Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric **WOF** (perpendicular to selvedges) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

Fabric A:

- Cut one 1 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut two 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles, one 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles and one 1 1/2" x 15 1/2" rectangles. (Canoe Block)
- Cut one 3 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut one 3 1/2" x 13 1/2" and one 1 1/2" x 2" rectangles; two 1" x 1", two 1 1/2" x 1 1/2", one 2" x 2" and one 3" x 3" squares. (Canoe Block)
- Cut two 2 1/4" x WOF strips; sub-cut eighteen 2 1/4" x 2 1/4" and squares three 1 3/4" x 1 3/4" squares. (Bear Paw Blocks)

Fabric B:

Cut one 4 1/4" x WOF strip; sub-cut three
 4 1/4" x 4 1/4" squares. (Bear Paw Blocks)

Fabric C:

 Cut one 3" x WOF strip; sub-cut three 3" x 5 1/2" rectangles. (Flying Geese)

Fabric D:

 Cut one 8" x WOF strip; sub-cut one 8" x 8" square and three 4 1/4" x 4 1/4" squares. (Bear Paw Blocks)

Fabric E:

Cut one 4 1/4" x WOF strip; sub-cut three
 4 1/4" x 4 1/4" squares. (Bear Paw Blocks)

Fabric F:

- Cut one 1 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut two 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles, one 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangle and one 1 1/2" x 15 1/2" rectangles. (Canoe Block)
- Cut one 3 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut one 3 1/2" x 13 1/2" rectangle, one 1 1/2" x 2" rectangle, two 1" x 1" squares, two 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares, one 2" x 2" square and one 3" x 3" square.
 (Canoe Block)
- Cut one 2 1/4" x WOF strip; sub-cut nine 2 1/4" x 2 1/4" squares and three 1 3/4" x 1 3/4" squares. (Bear Paw Blocks)
- Cut one 3 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut three 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares, one 3" x 3" square and three 3" x 5 1/2" rectangles. (Bear Paw Blocks/ Flying Geese)

Fabric G:

- Cut one 2 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut two 2 1/2" x 4" rectangles and two 2 1/2" x 7 1/2" rectangles, four 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares and two 2" x 2" squares. (Canoe Blocks)
- Cut one 2 1/4" x WOF strip; sub-cut nine 2 1/4" x 2 1/4" squares. (Bear Paw Blocks)
- Cut one 3 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut three 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares. (Bear Paw Blocks)

Fabric H:

 Cut one 2 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut two 2 1/2" x 15 1/2" rectangles. (Canoe Blocks)

Fabric I:

 Cut one 3" x WOF strip; sub-cut twelve 3" x 3" squares. (Flying Geese)

Fabric J:

 Cut four 2 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut two 2 1/2" x 30 1/2" and two 2 1/2" x 34 1/2" strips. (Outer Border)

Fabric K:

- Cut one 1 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut two 1 1/2" x 15 1/2" rectangles. (Canoe Blocks)
- Cut one 2 1/4" x WOF strip; sub-cut nine 2 1/4" x 2 1/4" squares. (Bear Paw Blocks)
- Cut four 2 1/4" x WOF strips. (Binding)

Fabric L:

 Cut one 3 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut two 3 1/2" x 8" rectangles, two 1" x 11" rectangles and two 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares. (Paddle Blocks)

Fabric M:

- Cut one 3 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut two 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares, two 1 1/2" x 2" rectangles and two 2 1/2" x 3" rectangles. (Canoe Blocks)
- Cut one 1" x WOF strip; sub-cut four 1" x 1" squares, eight 3/4" x 3/4" squares and four 1" x 3 1/2" rectangles. (Paddle Blocks)
- Cut four 1 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut eight 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares and four 1 1/2" x 20 1/2" rectangles. (Paddle Blocks)
- Cut two 1 3/4" x WOF strips; sub-cut four 1 3/4" x 11" rectangles. (Paddle Blocks)
- Cut one 2 1/4" x WOF strip; sub-cut nine 2 1/4" x 2 1/4" and three 1 3/4" x 1 3/4" squares. (Bear Paw Blocks)

Piecing Instructions:

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations while assembling the various components.

1. Place one 3" **Fabric I** square on the top of one 3" x 5 1/2" **Fabric C** rectangle, right sides together. (Diagram 1) Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner. (Diagram 1) Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. (Diagram 2)









- 2. Place another 3" **Fabric I** square on the bottom of the **Fabric C** rectangle strip, right sides together. (Diagram 3) Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. (Diagram 3) Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make one Block One rectangle. (Diagram 4)
- 3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make an additional two Block One rectangles.

 Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to Diagram 5 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make three Block Two rectangles.

5. Place one 2 1/4" **Fabric A** square on top of one 2 1/4" **Fabric M** square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square. (Diagram 6) Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line. (Diagram 6) Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 7) to make two half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 1 3/4" to make two Unit 1 squares. (Diagram 8) Repeat to make an additional sixteen Unit 1 squares.

 Repeat Step 5 and refer to Diagrams 9-10 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make eighteen Unit 2 squares and eighteen Unit 3 squares.



 Repeat Step 5 and refer to Diagram 11 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction while using 3 1/2" Fabric F and Fabric G squares to make six 3" Unit 4 squares.

 Repeat Step 5 and refer to Diagrams 12-13 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction while using 2" Fabric A, Fabric F and Fabric G squares to make two 1 1/2" Unit 5 squares and two 1 1/2" Unit 6 squares.





9. Sew together three Unit 1 squares. Sew the newly sewn rectangle to the right side of one 4 1/4" **Fabric D** square. Sew together three Unit 1 squares and one 1 3/4" **Fabric M** square in that order from left to right. Sew the newly sewn rectangle to the top of the **Fabric D** square to make one 5 1/2" Block Three square. (Diagram 14). Repeat to make two additional Block Three squares.



 Repeat Step 9 and refer to Diagrams 15-16 for fabric/unit identification, placement and orientation to make three Block Four squares and three Block Five squares.





11. Sew together three Unit 4 squares. Sew the newly sewn rectangle to the right side of one 8" **Fabric D** square. Sew together three Unit 4 squares and one 3" **Fabric F** square in that order from left to right. Sew the newly sewn rectangle to the top of the **Fabric D** square to make one 10 1/2" Block Six square. (Diagram 17).

12. Sew together one Block Three square, one Block Four square and one Block Five square, in that order from left to right, to make the top row. Sew together three Block One rectangles and three Block Two rectangles, alternating them from left to right, to make the bottom row. Sew together the two rows lengthwise to make one 15 1/2" x 10 1/2" Unit 7 rectangle. (Diagram 18)





13. Sew one Block Four square to the top of one Block Three square to make one 5 1/2" x 10 1/2" Unit 8 rectangle. (Diagram 19)





14. Sew together the Unit 7 rectangle, Block Six square and Unit 8 rectangle, in that order from left to right, to make the 30 1/2" x 10 1/2" Center Top. (Diagram 20).




15. Place one 1" **Fabric M** square on the top left corner of one 3 1/2" x 8" **Fabric L** rectangle, right sides together. (Diagram 21) Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. (Diagram 21) Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam. (Diagram 22)



16. Follow Diagram 23 for the seam direction to add a 1" Fabric M square to the top right corner and 1 1/2" Fabric M squares to the bottom right and left corners of the 3 1/2" x 8" **Fabric L** rectangle to make one Unit 9 square. (Diagram 24) Repeat to make a second Unit 9 rectangle.



17. Sew one 1 3/4" x 11" **Fabric M** rectangle to each side of one 1" x 11" **Fabric L** rectangle lengthwise to make one 3 1/2" x 11" Unit 10 rectangle. (Diagram 25) Repeat to make a second Unit 10 rectangle.


18. Place one 3/4" **Fabric M** square on the top left corner of one 1 1/2" **Fabric L** square, right sides together. (Diagram 26) Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. (Diagram 26) Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam. (Diagram 27)



19. Follow Diagram 28 for the seam direction to add a 3/4" Fabric M square to each of the remaining corners of the 1 1/2" Fabric L square to make one Unit 11 square. (Diagram 29) Repeat to make a second Unit 11 square.



20. Sew one 1 1/2" **Fabric M** square to each side of one Unit 11 square to make one 3 1/2" x 1 1/2" Unit 12 rectangle. (Diagram 30) Repeat to make a second Unit 12 rectangle.

- 21. Sew together one Unit 9 rectangle, one Unit 10 rectangle and one Unit 12 rectangle, in that order from top to bottom, to make one 3 1/2" x 19 1/2" Unit 13 rectangle. (Diagram 31) Repeat to make a second Unit 13 rectangle.
- 22. Sew one 1" x 3 1/2" Fabric M rectangle to the top and bottom of one Unit 13 rectangle. Sew one 1 1/2" x 20 1/2" Fabric M rectangle to each side of the Unit 13 rectangle to make one 5 1/2" x 20 1/2" Block Seven rectangle. (Diagram 32) Repeat to make a second Block Seven rectangle.




23. Place one 3 1/2" Fabric M square on the right side of one 3 1/2" x 13 1/2" Fabric A rectangle, right sides together. (Diagram 33) Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. (Diagram 33) Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind


the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam. (Diagram 34)



24. Follow Diagram 35 for the seam direction to add a 3" Fabric A square to the lower right corner of the 3 1/2" x 13 1/2" Fabric A rectangle to make one Unit 14 rectangle. (Diagram 36)



25. Repeat Steps 23-24 and refer to Diagram 37 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make one Unit 15 rectangle.

26. Place one 1 1/2" Fabric A square on the left side of one 2" x 1 1/2" Fabric M rectangle, right sides together. (Diagram 38) Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. (Diagram 38) Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam. (Diagram 39)

- 27. Follow Diagram 40 for the seam direction to add a 1 1/2" **Fabric A** square to the right side of the 2" x 1 1/2" Fabric M rectangle to make one Unit 16 rectangle. (Diagram 41)
- 28. Repeat Steps 26-27 and refer to Diagram 42 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make one Unit 17 rectangle.





29. Repeat Steps 26-27 and refer to Diagram 43 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction while using 2 1/2" Fabric G squares and 3" x 2 1/2" Fabric M rectangles to make two Unit 18 rectangles.



30. Sew together one Unit 5 square, one 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" **Fabric A** rectangle, one Unit 16 rectangle, one 1 1/2" x 2" **Fabric A** rectangle and one Unit 5 square, in that order from left to right, to make one 13 1/2" x 1 1/2" Unit 19 rectangle. (Diagram 44).




31. Sew together one Unit 6 square, one 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" **Fabric F** rectangle, one Unit 17 rectangle, one 1 1/2" x 2" **Fabric F** rectangle and one Unit 6 square, in that order from left to right, to make one 13 1/2" x 1 1/2" Unit 20 rectangle. (Diagram 45).




32. Place one 1" **Fabric A** square on the lower left corner of one 2 1/2" x 7 1/2" **Fabric G** rectangle, right sides together. (Diagram 46) Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner. (Diagram 46) Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam to make one Unit 21 rectangle. (Diagram 47)




33. Repeat Step 32 and refer to Diagram 48 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make one Unit 22 rectangles.



34. Repeat Step 32 and refer to Diagrams 49-50 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction while using 1" Fabric A and Fabric F squares and 2 1/2" x 4" Fabric G rectangles to make one Unit 23 rectangle and one Unit 24 rectangle.



35. Sew together one Unit 21 rectangle, one Unit 18 rectangle and one Unit 23 rectangle, in that order from left to right, to make one 13 1/2" x 2 1/2" Unit 25 rectangle. (Diagram 51)



36. Sew together one Unit 22 rectangle, one Unit 18 rectangle and one Unit 24 rectangle, in that order from left to right, to make one 13 1/2" x 2 1/2" Unit 26 rectangle. (Diagram 52)







41. Sew together one 1 1/2" x 15 1/2" **Fabric A** rectangle, one Unit 29 rectangle, one 2 1/2" x 15 1/2" **Fabric H** rectangle and one 1 1/2" x 15 1/2" **Fabric K** rectangle, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make one 15 1/2" x 10 1/2" Block Eight rectangle. (Diagram 57)





42 Sew together one 1 1/2" x 15 1/2" Fabric F rectangle, one Unit 30 rectangle, one 2 1/2" x 15 1/2" Fabric H rectangle and one 1 1/2" x 15 1/2" Fabric K rectangle, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make one 15 1/2" x 10 1/2" Block Nine rectangle. (Diagram 58)





43. Sew one Block Four square to the top of one Block Five square. Sew the newly sewn rectangle to the left side of the Block Eight rectangle to make the top row. Sew one Block Five square to the top of one Block Three square. Sew the newly sewn rectangle to the right side of the Block Nine rectangle to make the bottom row. Sew together the two rows lengthwise to make 20 1/2" one Unit 31 square. (Diagram 59).





44. Sew one Block Seven rectangle to each side of the Unit 31 rectangle to make the 30 1/2" x 20 1/2" Center Bottom. (Diagram 60)

45. Sew together the Center Top and Center Bottom lengthwise to make the 30 1/2" x 30 1/2" Quilt Center. (Diagram 61)





Quilt Assembly:

46. Sew one 2 1/2" x 30 1/2" **Fabric J** strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew one 2 1/2" x 34 1/2" **Fabric J** strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center to make the quilt top.

Finishing:

- 47. Trim backing fabric to 42" x 42".
- 48. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing. Baste layers together.
- 49. Quilt as desired.
- 50. Trim layers even with quilt top, squaring corners.
- 51. Attach 2 1/4" **Fabric K** binding strips using your favorite method.


