## Sunlit Serenade by Joy Hall



Throw Quilt: 56-1/2" x 65-1/2"



Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning. WOF = width of fabric. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

## 1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

Fabric A - Referring to the guilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 5" x 52-1/2" floral stripe borders

**Fabric B** - Cut (1) 4-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 4-1/2" squares

Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (12) 2-1/2" squares

**Fabric C** - Cut (1) 4-1/2" strip, subcut (5) 4-1/2" squares

Fabric D - Cut (1) 5" strip, subcut (8) 5" squares

**Fabric E** - Cut (1) 5-1/2" strip, subcut (5) 5-1/2" squares and (2) 5" squares

Cut (1) 5" strip, subcut (8) 5" squares

**Fabric F** - Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric G - Cut (2) 5" strips, subcut (16) 5" squares

Fabric H - Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 48-1/2" borders

**Fabric I** - Cut (2) 3" strips, subcut (16) 3" squares

Fabric J - Cut (2) 5-1/2" strips, subcut (12) 5-1/2" squares and (2) 4-7/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally // for a total of 4 triangles]

Cut (1) 5" strip, subcut (8) 5" squares

Fabric K - Cut (1) 5-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 5-1/2" squares and (4) 3" squares

Cut (2) 3" strips, subcut (28) 3" squares

**Fabric L** - Cut (5) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 48-1/2" and (2) 2-1/2" x 44-1/2" borders

Fabric M - Cut (2) 5-1/2" strips, subcut (11) 5-1/2" squares and (16) 2-1/2" squares Cut (3) 5" strips, subcut (22) 5" squares and (4) 2-1/2" squares

Cut (2) 4-1/2" strips, subcut (12) 4-1/2" squares and (4) 2-7/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally // for a total of 8 triangles]

**Fabric N** - Cut (2) 3" strips, subcut (16) 3" squares

Cut (9) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 61-1/2", (2) 2-1/2" x 56-1/2", and (2) 2-1/2" x 52-1/2" borders

### 2. Piecing Order:

1. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of:



all **Fabrics I**, **K**, and **N** 3" squares 8 Fabric B 2-1/2" squares

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

2. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side then draw 2 lines 1/4" on each side of first line on the following squares:



all **Fabrics E** and **M** 5-1/2" squares all **Fabric J** 5" squares 16 Fabric M 5" squares

3. Arrange a marked **Fabric J** 5" square right sides together with a **Fabric C** 5" square aligning all edges. Stitch along the 2 outside lines. Cut along the center line. Press the 2 triangle sets open. Centering seam, trim each to 4-1/2" square. Make a total of 8 Unit 1a.

Repeat 4 times for 8 units.

4. In the same manner, make 8 each Units 1b and 1d and 16 Unit 1c with the fabrics indicated.

5. Arrange a marked **Fabric M** 5-1/2" square right sides together with a Fabric J 5-1/2" square aligning all edges. Stitch along the 2 outside lines. Cut along the center line. Press the 2 triangle sets open. Do not trim. Make a

total of 14 Unit 2a.

Repeat 7 times for 14 units.

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6. In the same manner, make 10 Unit 2b and 8 Unit 2c with the fabrics indicated.





7. Arrange a marked Fabric K 3" square on G corner of a Unit 1c and a marked **Fabric I** 3" square on **M** corner. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press corners out. Make a total of 8 Unit 3a (4-1/2" square unfinished).

8. Arrange a marked Fabric I 3" square on M corner of a Unit 1d and a marked Fabric N 3" square on **D** corner. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press corners out. Make a total of 8 Unit 3b (4-1/2" square unfinished).

9. Arrange a marked Fabric N 3" square on D corner of a Unit 1b. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner out. Make a total of 8 Unit 4 (4-1/2" square unfinished).

10. Arrange a marked Fabric K 3" square on G corner of a Unit 1a. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner out. Make a total of 8 Unit 5 (4-1/2" square unfinished).



11. Arrange a marked **Fabric K** 3" square on **G** corner of a Unit 1c. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner out. Make a total of 16 Block 6 (4-1/2" square unfinished).





Block 6 - Make 16

12. Arrange a marked **Fabric B** 2-1/2" square on 1 corner of a **Fabric M** 4-1/2" square. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner out. Make a total of 8 Block 5 (4-1/2" square unfinished).







Block 5 - Make 8

13. Arrange 2 marked **Fabric M** 2-1/2" squares right sides together on opposite corners of a Fabric C 4-1/2" square. Stitch along the marked lines. Cut seam allowances to 1/4". Press the triangles open. Repeat on remaining corners. Make a total of 5 Unit 6 (4-1/2" square unfinished).









Unit 6 - Make 5

14. Sew 2 Fabric M 2-7/8" triangles on adjoining edges of a **Fabric B** 2-1/2" square. Add a Fabric J 4-7/8" triangle to the **M** diagonal edges as shown. Make a total of 4 Unit 7 (4-1/2" square unfinished).

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15. Draw a diagonal line, perpendicular to the seam line) across the wrong side of each Units 2a and 2b.





Mark 14 Mark 10

Draw 2 lines 1/4" on each side of first line.

16. Arrange a marked Unit 2b right sides together on a **Fabric E** 5" square. Stitch along the two outside lines. Cut along the center line. Press the 2 triangle sets open (1 each Units 8a and 8b). Centering seam trim each to 4-1/2" square. Make a total of 10 Units 8a and 8b.









Repeat 10 times for 10 each units.

17. Arrange a marked Unit 2a right sides together on a **Fabric M** 5" square. Stitch along the two outside lines. Cut along the center line. Press the 2 triangle

center line. Press the 2 triangle sets open (1 each **Blocks 4a** and **4b**). Centering seam trim each to 4-1/2" square. Make a total of 6 each **Blocks 4a** and **4b**.









Repeat 6 times for 6 each units.

18. Arrange a marked Unit 2a right sides together on a Unit 2c, nesting seam allowances, with **Fabric M** triangles alternating.
Stitch along the two outside lines.
Cut along the center line. Press the 2 triangle sets open. Trim each to 4-1/2" square. Make a



total of 16 Unit 9.







Repeat 8 times for 16 units.

19. Arrange 1 **Fabric B** 4-1/2" square, 2 Unit 3a, 2 Unit 3b, and 4 Unit 9 in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 **Block 1** (12-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make


- 20. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.
- 21. Arrange **Blocks 1-3** in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together completing block center (36-1/2" square unfinished).
- 22. Arrange 3 **Block 4a**, **2 Block 5**, and **4 Block 6** on right and left sides of block center. Stitch into rows (4-1/2" x 36-1/2" unfinished). Sew to right and left sides of block center.
- 23. Arrange 2 **Fabric M** 4-1/2" squares, 3 **Block 4b**, **2 Block 5**, and **4 Block 6** above and below block center. Stitch into rows (4-1/2" x 44-1/2" unfinished). Sew to top and bottom of block center. Quilt center measures 44-1/2" square (unfinished).
- 24. Sew **Fabric L** 2-1/2" x 44-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric L** 2-1/2" x 48-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.
- 25. Sew **Fabric H** 2-1/2" x 48-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric N** 2-1/2" x 52-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

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- 26. Sew **Fabric A** 5" x 52-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- 27. Sew **Fabric N** 2-1/2" x 61-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric N** 2-1/2" x 56-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- 28. The quilt measures approximately 56-1/2" x 65-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric O**) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- 29. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric F**) and enjoy!!
