Sweet Cherry - Wall Hanging

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning. WOF = width of fabric. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

- Fabric A Referring to the guilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 8-3/4" x 59" and (2) 8-3/4" x 47" multi-stripe borders
- **Fabric B** Referring to the guilt image, fussy cut (6) 4-1/2" squares with motifs centered
- Fabric C Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips, from 1 strip cut (8) 2-1/2" squares
- Fabric D Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (8) 2-1/2" squares
- Fabric E Cut (2) 4-1/2" strips, subcut (32) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces Cut (1) 3" strip, subcut (8) 3" squares
- Cut (5) 2-1/2" strips, from 4 strips cut (8) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces and (48) 2-1/2" squares
- Fabric F Cut (1) 3" strip, subcut (8) 3" squares Cut (4) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 1-1/2" x 36-1/2" and (2) 1-1/2" x 26-1/2" borders
- Fabric G Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabrics H and I - From each fabric:

Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (12) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces and (24) 2-1/2" squares

2. Piecing Order:

1. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of:



all Fabrics E, H, and I 2-1/2" squares

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

2. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side then draw 2 lines 1/4" on each side of first line on the following squares:



4. In the same manner, make 12 each Units 1b-1d with fabrics indicated.



3. Arrange a marked Fabric E 2-1/2" square

line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press the

triangle open. Repeat on remaining corner. Make a total of 12 Unit 1a (2-1/2" x 4-1/2

5. Sew a Unit 1a and 1b together as shown. Make a total of 12 Unit 2a (4-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 12 Unit 2b with units indicated.

6. Arrange a marked **Fabric E** 3" square right sides together with a Fabric F 3" square aligning all edges. Stitch along the 2 outside lines. Cut along the center line. Press the 2 triangle sets open. Centering seam, trim each to 2-1/2" square. Make a total of 16 Unit 3.

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7. Arrange 1 Fabric C 2-1/2" square, 1 Fabric D 2-1/2" square, and 2 Unit 3 in 2 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of



Unit 4 - Make 8 8 Unit 4 (4-1/2" square unfinished).

8. Stitch 1 each Fabrics C and E 2-1/2" x width of fabric (WOF) strips together lengthwise. From this, cut (16) 2-1/2" wide Unit 5 (2-1/2" x 4-1/2" unfinished).

9. Stitch 1 Unit 5 and 1 Fabric E 2-1/2" x 4-1/2 piece together as shown. Make a total of 16 Unit 6 (4-1/2" square unfinished).

10. Arrange 1 Fabric B 4-1/2" square, 4 Unit 2a, 1 Unit 4, and 3 Unit 6 in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete Block 1 (12-1/2" square unfinished).

11. In the same manner, make 1 each Blocks 2-6 with units indicated. See Blocks 3-6 layouts on Page 3.

12. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.

13. Arrange blocks in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together completing guilt center (24-1/2" x 36-1/2" unfinished).

14. Sew **Fabric F** 1-1/2" x 36-1/2" borders to right and left sides of guilt center. Add Fabric F 1-1/2" x 26-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

15. Center Fabric A 8-3/4" x 59" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and Fabric A 8-3/4" x 47" borders on top and bottom of guilt center, referring to guilt image for positioning of stripe. Stitch 1/4″ borders to sides starting detail and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. A Do not trim. Press Quilt Center borders out.

> *Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.* Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

16. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



(Fabric J) approximately 8" larger than the top.

18. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric G) and enjoy!!
