# CHICKADEE CHARM

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning. WOF = width of fabric.  
All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

## 1. Cut the following:

**Fabric A** - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the panel will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of panel to approximately 23-1/2" x 42"

**Fabric B** - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 5-1/2" x 84" and (2) 5-1/2" x 62" wide stripe borders. Fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 2-3/4" x 53" and (2) 2-3/4" x 34" narrow stripe borders.

**Fabrics C and D** - From each fabric:  
Cut (5) 2-1/2" strips

**Fabric E** - Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips

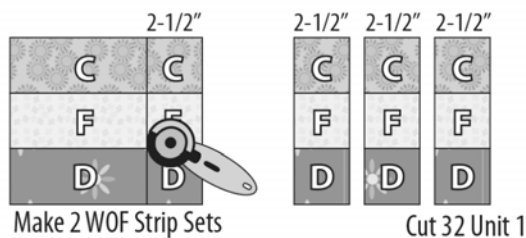
**Fabric F** - Cut (4) 2-1/2" strips  
Cut (6) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 66-1/2" and (2) 2" x 48-1/2" borders

**Fabric G** - Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 2-1/2" x 27" strips  
Cut (2) 2" strips

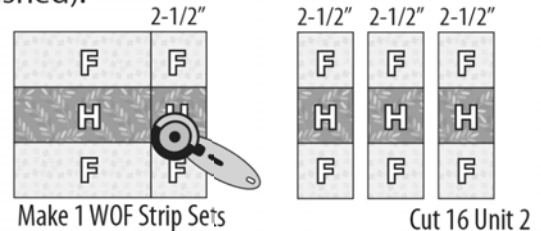
**Fabric H** - Cut (2) 3" strips, subcut (2) 3" x 33-1/2" borders  
Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)  
Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip  
Cut (6) 2-1/4" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/4" x 49-1/2" borders

## 2. Piecing Order:

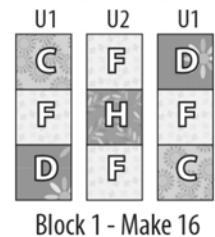
1. Stitch a **Fabric F** 2-1/2" x WOF strip between 1 each **Fabrics C** and **D** 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Make a total of 2 strip sets. From these, cut (32) 2-1/2" wide Unit 1 (2-1/2" x 6-1/2" unfinished).



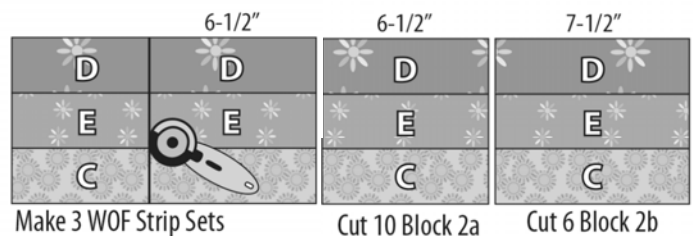
2. Stitch a **Fabric H** 2-1/2" x WOF strip between 2 **Fabric F** 2-1/2" x WOF strips. From this, cut (16) 2-1/2" wide Unit 2 (2-1/2" x 6-1/2" unfinished).



3. Stitch a Unit 2 between 2 Unit 1. Make a total of 16 **Block 1** (6-1/2" square unfinished).



4. Stitch a **Fabric E** 2-1/2" x WOF strip between 1 each **Fabrics C** and **D** 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Make a total of 3 strip sets. From these, cut (10) 6-1/2" wide **Block 2a** (6-1/2" square unfinished) and (6) 7-1/2" wide **Block 2b** (6-1/2" x 7-1/2" unfinished).

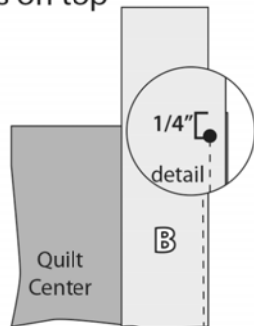


5. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.

6. Stitch **Fabric G** 2" x width of fabric strips to sides of the **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 2-1/2" x 27" **Fabric G** strips to top and bottom of panel. *Trim bordered panel to 25-1/2" x 45" (unfinished).*

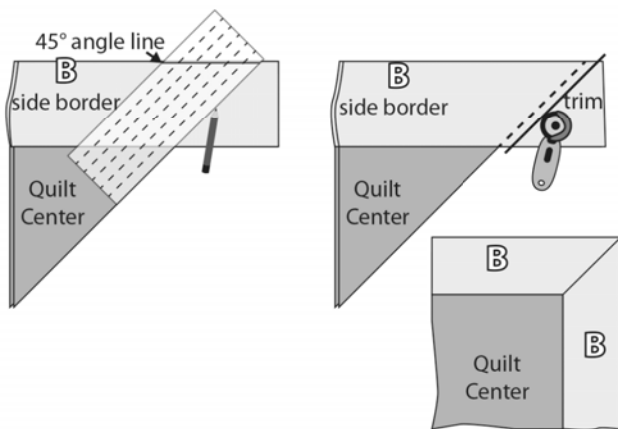

7. Center **Fabric B** 2-3/4" x 53" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and **Fabric B** 2-3/4" x 34" borders on top and bottom of quilt center noting orientation of stripe. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.



*Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.  
Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.*

8. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



9. Sew **Fabric H** 2-1/4" x 49-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric H** 3" x 33-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

10. Arrange 4 **Block 1** and 5 **Block 2a** in vertical rows on right and left sides of quilt. Stitch into side borders (6-1/2" x 54-1/2" unfinished). Sew to right and left sides of quilt.

11. Arrange 4 **Block 1** and 3 **Block 2b** in horizontal rows above and below quilt. Stitch into top/bottom borders (6-1/2" x 45-1/2" unfinished). Sew to top and bottom of quilt.

12. Sew **Fabric F** 2" x 66-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric F** 2" x 48-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

13. Referring to Steps 7 and 8 add **Fabric B** 5-1/2" x 84" mitered borders on right and left sides of quilt center and **Fabric B** 5-1/2" x 62" mitered borders on top and bottom of quilt center noting orientation of stripe.

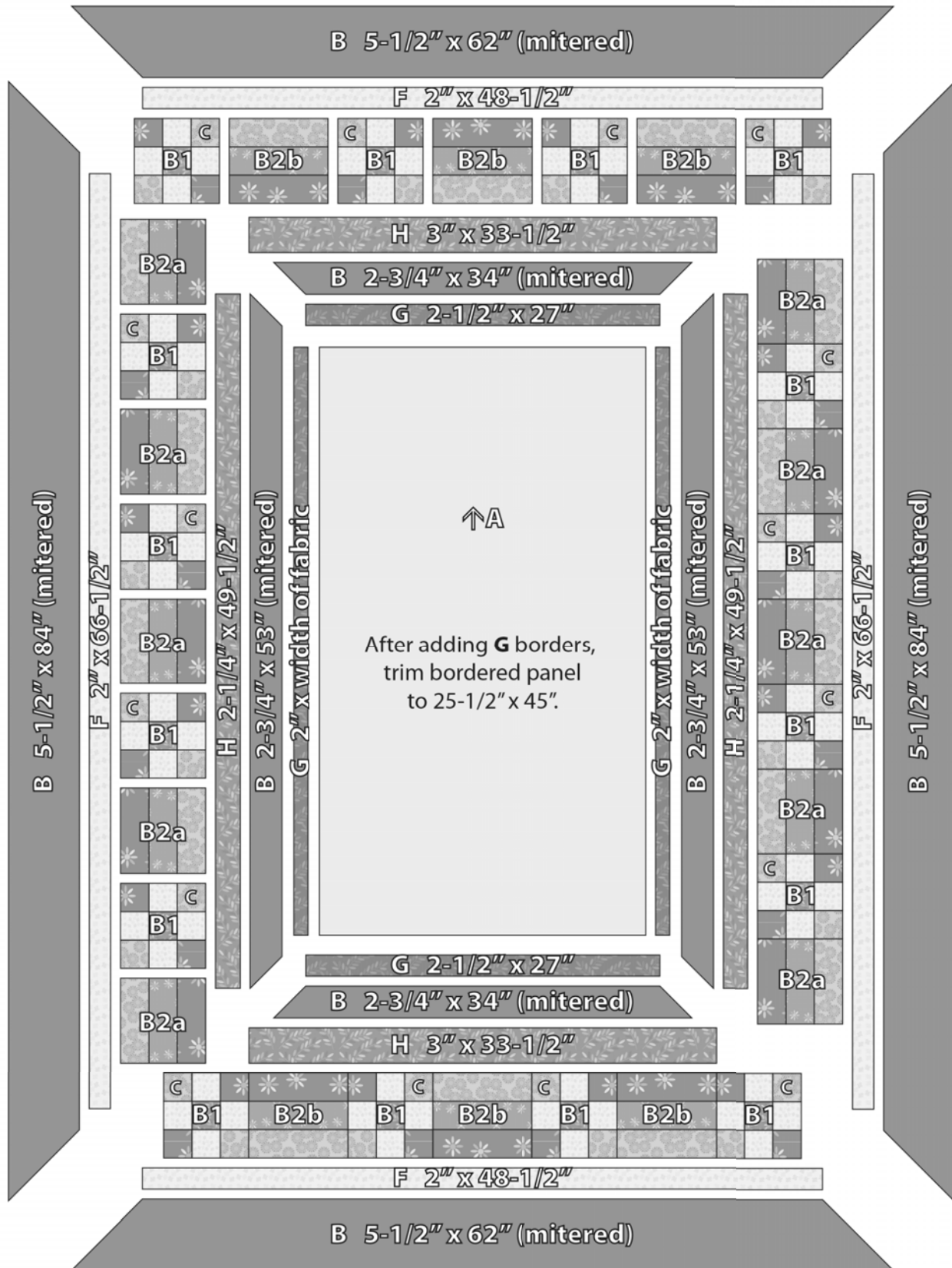
14. The quilt measures approximately 58-1/2" x 79-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric I**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

15. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric H**) and enjoy!!

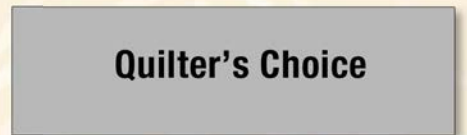
