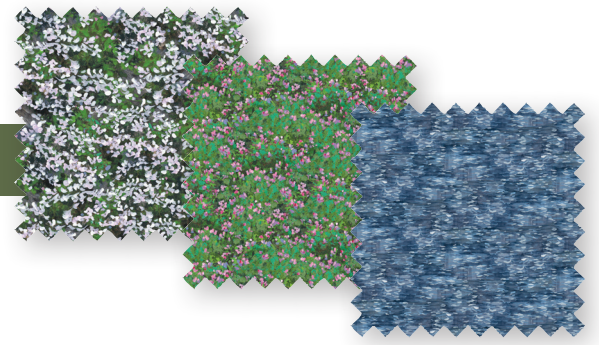

Fabric B	SMIL5698-GW.....	1/8 yard
Fabric C	SMIL5699-GP.....	3/8 yard
Fabric D	SMIL5700-B.....	5/8 yard
Fabric E	CSTO5226-DG.....	1 1/8 yards
Fabric F	CSTO5226-N.....	1/4 yard
Fabric G	SUED300-LZ.....	7/8 yard
Backing	3 yards
Batting	50" x 58"

Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric **WOF** (perpendicular to selvages) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

Fabric A:

- Fussy cut one 23" x 30 1/2" rectangle centered on the design.

Fabric B:

- Cut one 1 1/4" x WOF strip; sub-cut one 1 1/4" x 11 1/2" strip. **(Right Frame)**
- Cut one 1 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut one 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strip, one 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" strip, and one 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" strip. **(Blocks)**

Fabric C:

- Cut one 1 1/4" x WOF strip; sub-cut one 1 1/4" x 30 1/2" strip and one 1 1/4" x 8 1/2" strip. **(Left & Right Frame)**
- Cut one 1 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut one 1 1/2" x 24 1/2" strip. **(Top Frame)**
- Cut five 1 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut eight 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips; eight 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips and eight 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips. **(Blocks)**

Fabric D:

- Cut one 1 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut one 1 1/2" x 24 1/2" strip. **(Bottom Frame)**
- Cut two 1 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut three 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips, three 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips, and three 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips. **(Blocks/Bottom Frame)**
- Cut one 11 1/2" x WOF strip; cutting parallel to selvages, sub-cut one 1 1/2" x 11 1/2" strip. **(Right Frame)**

- Use the remainder of 11 1/2" strip, continue to cut parallel to selvages to cut two 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips, two 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips, and two 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips. **(Blocks)**

Fabric E:

- Cut sixteen 1 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut four 1 1/2" x 7 1/2" strips, thirty-two 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips, four 1 1/2" x 5 1/2" strips, thirty-two 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips, four 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" strips, and thirty-two 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" strips. **(Blocks)**
- Cut five 2 1/2" x WOF strips. **(Binding)**

Fabric F:

- Cut two 2 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut eighteen 2 1/2" squares. **(Blocks)**

Fabric G:

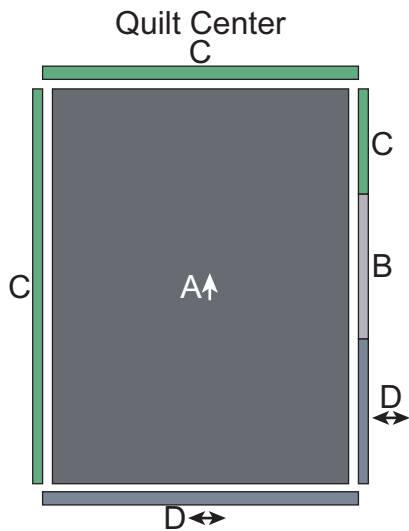
- Cut five 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Trim seams and press open. From this pieced strip, cut two 1 1/2" x 42 1/2" strips and two 1 1/2" x 48 1/2" strips. **(Outer Border)**
- Cut fourteen 1 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut eighteen 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips, four 1 1/2" x 7 1/2" strips, eighteen 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips, four 1 1/2" x 5 1/2" strips, eighteen 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips and four 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" strips. **(Blocks)**

Piecing Instructions:

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations while assembling the various components. The arrows in diagrams represent the fabric print direction.

1. Sew one 1 1/4" x 30 1/2" **Fabric C** strip to the left side of the **Fabric A** rectangle; press. (Diagram 1)
2. Sew together one 1 1/4" x 8 1/2" **Fabric C** strip, one 1 1/4" x 11 1/2" **Fabric B** strip and one 1 1/4" x 11 1/2" **Fabric D** strip end to end and in that order from top to bottom. Sew the newly sewn strip to the right side of the **Fabric A** rectangle; press. (Diagram 1)
3. Sew 1 1/2" x 24 1/2" **Fabric C** strip to the top of the **Fabric A** rectangle; press. (Diagram 1)

4. Sew 1 1/2" x 24 1/2" **Fabric D** strip to the bottom of the **Fabric A** rectangle to make the 24 1/2" x 32 1/2" Quilt Center; press. (Diagram 1)

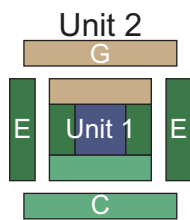


Make (1) = 24 1/2" x 32 1/2" unfinished

5. Sew one 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" **Fabric E** strip to each side of one 2 1/2" **Fabric F** square. Sew one 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" **Fabric G** strip to the top of the newly sewn strip and one 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" **Fabric C** strip to the bottom of the newly sewn strip to make one 4 1/2" Unit 1 square. (Diagram 2) Repeat to make eight Unit 1 squares total.
6. Sew one 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" **Fabric E** strip to each side of one Unit 1 square. Sew one 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" **Fabric G** strip to the top of the Unit 1 square and one 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" **Fabric C** strip to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make one 6 1/2" Unit 2 square. (Diagram 3) Repeat to make eight Unit 2 squares total.



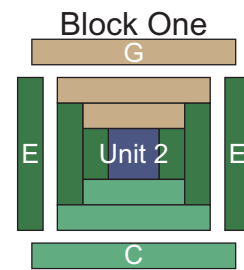
Make (8) = 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" unfinished

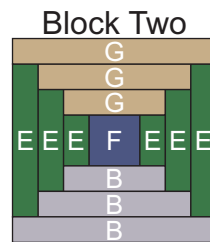
7. Sew one 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" **Fabric E** strip to each side of one Unit 2 square. Sew one 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" **Fabric G** strip to the top of the Unit 2 square and one 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" **Fabric C** strip to the bottom of the Unit 2 square to make one 8 1/2" Block One square. (Diagram 4) Repeat to make eight Block

One squares total.

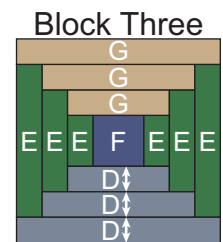


Make (8) = 8 1/2" x 8 1/2" unfinished

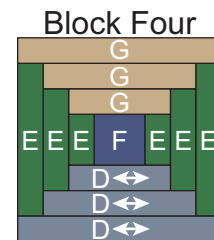
8. Repeat Steps 5-7 and refer to Diagrams 5-6 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make one Block Two square and two Block Three square and three Block Four squares.

9. Sew one 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" **Fabric E** strip to the bottom of one 2 1/2" **Fabric F** square. Sew one 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" **Fabric E** strip to the right side of the newly sewn strip to make one 3 1/2" Unit 3 square. (Diagram 8) Repeat to make four Unit 3 squares total.

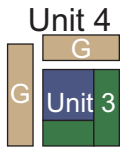


Make (4) = 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" unfinished

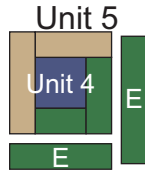
10. Sew one 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" **Fabric G** strip to the top of one Unit 3 square. Sew one 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" **Fabric G** strip to the left side of the Unit 3 square to make one 4 1/2" Unit 4 square.

(Diagram 9) Repeat to make four Unit 4 squares total.

- Sew one 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" **Fabric E** strip to the bottom of one Unit 4 square. Sew one 1 1/2" x 5 1/2" **Fabric E** strip to the right side of the Unit 4 square to make one 5 1/2" Unit 5 square. (Diagram 10) Repeat to make four Unit 5 squares total.

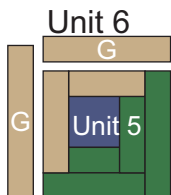


Make (4) = 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" unfinished

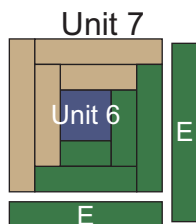


Make (4) = 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" unfinished

- Sew one 1 1/2" x 5 1/2" **Fabric G** strip to the top of one Unit 5 square. Sew one 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" **Fabric G** strip to the left side of the Unit 5 square to make one 6 1/2" Unit 6 square. (Diagram 11) Repeat to make four Unit 6 squares total.

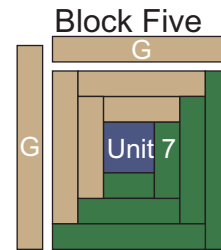


Make (4) = 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" unfinished

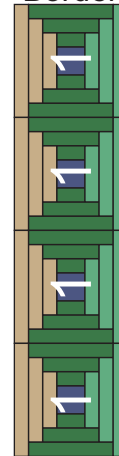
- Sew one 1 1/2" x 7 1/2" **Fabric G** strip to the top of one Unit 7 square. Sew one 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" **Fabric G** strip to the left side of the Unit 7 square to make one 8 1/2" Block Five square. (Diagram 13) Repeat to make four Block Five squares total.



Make (4) = 8 1/2" x 8 1/2" unfinished

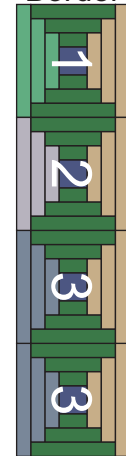
- Sew together four Block One squares to make the 8 1/2" x 32 1/2" Left Side Border. (Diagram 14)
- Sew together one Block One square, one Block Two square and two Block Three squares, in that order from top to bottom, to make the 8 1/2" x 32 1/2" Right Side Border. (Diagram 15)

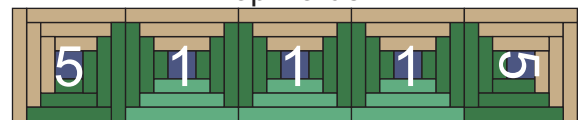
Right Side Border

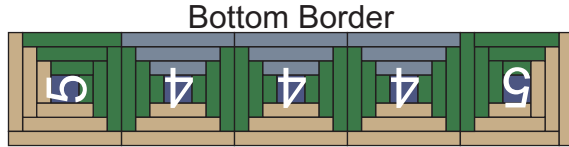
- Sew together one Block Five square, three Block One squares and one Block Five square, in that order from left to right, to make the 8 1/2" x 40 1/2" Top Border. (Diagram 16)

18. Sew together one Block Five square, three Block Four squares and one Block Five square, in that order from left to right, to make the 8 1/2" x 40 1/2" Bottom Border. (Diagram 17)



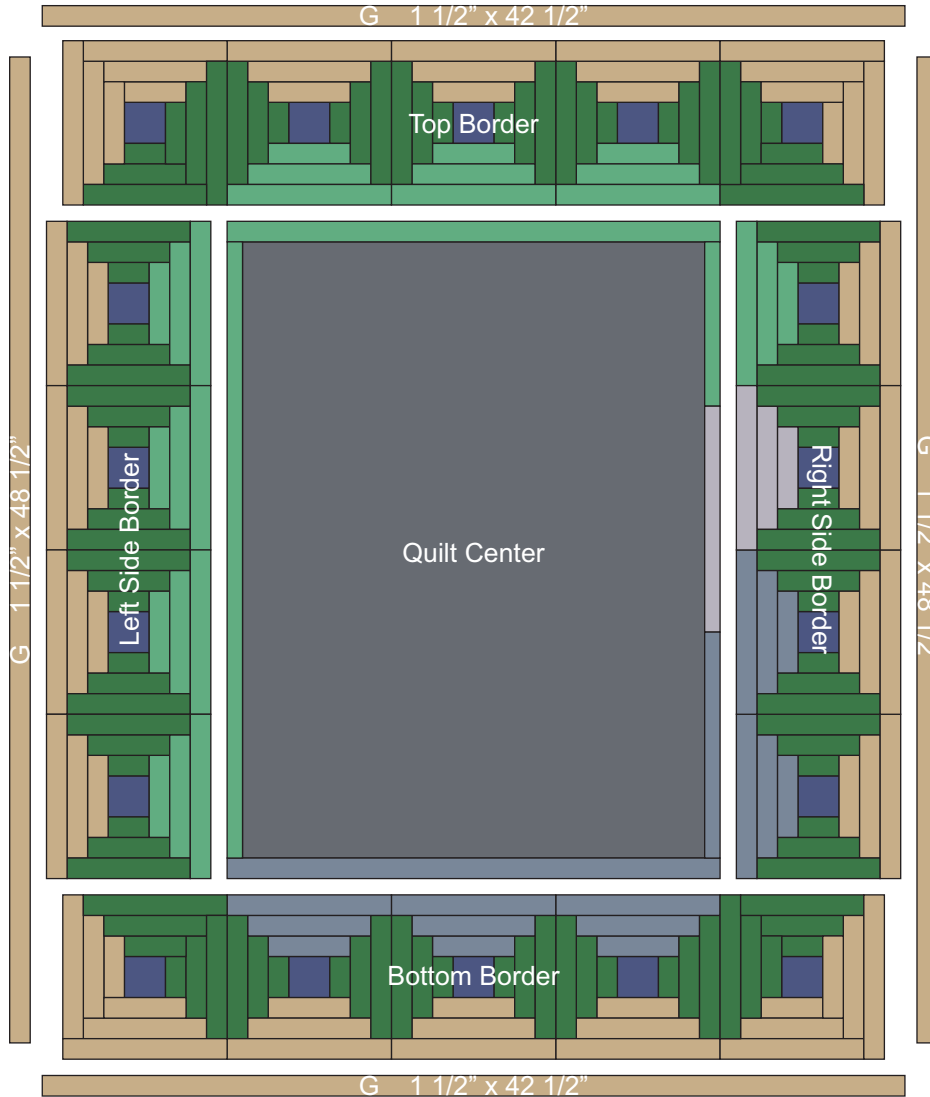

Quilt Assembly:

19. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and right sides of the Quilt Center. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Quilt Center.
20. Sew one 1 1/2" x 48 1/2" **Fabric G** strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew one 1 1/2" x 42 1/2" **Fabric G** strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center to make the quilt top.

Finishing:

21. Prepare backing using two widths of fabric with a horizontal seam. Press seams open. Trim to 50" x 58".
22. Layer the quilt, batting and backing. Baste layers together.
23. Quilt as desired.
24. Trim layers even with quilt top, squaring corners.
25. Attach 2 1/2" **Fabric E** binding strips using your favorite method.



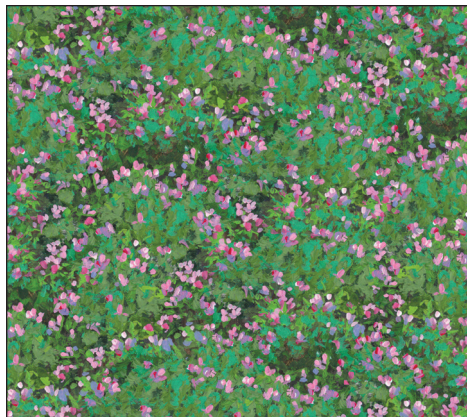
Quilt Diagram

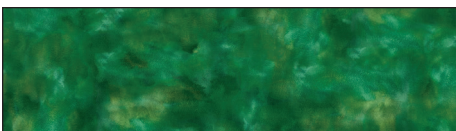

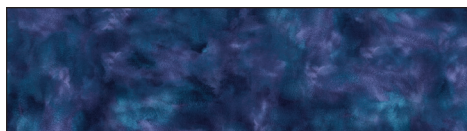
