Blue Harmony

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning. WOF = width of fabric. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

Fabric A - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 5-1/2" x 75" and (2) 5-1/2" x 55" wide floral stripe borders and (4) 2-1/2" x 45" narrow floral stripe borders

Fabric B - Cut (1) 8" strip, subcut (4) 8" squares and (1) 5-1/2" square

Cut (1) 5-1/2" strip, subcut (7) 5-1/2" squares

Fabric C - Cut (1) 7-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 7-1/2" squares

Fabric D - Cut (1) 8" strip, subcut (4) 8" squares

Fabric E - Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 3-1/2" squares and (1) 3" x 5-1/2" piece

Cut (1) 3" strip, subcut (7) 3" x 5-1/2" pieces

Fabric F - Cut (2) 3" strips, subcut (16) 3" squares

Fabric G - Cut (3) 3" strips, subcut (32) 3" squares

Fabric H - Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 3-1/2" squares

Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric I - Cut (3) 3" strips, subcut (32) 3" squares

Cut (6) 2" strips, subcut (12) 2" x 9-1/2" and (12) 2" x 8" pieces

Fabric J - Cut (1) 7-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 7-1/2" squares and (8) 3" squares

Cut (5) 3" strips, subcut (32) 3" x 5-1/2" and (8) 2" x 3" pieces

Fabric K - Cut (4) 3" strips, subcut (48) 3" squares

2. Piecing Order:

1. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of:



all **Fabrics F, G, I, and J** 3" squares
16 **Fabric K** 3" squares

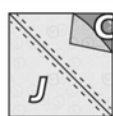
2. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side then draw 2 lines 1/4" on each side of first line on the following squares:



all **Fabric E** 3-1/2" squares
all **Fabric J** 7-1/2" squares

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

3. Arrange a marked **Fabric J** 7-1/2" square right sides together with a **Fabric C** 7-1/2" square aligning all edges. Stitch along the 2 outside lines. Cut along the center line. Press the 2 triangle sets open. Centering seam, trim each to 7" square. Make a total of 4 Unit 1.



Repeat 2 times for 4 units.



Unit 1
Make 4

4. Arrange a marked **Fabric E** 3-1/2" square right sides together with a **Fabric H** 3-1/2" square aligning all edges. Stitch along the 2 outside lines. Cut along the center line. Press the 2 triangle sets open. Centering seam, trim each to 3" square. Make a total of 4 Unit 2.



Repeat 2 times for 4 units.



Unit 2
Make 4

5. Arrange a marked **Fabric K** 3" square on an end of a **Fabric E** 3" x 5-1/2" piece as shown. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner out. Repeat on other end. Make a total of 8 Unit 3a (3" x 5-1/2" unfinished).



Unit 3a - Make 8

6. In the same manner, make 16 each Units 3b and 3c with fabrics indicated.



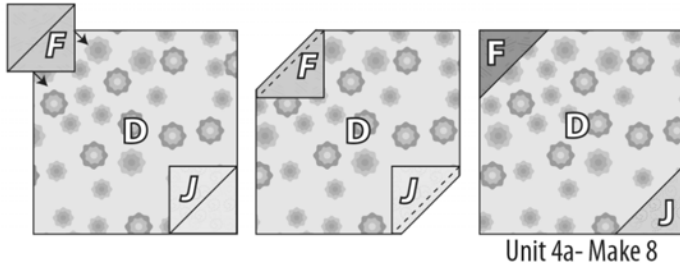

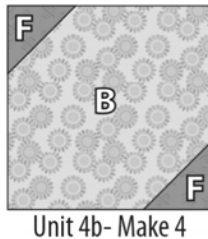

7. Arrange 1 each marked **Fabrics F** and **J** 3" squares on opposite corners of a **Fabric D** 8" square as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press corners out. Repeat on remaining corners. Make a total of 8 Unit 4a (8" square unfinished).



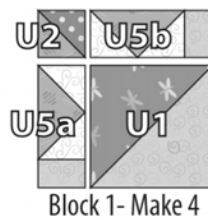
8. In the same manner, make 4 Unit 4b with fabrics indicated.



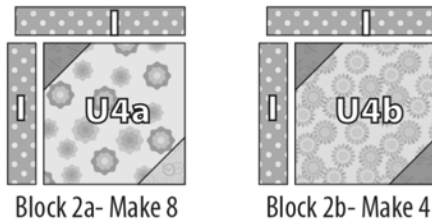
9. Stitch a **Fabric J** 2" x 3" piece to 1 end of a Unit 3a. Make a total of 4 each Units 5a and 5b (3" x 7" unfinished).



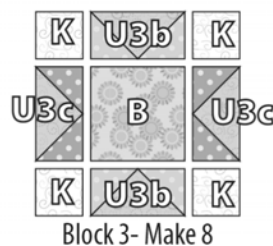
10. Arrange 1 each Units 1, 2, 5a, and 5b in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 **Block 1** (9-1/2" square unfinished).



11. Stitch a **Fabric I** 2" x 8" piece to left edge of a Unit 4a. Add a **Fabric I** 2" x 9-1/2" piece to the top. Make a total of 8 **Block 2a** (9-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 4 **Block 2b** with Unit 4b.



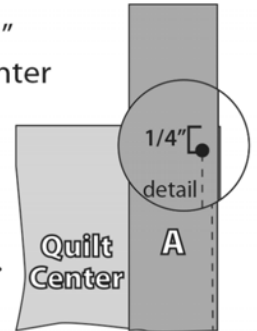
12. Arrange 2 each Units 3b and 3c, 1 **Fabric B** 5-1/2" square, and 4 **Fabric K** 3" squares in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 8 **Block 3** (10-1/2" square unfinished).



13. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.

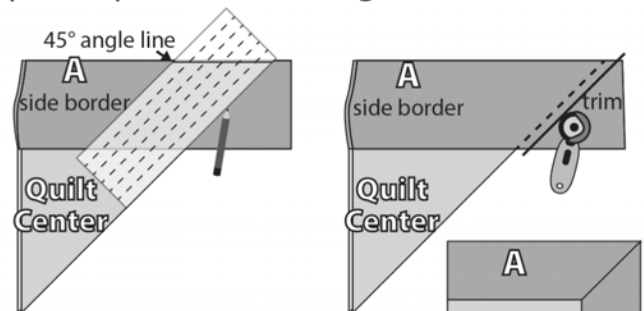
14. Arrange **Blocks 1, 2a, and 2b** in 4 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together completing quilt center (36-1/2" square unfinished).

15. Center **Fabric A** 2-1/2" x 45" borders on all sides of quilt center noting orientation of stripe. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.

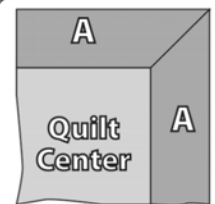


Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.
Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

16. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



17. Arrange 4 **Block 3** above and below bordered quilt center. Stitch into rows (10-1/2" x 40-1/2" unfinished). Sew to top and bottom of quilt.



18. Referring to Steps 15 and 16 add **Fabric A** 5-1/2" x 75" and 5-1/2" x 55" mitered borders.

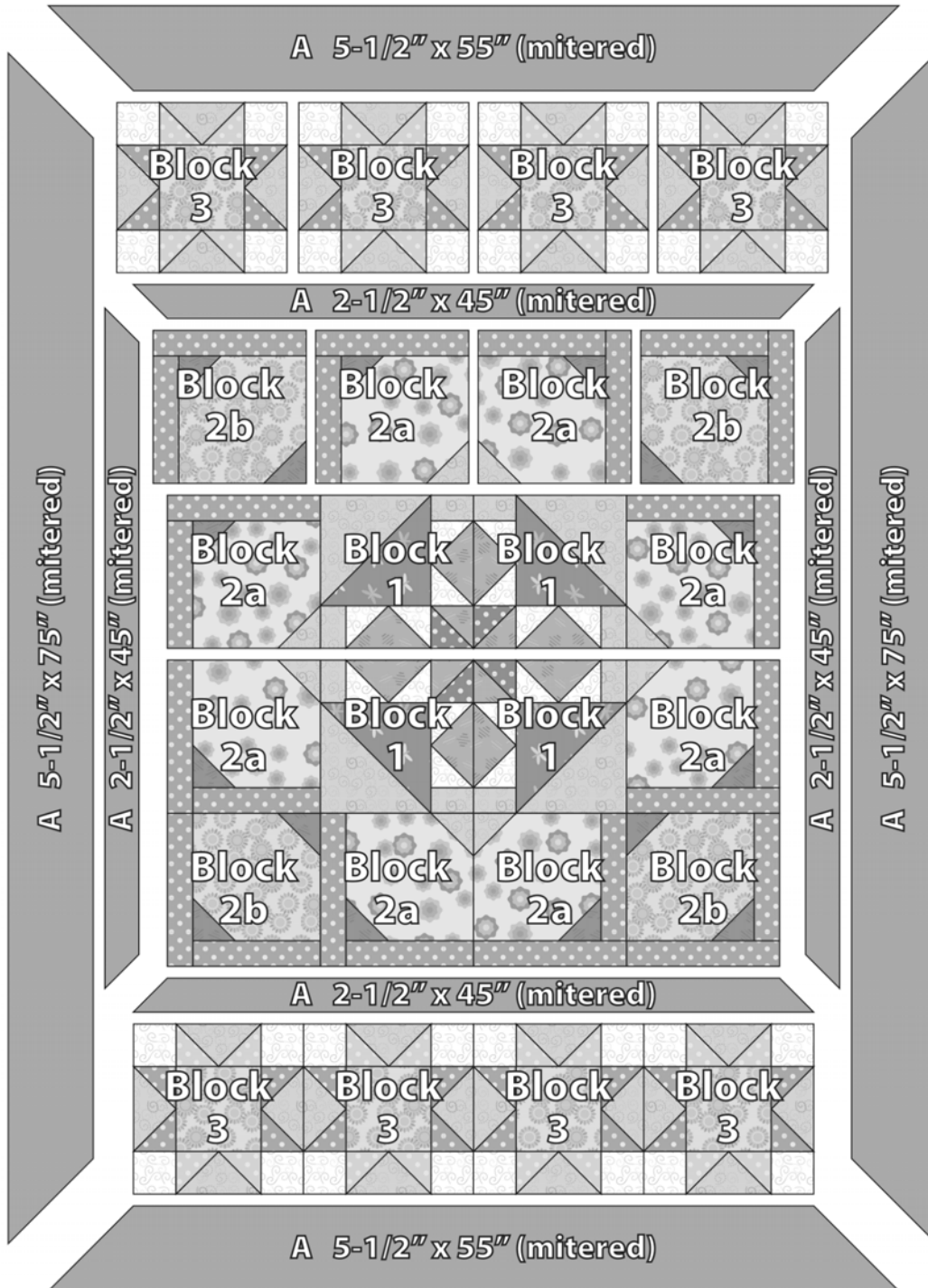
19. The quilt measures approximately 50-1/2" x 70-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric L**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

20. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric H**) and enjoy!!

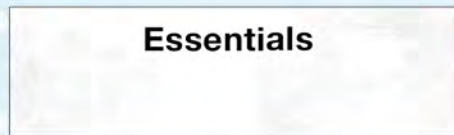
