

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus 1/4" seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately

42" wide).	
Fabric A	Cut (3) 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (10) 6 ½" x 8 ½" strips. Cut (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (10) 3 ½" x 6 ½" strips.
Fabric B	Cut (4) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (20) 3 ½" x 6 ½"

	strips.
Fabric C	Cut (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut

the strips into (10)	3½" x 5½"
strips.	

Fabric D	Cut (2) 3 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut
	the strips into (10) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ "
	strips.

Fabric E	Cut (2) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut
	the strips into (10) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Fabric F	Cut (3) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut
	the strips into (10) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ "
	strips.

Fabric G	Cut (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut
	the strips into (10) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ "
	strips.

Fabric H	Cut (2) 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut
	the strips into (10) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Fabric I	Cut (3) 3 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut
	the strips into (10) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ "
	strips.

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Fabric J	Cut (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (10) 3 ½" x 6 ½" strips. Cut (4) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ½" x 70 ½" strips. Cut (4) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ½" x 65 ½" strips.
Fabric K	Cut (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strips into (10) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
Fabric L	Cut (5) 1½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (15) 1½" x 12½" strips. Cut (6) 1½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams

and cut (4) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $51\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Cut (4) 11/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 11/2" x 64 1/2" strips.

Cut (3) 11/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 53 1/2" strips.

Cut (8) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

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Quilt Cutting Directions - Continued

Fabric M

Cut (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 66 ½" strips. Cut (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 57 ½" strips.

Backing

Cut (2) 86" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 73" x 86" backing.

Making the Quilt

Note: The arrows in diagrams represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

Quilt Top Assembly

- 1. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 5 ½" Fabric C strip to the left side of (1) 3 ½" x 5 ½" Fabric D strip lengthwise. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric B strip to the top of the newly sewn strip lengthwise. Sew (1) 6 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric A strip to the left side of the newly sewn strip to make the top row (Diagram 1).
- 2. Sew (1) 4 ½" Fabric E square to the left end of (1) 4 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric F strip to make the bottom row (Diagram 1).
- **3.** Sew together the (2) rows from Steps 1-2 lengthwise to make (1) 12 ½" Block One square (Diagram 1).
- 4. Repeat Steps 1-3 to make (10) Block One squares total.




5. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric G strip to the top of (1) 3 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric B strip to make the left column (Diagram 2).


- **6.** Sew together (1) 6 ½" Fabric H square, (1) 3 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric A strip and (1) 3 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric J strip, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make the middle column (Diagram 2).
- 7. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 9 ½" Fabric I strip to the top of (1) 3 ½" Fabric K square to make the right column (Diagram 2).
- 8. Sew together the (3) columns from Steps 5-7 lengthwise to make (1) 12 ½" Block Two square (Diagram 2).
- **9.** Repeat Steps 5-8 to make (10) Block Two squares total.



10. Refer to Diagram 3 and sew together (2) Block One squares, (3) 1½" x 12½" Fabric L strips and (2) Block Two squares to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three and Row Five.

- **11.** Refer to Diagram 3 and sew together (2) Block Two squares, (3) 1½" x 12½" Fabric L strips and (2) Block One squares to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Four.
- **12.** Sew together the (5) Rows in numerical order and (4) 1 ½" x 51 ½" Fabric L strips, lengthwise and alternating them from top to bottom, to make the 51 ½" x 64 ½" Center Block (Diagram 3).

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
Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)

- **13.** Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $64\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric L strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $53\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric L strip to the top and bottom of the Center Block.
- **14.** Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $66\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric M strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $57\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric M strip to the top and bottom of the Center Block.
- **15.** Sew (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 65 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J strip to the top and bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

Finishing the Quilt


- 16. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 17. Sew the (8) Fabric L binding strips together, end to end with a 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 18. Bind as desired.
