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

Α	So an	5" Square Pack CP5PRET-X	3 Packs	NOTE: Each 5" square yields (3) cut pieces; subcut (100) 2-1/2" squares, (100) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" and (100) 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles. Refer to DIAGRAM BELOW .
В		Ruby + Bee Solids: 51583-46 Cornflower	1-1/4	 (8) 1-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (50) 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" and (50) 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles. Border: (6) 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 3-1/2" x 63" and (2) 3-1/2" x 57" borders.
С		54472-2 Pouf	5/8	Binding: Cut into (7) 2-1/4" strips.
D		Ruby + Bee Solids: 51583-4 Peachy Keen	1/2	(8) 1-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (50) 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" and (50) 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles.
E		Ruby + Bee Solids: 51583-55 Wisp	1-3/8	(9) 4-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (81) 4-1/2" squares.
F		Ruby + Bee Solids: 51583-32 Marigold	1/2	 (2) 7" x WOF strips; subcut Setting Triangles: (9) 7" squares. Cut each on the diagonal twice for a total of (36) setting triangles. Corner Triangles: (2) 4" squares. Cut each on the diagonal once for a total of (4) corner triangles.
		Backing	4	70-1/2" x 70-1/2" piece of batting.



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
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


PIECED BLOCK


REFERENCE QUILT IMAGE FOR FABRIC PLACEMENT.

 Block 1: Sew (1) B 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangle to the left side of (1) print 2-1/2" square. Then sew (1) B 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle to the bottom of the unit.





- Sew (1) print 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle to the left side of the Step 1 unit. Finish by adding (1) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" of the same print rectangle to the bottom of the unit. Make (50) total of Block 1.
- 3. Block 2: Repeat Step 1-2 using **D** fabric, as shown.



QUILT ASSEMBLY

4. Pieced Diagonal Rows

Arrange and sew pieced **Blocks 1** and **2**, **E** 4-1/2" squares, **F** setting triangles (ST) and **F** corner triangles (CT) into rows, starting from left to right. Row 1 is shown.




- **5.** Sew **pieced diagonal rows** to complete quilt center. Trim quilt center to 1/4" beyond the seam intersections on outside edges of quilt center to approximately 57" square.
- 6. Border: Sew (2) B 3-1/2" x 57" strips to the opposite sides of the quilt center, followed by
 (2) B 3-1/2" x 63" strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center to complete the quilt top.

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QUILT ASSEMBLY



FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **C** 2-1/4" strips.
