub-cut eleven 6" squares.
 (Blocks)
- Cut four 1" strips; sub-cut four 1" x 15 1/2" and four 1" x 14 1/2" strips. (Panel Frames)

Fabric Q:

Cut two 6" x WOF strips; sub-cut nine 6" squares.
 (Blocks)

Piecing Instructions:

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations while assembling the various components.

Place one 6" Fabric N square on top of one 6" Fabric M square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square. (Diagram 1) Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line. (Diagram 1) Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 2) to make two half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 5 1/2" to make two Unit 1 squares. (Diagram 3) Repeat to make twenty Unit 1 squares total.

Make (20) Use (19) 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" unfinished Diagram 3

Repeat Step 1 and refer to Diagrams 4-13 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make the indicated number of unit squares for Unit 2 through Unit 11.




Make (18) unfinished Diagram 13

Refer to Diagram 14 to sew together nine assorted unit squares into a 9 x 9 matrix to make one 15 1/2" x 15 1/2" Block One square.




Make (1) = $15 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $15 \frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished Diagram 14


Repeat Step 3 and refer to Diagrams 15-17 for unit identification, placement and orientation to make seven Block Two squares, four Block Three squares and six Block Four squares.



Make (7) = 15 1/2" x 15 1/2" unfinished Diagram 15




Make (4) = 15 1/2" x 15 1/2" unfinished Diagram 16




Make (6) = 15 1/2" x 15 1/2" unfinished Diagram 17

5. Sew one 1" x 14 1/2" Fabric P strip to each side of one 14 1/2" Fabric J square. Sew one 1" x 15 1/2" Fabric P strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric J square to make one 15 1/2" x 15 1/2" Block Five square. (Diagram 18) Repeat to make a second Block Five square.



Make (2) = 15 1/2" x 15 1/2" unfinished Diagram 18

- 6. Sew together one Block One square, one Block Two square, one Block Three square and one Block Four square, in that order from left to right, to make Row One. (Diagram 19)
- 7. Repeat Step 6 and refer to Diagram 19 for block identification, placement and orientation to make Row Two through Row Five.
- 8. Sew together the five Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 60 1/2" x 75 1/2" Center Block. (Diagram 19)




Make (1) = 60 1/2" x 75 1/2" unfinished Diagram 19

Quilt Assembly:

- 9. Sew one 1 1/2" x 75 1/2" Fabric M strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew one 1 1/2" x 62 1/2" Fabric M strip to the top and bottom of the Center Block.
- 10. Sew one 4 1/2" x 77 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew one 4 1/2" x 70 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

Finishing:

- 11. Trim 108" backing fabric to 78" x 93".
- 12. Layer the quilt, batting and backing. Baste layers together.
- 13. Quilt as desired.
- 14. Trim layers even with quilt top, squaring corners.
- 15. Attach 2 1/2" binding strips using your favorite method.
