

## Cutting Instructions (Both version)

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric WOF (perpendicular to selvedges) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

#### Fabric A:

 Cut four 8 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut fifteen 8 1/2" X 8 1/2" squares. (Blocks)

#### Fabric B:

 Cut four 8 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut fifteen 8 1/2" X 8 1/2" squares. (Blocks)

#### Fabric C:

• Cut eight 2 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut fifteen 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles and fifteen 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangles. (Blocks)

#### Fabric D:

- Cut ten 2 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut fifteen 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangles and fifteen 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles. (Blocks)
- Cut seven 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips

together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two 2 1/2" x 64 1/2" strips and two 2 1/2 x 72 1/2" strips. (Borders)

#### Fabric E:

 Cut ten 2 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut fifteen 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangles and fifteen 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles. (Blocks)

#### Fabric F:

• Cut eight 2 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut fifteen 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles and fifteen 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangles. (Blocks)


#### Fabric G:


Cut eight 2 1/4" x WOF strips. (Binding)


## Piecing Instructions (Both Version

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations while assembling the various components.

- Sew one 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric C rectangle to the left side of one 8 1/2" Fabric A square. Sew one 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" Fabric C rectangle to the bottom of the **Fabric A** square to make one 10 1/2" Unit 1 square. (Diagram 1) Repeat to make fifteen Unit 1 squares total.
- Sew one 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric F rectangle to the left side of one 8 1/2" Fabric B square. Sew one 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" Fabric F rectangle to the bottom of the Fabric B square to make one 10 1/2" Unit 2 square. (Diagram 2) Repeat to make fifteen Unit 2 squares total.






- 3. Sew one 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" **Fabric E** rectangle to the left side of one Unit 1 square. Sew one 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" **Fabric E** rectangle to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make one 12 1/2" Block One square. (Diagram 3) Repeat to make fifteen Block One squares total.
- 4. Sew one 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" **Fabric D** rectangle to the left side of one Unit 2 square. Sew one 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" **Fabric D** rectangle to the bottom of the Unit 2 square to make one 12 1/2" Block Two square. (Diagram 4) Repeat to make fifteen Block Two squares total.






Make (15) = 12 1/2" x 12 1/2" unfinished Diagram 3

- Sew together three Block One squares and two Block Two squares, alternating them from left to right, to make Row One. (Diagram 5) Repeat to make Row Three and Row Five.
- 6. Sew together three Block Two squares and two Block One squares, alternating them from left to right, to make Row Two. (Diagram 5) Repeat to make Row Four and Row Six.
- 7. Sew together the six pieced Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 60 1/2" x 72 1/2" Quilt Center. (Diagram 5)




Make (1) = 60 1/2" x 72 1/2" unfinished Diagram 5

### Quilt Assembly:

Sew one 2 1/2" x 72" Fabric D strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew one 2 1/2" x 64 1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center to make the quilt top.

### Finishing:

- Prepare backing using two widths of fabric with a horizontal seam. Press seams open. Trim to 72" x 84".
- 10. Layer the quilt, batting and backing. Baste layers together.
- 11. Quilt as desired.
- 12. Trim layers even with quilt top, squaring corners.
- 13. Attach 2 1/4" **Fabric G** binding strips using your favorite method.
