Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric **WOF** (perpendicular to selvages) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

Fabric A:

- Fussy cut eight 8 1/2" x 8 1/2" squares each centered on a block. **(Blocks)**

Fabric B:

- Cut seven 4" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end and cut two 4" x 58 1/2" strips and two 4" x 65 1/2" strips. **(Outer Border)**

Fabric C:

- Cut four 2" x WOF strips; sub-cut sixty-four 2" squares. **(Blocks)**
- Cut 1 3 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut one 3 1/2" square and eight 2" squares. **(Blocks)**

Fabric D:

- Cut one 4" x WOF strip; sub-cut two 4" squares. **(Blocks)**

Fabric E:

- Cut two 14 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut forty-eight 1 1/2" x 14 1/2" rectangles. **(Sashing)**

Fabric F:

- Cut four 2" x WOF strips; sub-cut eighty 2" squares. **(Blocks)**
- Cut seven 2 1/4" x WOF strips. **(Binding)**

Fabric G:

- Cut four 1" x WOF strips; sub-cut eight 1" x 8 1/2" rectangles and eight 1" x 9 1/2" rectangles. **(Blocks)**
- Cut two 1 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut thirty-two 1 1/2" squares. **(Cornerstones)**

Fabric H:

- Cut four 1" x WOF strips; sub-cut eight 1" x 8 1/2" rectangles and eight 1" x 9 1/2" rectangles. **(Blocks)**
- Cut two 1 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut thirty-two 1 1/2" squares. **(Cornerstones)**

Fabric I:

- Cut two 2" x WOF strip; sub-cut thirty-two 2" squares. **(Blocks)**
- Cut five 3 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut ninety-six 2" x 3 1/2" rectangles. **(Blocks)**
- Cut one 14 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut sixteen 1 1/2" x 14 1/2" rectangles and ten 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles. **(Blocks)**
- Cut two 1 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut six 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles. **(Blocks)**
- Cut two 1 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut two 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles and two 1 1/2" x 14 1/2" rectangles. **(Blocks)**
- Cut one 2" x WOF strip; sub-cut four 2" squares and eight 2" x 3 1/2" rectangles. **(Blocks)**
- Cut one 4" x WOF strip; sub-cut two 4" squares and four 3 1/2" x 5" rectangles. **(Blocks)**
- Cut three 1 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut eighty 1 1/2" squares. **(Cornerstones)**
- Cut six 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two 2 1/2" x 54 1/2" strips and two 2 1/2" x 58 1/2" strips. **(Inner Border)**

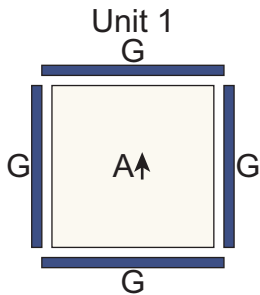
Fabric J:

- Cut one 14 1/2" x WOF; sub-cut twenty-four 1 1/2" x 14 1/2" rectangles. **(Sashing)**

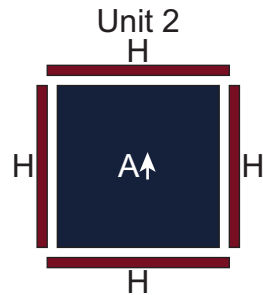
Piecing Instructions:

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations while assembling the various components.

1. Sew one 1" x 8 1/2" **Fabric G** rectangle to each side of one 8 1/2" **Fabric A** square. Sew one 1" x 9 1/2" **Fabric G** rectangle to the top and bottom of the 8 1/2" **Fabric A** square to make one 9 1/2" Unit 1 square. (Diagram 1) Repeat to make an additional three Unit 1 squares.
2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Diagram 2 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make four 9 1/2" Unit 2 squares.

3. Place one 2" **Fabric F** square on the left side of one 2" x 3 1/2" **Fabric I** rectangle, right sides together. (Diagram 3) Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. (Diagram 3) Flip open the triangle formed and press. (Diagram 4) Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.

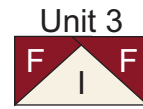

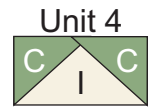
4. Place one 2" **Fabric F** square on the right side of the 2" x 3 1/2" **Fabric I** rectangle, right sides together. (Diagram 5) Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner. (Diagram 5) Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make one 2" x 3 1/2" Unit 3 rectangle. (Diagram 6)
5. Repeat Steps 3-4 to make an additional thirty-nine Unit 3 rectangles.
6. Repeat Steps 3-4 and refer to Diagram 7 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make thirty-two Unit 4 rectangles.

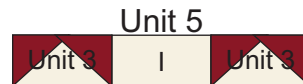

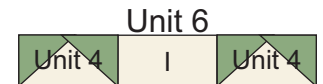


Unit 4

7. Sew one Unit 3 rectangle to each end of one 2" x 3 1/2" **Fabric I** rectangle to make one 2" x 9 1/2" Unit 5 rectangle. (Diagram 8). Repeat to make an additional fifteen Unit 5 rectangles.
8. Sew one Unit 4 rectangle to each end of one 2" x 3 1/2" **Fabric I** rectangle to make one 2" x 9 1/2" Unit 6 rectangle. (Diagram 9). Repeat to make an additional fifteen Unit 6 rectangles.

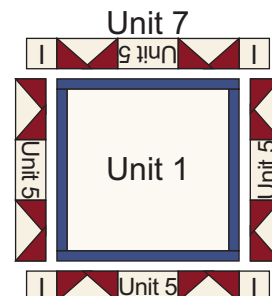

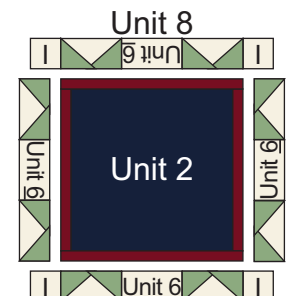

9. Sew one Unit 5 rectangle to each side of one Unit 1 square. Sew one 2" **Fabric I** square to each end of one Unit 5 rectangle. Repeat to make a second rectangle. Sew one newly sewn rectangle to the top and bottom of the Unit 1 square to make one 12 1/2" Unit 7 square. (Diagram 10) Repeat to make three additional Unit 7 squares.
10. Repeat Step 9 and refer to Diagram 11 for fabric/unit identification, placement and orientation to make four 12 1/2" Unit 8 squares.



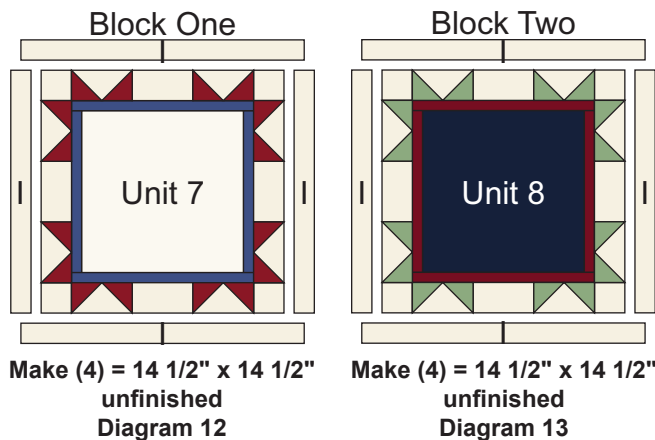

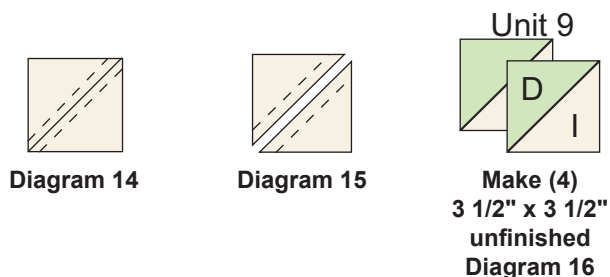

11. Sew one 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" **Fabric I** rectangle to each side of one Unit 7 square. Sew one 1 1/2" x 14 1/2" **Fabric I** rectangle to the top and bottom of the Unit 7 square to make one 14 1/2" Block One square. (Diagram 12) Repeat to make an additional three Block One squares.

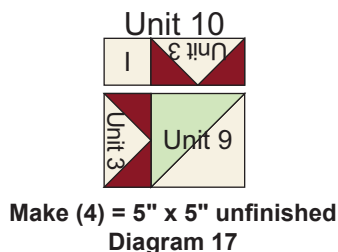
12. Repeat Step 11 and refer to Diagram 13 for fabric/unit identification, placement and orientation to make four 14 1/2" Block Two squares.



13. Place one 4" **Fabric I** square on top of one 4" **Fabric D** square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square. (Diagram 14) Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line. (Diagram 14) Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 15) to make two half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 3 1/2" to make (2) Unit 9 squares. (Diagram 16) Repeat to make an additional two Unit 9 squares.



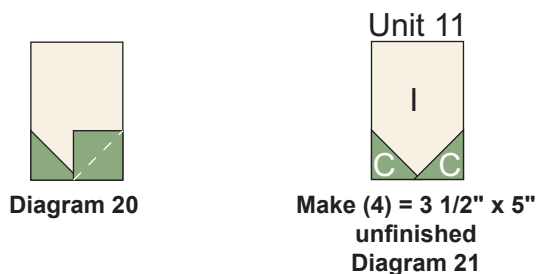
14. Sew one 2" **Fabric I** square to the left side of one Unit 3 rectangle to make the top row. Sew one Unit 3 rectangle to the left side of one Unit 9 square to make the bottom row. Sew together the two rows lengthwise to make one 5" Unit 10 square. (Diagram 17) Repeat to make an additional three Unit 10 squares.



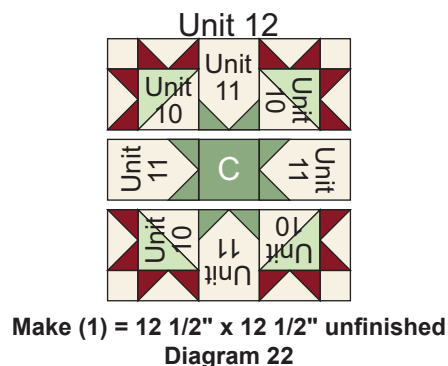
15. Place one 2" **Fabric C** square on the lower left corner of one 3 1/2" x 5" **Fabric I** rectangle, right sides together. (Diagram 18) Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner. (Diagram 18) Flip open the triangle formed and press. (Diagram 19) Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam.



16. Follow Diagram 20 for the seam direction to add a 2" **Fabric C** square to the lower right corner of the 3 1/2" x 5" **Fabric I** rectangle to make one 3 1/2" x 5" Unit 11 square. (Diagram 21) Repeat to make an additional three Unit 11 rectangle.

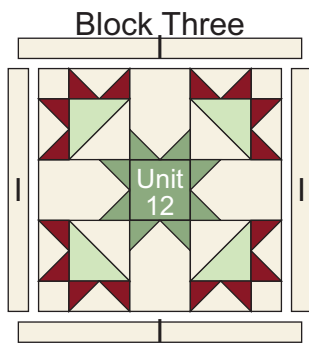


17. Sew one Unit 10 square to each side of one Unit 11 rectangle to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew one Unit 11 rectangle to each side of one 3 1/2" **Fabric C** square to make the middle row. Sew together the three rows lengthwise to make one 12 1/2" Unit 12 square. (Diagram 22)



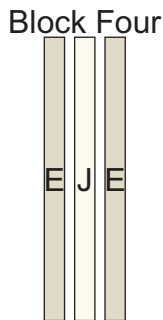
18. Sew one 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" **Fabric I** rectangle to each side of one Unit 12 square. Sew one 1 1/2" x 14 1/2" **Fabric I** rectangle to the top and bottom of the Unit 12 square to make one 14 1/2"

Block Three square. (Diagram 23)



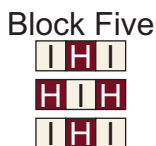

19. Sew one 1 1/2" x 14 1/2" **Fabric E** rectangle to each side of one 1 1/2" x 14 1/2" **Fabric J** rectangle to make one 3 1/2" x 14 1/2" Block Four rectangle. (Diagram 24) Repeat to make an additional twenty-three Block Four rectangles.

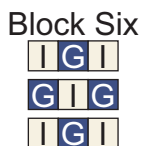

20. Sew one 1 1/2" **Fabric I** square to each side of one 1 1/2" **Fabric H** square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew one 1 1/2" **Fabric H** square to each side of one 1 1/2" **Fabric I** square to make the middle row. Sew together the three rows lengthwise to make one 3 1/2" Block Five square. (Diagram 25) Repeat to make an additional seven Block Five squares.
21. Repeat Step 20 and refer to Diagram 26 for fabric identification and placement to make eight Block Six squares.

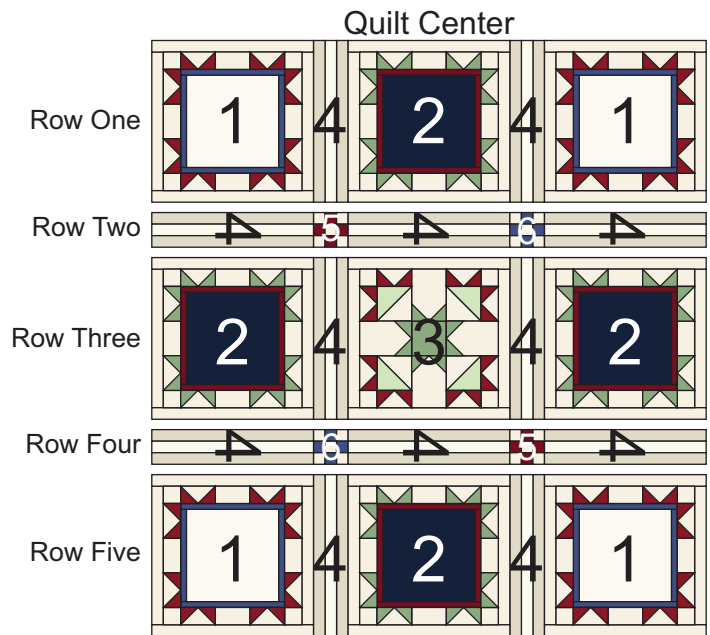

22. Sew together one Block One square, one Block Four rectangle, one Block Two square, one Block Four rectangle and one Block One square, in that order from left to right, to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Five. (Diagram 27)
23. Sew together one Block Four rectangle, one Block Five rectangle, one Block Four rectangle, one Block Six square and one Block Four rectangle, in that order from left to right, to make Row Two. (Diagram 27)
24. Sew together one Block Two square, one Block Four rectangle, one Block Three square, one Block Four rectangle and one Block Two square, in that order from left to right, to make Row Three. (Diagram 27)
25. Sew together one Block Four rectangle, one Block Six rectangle, one Block Four rectangle, one Block Five square and one Block Four rectangle, in that order from left to right, to make Row Four. (Diagram 27)
26. Sew together the five pieced Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 48 1/2" Quilt Center. (Diagram 27)

27. Sew together one Block Four rectangle, one Block Six rectangle, one Block Four rectangle, one Block Five square and one Block Four rectangle, in that order from top to bottom, to make the Left Side Border. (Diagram 28)
28. Sew together one Block Four rectangle, one

Block Five rectangle, one Block Four rectangle, one Block Six square and one Block Four rectangle, in that order from top to bottom, to make the Right Side Border. (Diagram 29)

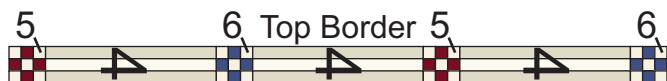

29. Sew together two Block Five squares, three Block Four rectangles and two Block Six squares as shown below to make the 3 1/2" x 54 1/2" Top Border. (Diagram 30)

30. Sew together two Block Six squares, three Block Four rectangles and two Block Five squares as shown below to make the 3 1/2" x 54 1/2" Bottom Border. (Diagram 31)



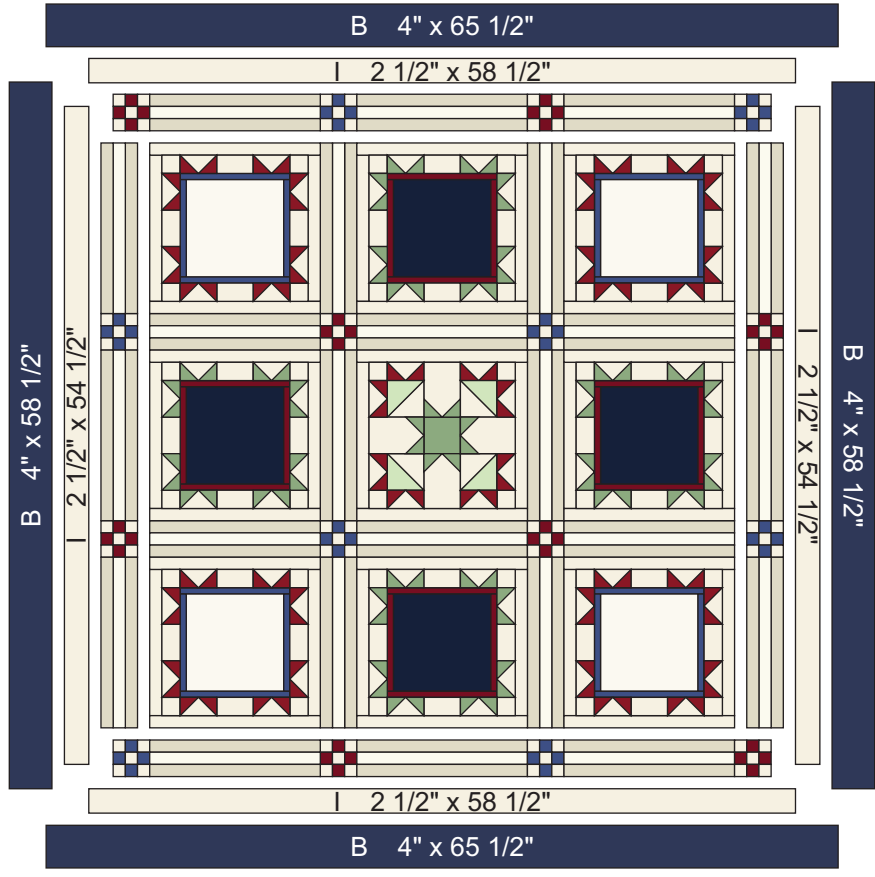

Quilt Assembly:

31. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and right sides of the Quilt Center. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Quilt Center.
32. Sew one 2 1/2" x 54 1/2" **Fabric I** strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew one 2 1/2" x 58 1/2" **Fabric I** strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center.
33. Sew one 4" x 58 1/2" **Fabric B** strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew one 4" x 65 1/2" **Fabric B** strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center to make the quilt top.

Finishing:

34. Prepare backing using two widths of fabric. Press seams open. Trim to 73" x 73".
35. Layer the quilt, batting and backing. Baste layers together.
36. Quilt as desired.
37. Trim layers even with quilt top, squaring corners.
38. Attach 2 1/4" **Fabric F** binding strips using your favorite method.

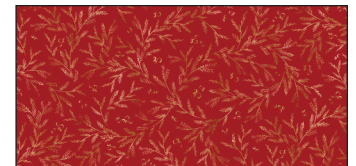

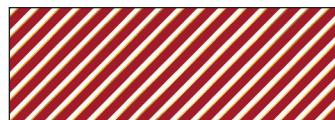

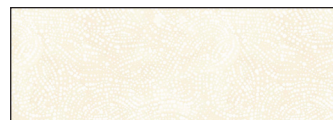
