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Woodland Snowmen

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the panel will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of panel to approximately 23-1/2" x 42"

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 8-3/4" x 49" multi-stripe borders (1 with large stripe on top, 1 with large stripe on bottom)

Fabric C - Cut (6) 9-3/4" squares

Fabric D - Cut (1) 3-5/8" strip, subcut (4) 3-5/8" squares and (1) 2-3/4" square
Cut (1) 2-3/4" strip, subcut (15) 2-3/4" squares

Fabric E - Cut (7) 3-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3-1/2" x 72-1/2" and (2) 3-1/2" x 61-1/2" borders

Fabric F - Cut (11) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 68-1/2", (2) 2-1/2" x 55-1/2", (2) 2-1/2" x 49", and (2) 2-1/2" x 45-1/2" borders

Fabric G - Cut (2) 5-3/8" strips, subcut (12) 5-3/8" squares
Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)
Cut (4) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 1-1/2" x 26" strips

Fabric H - Cut (8) 1-3/4" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 1-3/4" x 66", (2) 1-3/4" x 51-1/2", and (2) 1-3/4" x 43" borders
Cut (2) 1-3/4" strips, subcut (2) 1-3/4" x 27" borders

Fabric I - Cut (3) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (8) 2-3/4" x 5" pieces and (24) 2-3/4" squares

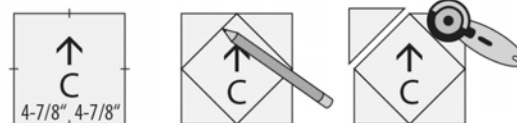
Fabric J - Cut (2) 3-1/8" strips, subcut (16) 3-1/8" squares (then cut in half diagonally for 32 triangles) and (1) 2-3/4" square

Cut (1) 2-3/4" strip, subcut (15) 2-3/4" squares

Fabric K - Cut (1) 5-3/4" strip, subcut (2) 5-3/4" squares then cut in half diagonally twice for 8 triangles

2. Piecing Order:

1. Mark the 4-7/8" center



point on all sides of a 9-3/4" **Fabric C** square as shown. Draw diagonal lines from mark to mark. Trim corners from square. Repeat for a total of 6 trimmed **C** squares (6-7/8" square unfinished).

Arrows and stripes indicate orientation of directional prints. Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

2. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of **Fabric I** 2-3/4" squares, 12 in 1 direction and 12 in the opposite direction.

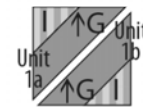


Mark 12 each direction

3. Arrange 2 marked **Fabric I** 2-3/4" squares to opposite corners of a **Fabric G** 5-3/8" square as shown. Stitch along

marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press triangles out. Cut the **Fabric G** square in half diagonally as shown creating Units 1a and 1b (5-3/8" x 5-3/8" x 7-5/8" unfinished). Repeat to make a total of 6 each Units 1a and 1b.

4. In the same manner, make 6 each Units 1c and 1d by adding marked **Fabric I** 2-3/4" squares to opposite corners of **Fabric G** 5-3/8" squares as shown.

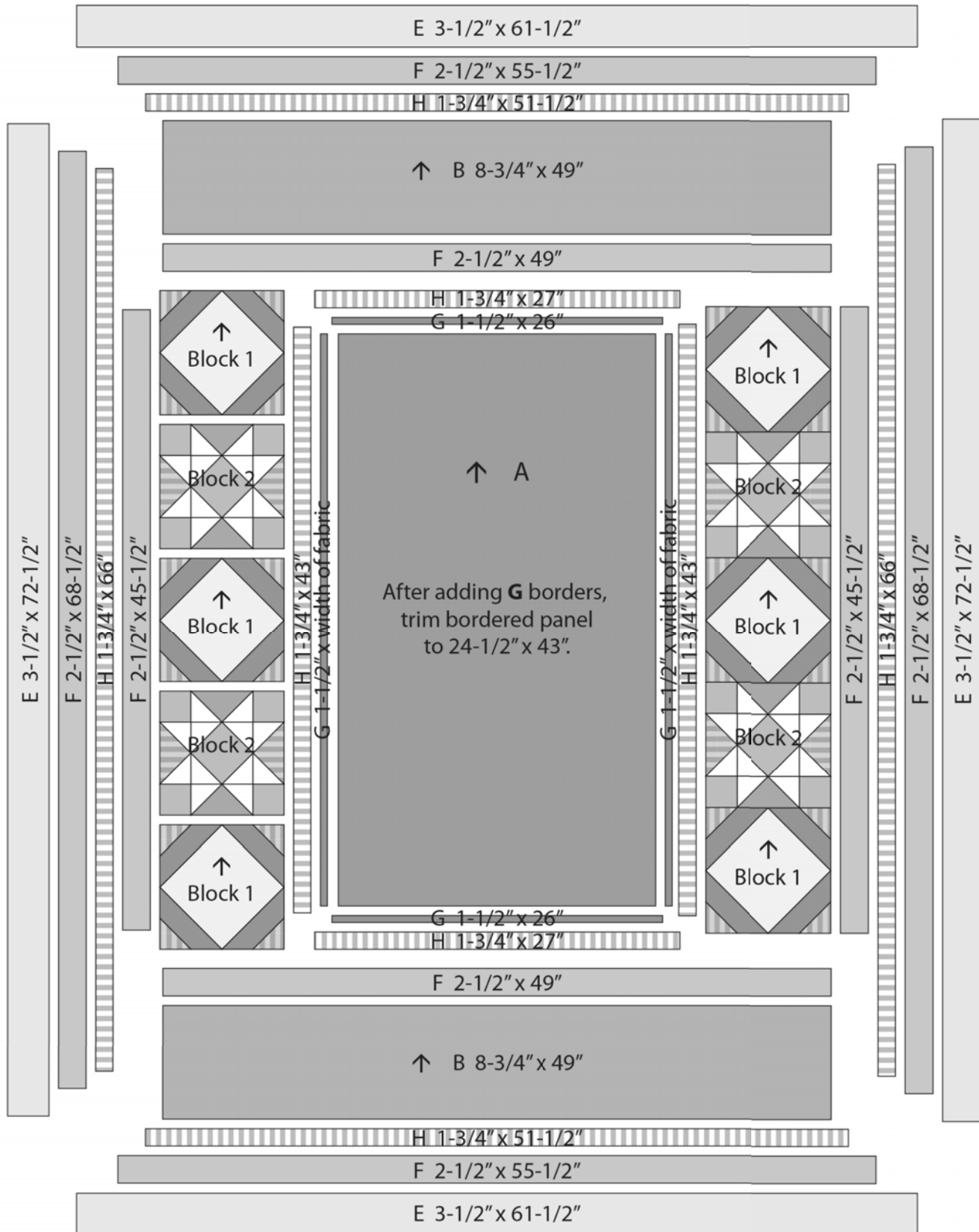

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QUILT LAYOUT

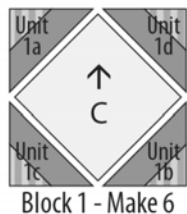
Arrows and stripes indicate orientation of directional prints.

Border measurements are the cut size.



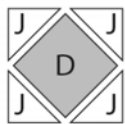
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5. Stitch 1 each Units 1a-1d on sides of a 6-7/8" **Fabric C** (Step 1) square. Make a total of 6 **Block 1** (9-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 1 - Make 6

6. Sew 4 **Fabric J** 3-1/8" triangles to sides of a **Fabric D** 3-5/8" square. Make a total of 4 Unit 2 (5" square unfinished).



Unit 2 - Make 4

7. Sew 2 **Fabric J** 3-1/8" triangles to short edges of a **Fabric K** 5-3/4" triangle. Make a total of 8 Unit 3 (2-3/4" x 5" unfinished).

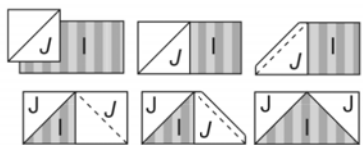


Unit 3 - Make 8

8. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of 16 **Fabric J** 2-3/4" squares.



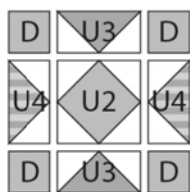
9. Arrange 1 marked **Fabric J** 2-3/4" square on end of a **Fabric I** 2-3/4" x 5" piece as shown.



Unit 4 - Make 8

Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press triangle out. Repeat on other end of **Fabric I** 2-3/4" x 5" piece. Make a total of 8 Unit 4 (2-3/4" x 5" unfinished).

10. Arrange 1 Unit 2, 2 each Units 3 and 4, and 4 **Fabric D** 2-3/4" squares in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 **Block 2** (9-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 2 - Make 4

11. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of panel, strips, blocks, and borders.

12. Stitch **Fabric G** 1-1/2" x width of fabric strips to sides of the **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-1/2" x 26" **Fabric G** strips to top and bottom of panel. *Trim bordered panel to 24-1/2" x 43" (unfinished).*

13. Sew **Fabric H** 1-3/4" x 43" borders to right and left sides of bordered panel. Add **Fabric H** 1-3/4" x 27" borders to top and bottom of bordered panel.

14. Arrange blocks in 2 vertical rows (alternating **Blocks 1** and **2**) on right and left sides of bordered panel. Stitch into vertical rows (9-1/2" x 45-1/2" unfinished). Sew rows to bordered panel completing quilt center (45" wide x 45-1/2" tall unfinished).

15. Sew **Fabric F** 2-1/2" x 45-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric F** 2-1/2" x 49" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

16. Sew **Fabric B** 8-3/4" x 49" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

17. Sew **Fabric H** 1-3/4" x 66" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric H** 1-3/4" x 51-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

18. Sew **Fabric F** 2-1/2" x 68-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric F** 2-1/2" x 55-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

19. Sew **Fabric E** 3-1/2" x 72-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric E** 3-1/2" x 61-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

20. The quilt measures approximately 61-1/2" x 78-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric L**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

21. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric G**) and enjoy!!

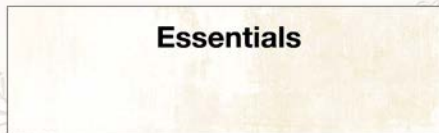

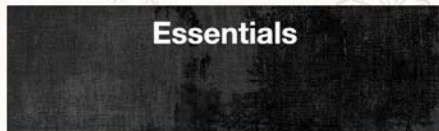
