# GARDEN GRACE

Throw Quilt: 55" x 73"



Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning. WOF = width of fabric. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

### 1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

**Fabric A** - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 8-3/4" x 78" and (2) 8-3/4" x 60" multi-stripe borders

**Fabric B** - Cut (2) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (24) 2-3/4" squares

**Fabrics C and D** - From each fabric: Cut (1) 5-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 5-1/2" squares

**Fabric E** - Cut (2) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (16) 2-3/4" squares

**Fabric F** - Cut (2) 5-1/2" strips, subcut (8) 5-1/2" squares

**Fabric G** - Cut (1) 5-1/2" strip, subcut (6) 5-1/2" squares

Cut (2) 3-1/4" strips, subcut (24) 3-1/4" squares Cut (2) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (24) 2-3/4" squares

**Fabric H** - Cut (2) 5-1/2" strips, subcut (8) 5-1/2" squares and (8) 3-1/4" squares

Fabric I - Cut (1) 5-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 5-1/2" squares and (1) 2-3/4" squares Cut (4) 3-1/4" strips, subcut (48) 3-1/4" squares Cut (1) 2-3/4" strip, subcut (15) 2-3/4" squares

Fabric J - Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

**Fabric K** - Cut (3) 1-3/4" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 1-3/4" x 54-1/2" borders

Cut (2) 1-3/4" strips, subcut (2) 1-3/4" x 39" borders

**Fabric L** - Cut (2) 5-1/2" strips, subcut (14) 5-1/2" squares

Cut (2) 3-1/4" strips, subcut (16) 3-1/4" squares and (2) 2-3/4" squares

Cut (2) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (30) 2-3/4" squares

#### 2. Piecing Order:

1. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of:



all Fabric I 2-3/4" squares

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

2. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side then draw 2 lines 1/4" on each side of first line on the following squares:



all **Fabric I** 3-1/4" squares all **Fabrics F** and **L** 5-1/2" squares 2 **Fabric C** 5-1/2" squares

3. Arrange a marked **Fabric I** 3-1/4" square right sides together with a **Fabric G** 3-1/4" square aligning all edges. Stitch along the 2 outside lines. Cut along the center line. Press the 2 triangle sets open. Centering seam, trim each to 2-3/4" square. Make a total of 48 Unit 1a.









Repeat 24 times for 48 units.


4. In the same manner, make 16 Unit 1b and 32 Unit 1c with fabrics indicated.

5. Arrange 2 Unit 1a and 1 each **Fabrics B** and **G** 2-3/4" squares in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 8 Unit 2a (5" square unfinished).

6. In the same manner, make 8 each Units 2b-2d and 16 Unit 2e with units and fabrics indicated.

7. Arrange a marked **Fabric F** 5-1/2" square right sides together with a Fabric I 5-1/2" square aligning all edges. Stitch along the 2 outside lines. Cut along the center line. Press the 2 triangle sets open. Centering seam, trim each to 5" square. Make a total of 8 Unit 3a.









Repeat 4 times for 8 units.

8. In the same manner, make the number of Units 3b-3f listed with fabrics indicated.

9. Arrange a marked **Fabric I** 2-3/4" square on L corner of a Unit 3c as shown. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner out. Make a total of 8 Unit 4a (5" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 8 Unit 4b with fabrics and units indicated.















10. Arrange 2 Unit 2a and 1 each Units 3a and 3b in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 Block 1a (9-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 1a - Make 4


11. In the same manner, make 4 each **Blocks** 1b-1d and 8 Block 2 with units indicated.




- 12. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.
- 13. Arrange blocks in 6 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together completing guilt center (36-1/2" x 54-1/2" unfinished).


14. Sew **Fabric K** 1-3/4" x 54-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric K** 1-3/4" x 39" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

15. Center **Fabric A** 8-3/4" x 78" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and **Fabric A** 8-3/4" x 60" borders on top and bottom of quilt center noting orientation of stripe. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric. Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

16. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.






17. The quilt measures approximately 55-1/2" x 73-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric M**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

18. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric J**) and enjoy!!

Border measurements are the cut size.

Arrows and stripes indicate orientation of directional prints.
