# Timberland Trails By Fluidity



Throw Quilt 55-1/2" x 74-1/2"



Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

#### 1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

**Fabric A** - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, panels have a coping border added then trimmed so they will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of 2 panels to approximately 9" x 23-1/2" and 4 panels to approximately 11-1/2" square

**Fabric B** - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 8-3/4" x 46" multi-stripe borders, 1 with animal stripe on top, 1 with animal stripe on bottom

**Fabric C** - Cut (1) 6-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 6-1/2" squares

Fabric D - Cut (6) 5-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 5-1/2" x 65" and (2) 5-1/2" x 56" borders
Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 3-1/2" squares

**Fabric E** - Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (4) 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" and (4) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips

**Fabric F** - Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (8) 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" strips

**Fabric G** - Cut (4) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (24) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips

Fabric H - Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

**Fabric I** - Cut (5) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (48) 3-1/2" squares and (8) 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" pieces

**Fabric J** - Cut (6) 1-1/4" strips, subcut (8) 1-1/4" x 13" and (8) 1-1/4" x 12" strips

**Fabric K** - Cut (4) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (4) 1-1/2" x 24" and (4) 1-1/2" x 11" strips

**Fabric L** - Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (16) 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" pieces

#### 2. Piecing Order:

1. Stitch **Fabric K**1-1/2" x 24" strips to sides of a 9" x 23-1/2" **Fabric A**panel. Trim strip ends even.
Add 1-1/2" x 11" **Fabric K**strips to top and bottom of panel. *Trim bordered panel*to 10" x 24-1/2" (unfinished).
Make a total of 2 **Block 1**.



#### 2. Stitch Fabric J

1-1/4" x 12" strips to sides of an 11-1/2" square **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-1/4" x 13" **Fabric J** strips to top and bottom of panel. *Trim bordered panel to 12-1/2" square (unfinished)*. Make a total of 4 **Block 2**.






3. Stitch a **Fabric D** 3-1/2" square to end of a **Fabric E** 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" strip. Make a total of 4 Unit 1 (3-1/2" x 12-1/2" unfinished).




4. Stitch a **Fabric E** 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" strip to the left of a **Fabric C** 6-1/2" square. Add a **Fabric F** 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" strip to the top and then a **Fabric F** 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" strip to the right side of the unit. Make a total of 2 Unit 2a (9-1/2" x 12-1/2" unfinished). In a similar manner, make 2 Unit 2b noting orientation and placement of strips.


4. Stitch a **Fabric E** 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" strip to the left of a Fabric C 6-1/2" square. Add a Fabric F 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" strip to the top and the a Fabric F 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" strip to the right side of the unit. Make a total of 2 Unit 2a (9-1/2" x 12-1/2" unfinished). In a similar manner, make 2 Unit 2b noting orientation and placement of strips.



5. Stitch a Unit 1 to each Unit 2a and 2b as shown. Make a total of 2 each Blocks 3 and 4 (12-1/2" square unfinished).

6. Sew a **Fabric I** 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" piece between 2 Fabric L 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" pieces as shown. Make a total of 8 Unit 3  $(3-1/2" \times 6-1/2" \text{ unfinished}).$ 





7. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of all the Fabric I 3-1/2" squares only as shown.




Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

8. Arrange a marked **Fabric I** 3-1/2" square on 1 end of a **Fabric G** 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" piece as shown. Stitch along the marked line. Trim




seam allowance to 1/4". Press triangle out. Repeat on opposite end of the **Fabric G** piece. Make a total of 24 Unit 4 (3-1/2" x 6-1/2" unfinished).

- 9. Arrange 3 Unit 4 and 1 Unit 3 in a vertical row. Stitch units together. Make a total of 8 Block 5 (6-1/2 x 12-1/2 unfinished).
- 10. Referring to Quilt Center Layout arrange Blocks 2-5 in 4 rows. Stitch blocks into rows. Sew the top 2 rows together and add a Block 1 to the left

side. Stitch bottom 2 rows together and sew the remaining **Block 1** to the right. Sew top and bottom halves of the quilt center together (46" x 48-1/2" unfinished)



- 11. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 4 for arrangement and placement of quilt center and borders.
- 12. Sew **Fabric B** 8-3/4" x 46" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.


