

С		54740-1 Cream	1	(8) 3-1/2" × WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 3-1/2" x 66-1/2" and (2) 3-1/2" x 72-1/2" strips for Inner Border 3.

Subcut (234) 2" squares.

STAR BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. HALF-SQUARE TRIANGLES: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) **E** 2" square. Place square, right sides together, on (1) **G** 2" square. Sew 1/4" away on the right and left sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield (2) HST units. Open and press. Trim **EG** HST units to 1-1/2" square. Make (18) **EG** HST units.












Sew 1/4" away from both sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line.


Yields (2) EG HSTs. Square units to 1-1/2"

- **2.** Arrange and sew together (3) **EG** HST units and (3) 1-7/8" **E** triangles into three rows to make a pieced triangle, as shown. *Note orientation and placement of HST units and triangles.* Make (78) **EG** Pieced Triangles.
- **3.** Layer (1) **G** 3-7/8" triangle right sides together on (1) **EG** Pieced Triangle and sew along the long edge. Press open and trim to 3-1/2" square. Make (78) **G-EG** squares.
- **4.** Sew (1) **G** 3-1/2" square to left side of (1) **G-EG** square to make (1) G-EG unit. Make (26). Note rotation of **G-EG** squares.











5. Repeat steps 1-4 to make (78) **G-BG** Squares and (26) **G-BG** Units, as shown in diagrams. Note proper placement and rotation of units.










6. BLOCK ONE: Arrange and sew (4) rows as shown to complete Block One. Square block to 12-1/2". Make (13) Block Ones.






MAKE (13)

DIAMOND IN SQUARE:


- 7. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) **G** 6-1/2" and **D** 3-7/8" square. Place **G** square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) **A** 12-1/2" square. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **G** corner.
- **8.** Similar to **AG** corner assembly, sew **D** 3-7/8" square to **AG** corner as shown.
- **9. BLOCK TWO:** Repeat steps 7 and 8 to complete remaining corners. Square block to 12-1/2". Make (12) Block Twos.





QUILT ASSEMBLY

- **10. ROW ASSEMBLY:** Arrange and sew (5) blocks into (5) rows as shown. Note proper placement of blocks.
- **11.** Sew rows together to complete quilt center.



BORDER ASSEMBLY

- **12. INNER BORDER 1:** Sew (1) **G** 2-1/2" \times 60-1/2" strip to each side of quilt center. Sew (1) **G** 2-1/2" \times 64-1/2" strip to the top and bottom of quilt center.
- **13. INNER BORDER 2:** Sew (1) **F** 1-1/2" \times 64-1/2" strip to each side of quilt center. Sew (1) **F** 1-1/2" \times 66-1/2" strip to the top and bottom of quilt center.



14. INNER BORDER 3: Sew (1) \mathbb{C} 3-1/2" x 66-1/2" strip to each side of quilt center. Sew (1) \mathbb{C} 3-1/2" x 72-1/2" strip to the top and bottom of quilt center.

15. OUTER BORDER: Sew (1) **B** $4" \times 72-1/2"$ strip to each side of quilt center.

Sew (1) **B** $4" \times 79-1/2"$ strip to the top and bottom of quilt center.



FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **E** 2-1/4" strips.
