Fabric Requirements

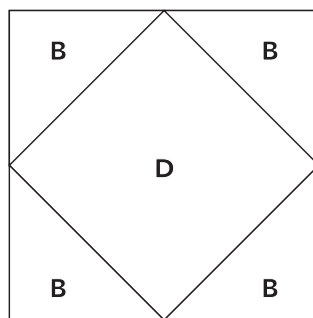
Fabric 1	MAS8119-EB	1 5/8 yards
Fabric 2	MAS8119-ER	1 5/8 yards
Fabric 3	MAS8119-N	3/4 yard
Fabric 4	MAS609-R2	3/4 yard
Fabric 5	MAS8119-B3	1/2 yard*
Fabric 6	MAS609-BN	1/2 yard*
Fabric 7	MAS609-O5	1/2 yard*
Fabric 8	MAS8119-R3	1/2 yard*
Fabric 9 Binding	MAS610-N4	1/2 yard
Backing	your choice	4 yards

*Note: Fabrics 5, 6, 7, and 8 require exactly 18" of fabric. We recommend getting 5/8 of a yard if you plan to prewash or if you prefer a little extra fabric.

WOF - Width of Fabric
 LOF - Length of Fabric
 RST - Right Sides Together
 HST - Half Square Triangle

Cutting

60" x 72" finished

Fabrics 1 and 2

From each cut (4) 6-1/2" x WOF strips into:
 A (20) 6-1/2" squares

From each cut (4) 7" x WOF strips into:
 B (20) 7" squares. Cut 1x on the diagonal

Fabrics 3, 4

From each cut (2) 12-1/2" x WOF strips into:
 C: (10) 6-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles

Fabrics 5, 6, 7, 8

From each cut
 D (5) 9" squares

Fabric 8 Binding

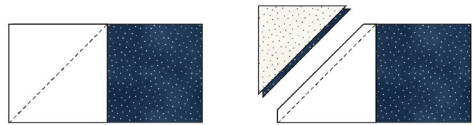
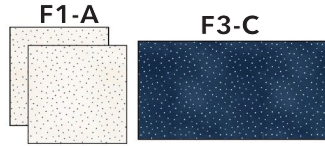
Cut (7) strips 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Geese in the Square Instructions

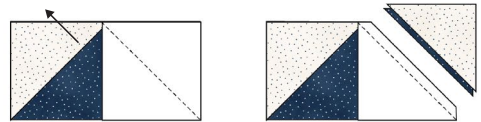
Please read all instructions before you begin. Seam allowance is 1/4".
Fabric is abbreviated as 'F' and by number. For example, Fabric 1 is 'F1'.

Flying Geese Units

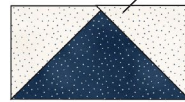
1. Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the F1-A squares.
2. Place an A square, RST over a F2-C rectangle. Sew on the marked line.
3. Cut 1/4" away from the sewn line. Press towards F1.
4. Repeat steps 2-3 on the opposite corner. Trim to finish at 6-1/2" x 12-1/2". Make 5.
5. Repeat Steps 1-4 using F2-A squares and F4-C rectangles. Make 5.



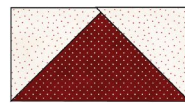

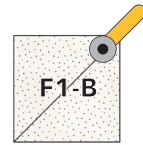

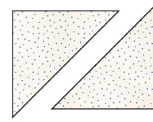

Square in a Square blocks

1. Cut the F1-B squares once on the diagonal.

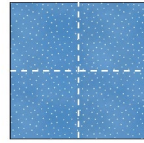


TIP: For the next steps, mark the centers of the D squares to line up the point of each B triangle.

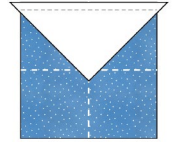


Step 1

2. Sew a F1-B triangle to the top of each F5-D square. Press away from center.



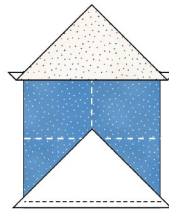

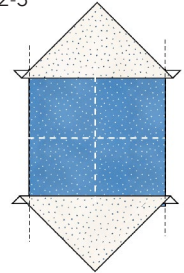
3. Sew an F1-B triangle to the bottom of each step 2 unit. Trim the overhang even with the edge of the center square.

Steps 2-3

4. Sew an F1-B triangle to the right side of each step 3 unit. Press away from center.



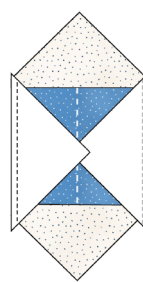
5. Sew an F1-B triangle to the left side of each step 4 unit. Press away from center.



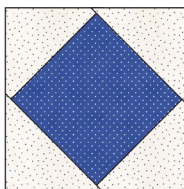
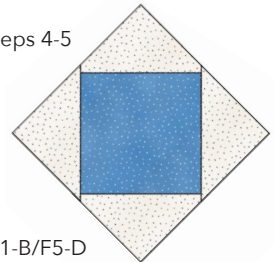
6. Trim to 12-1/2" square. Make sure there is a 1/4" seam allowance around the center square at the corners. Make 5.

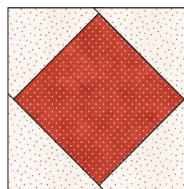
7. Make a total of 5 blocks in each combination shown below.



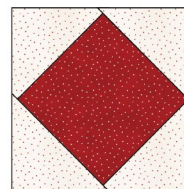
F1-B/F5-D

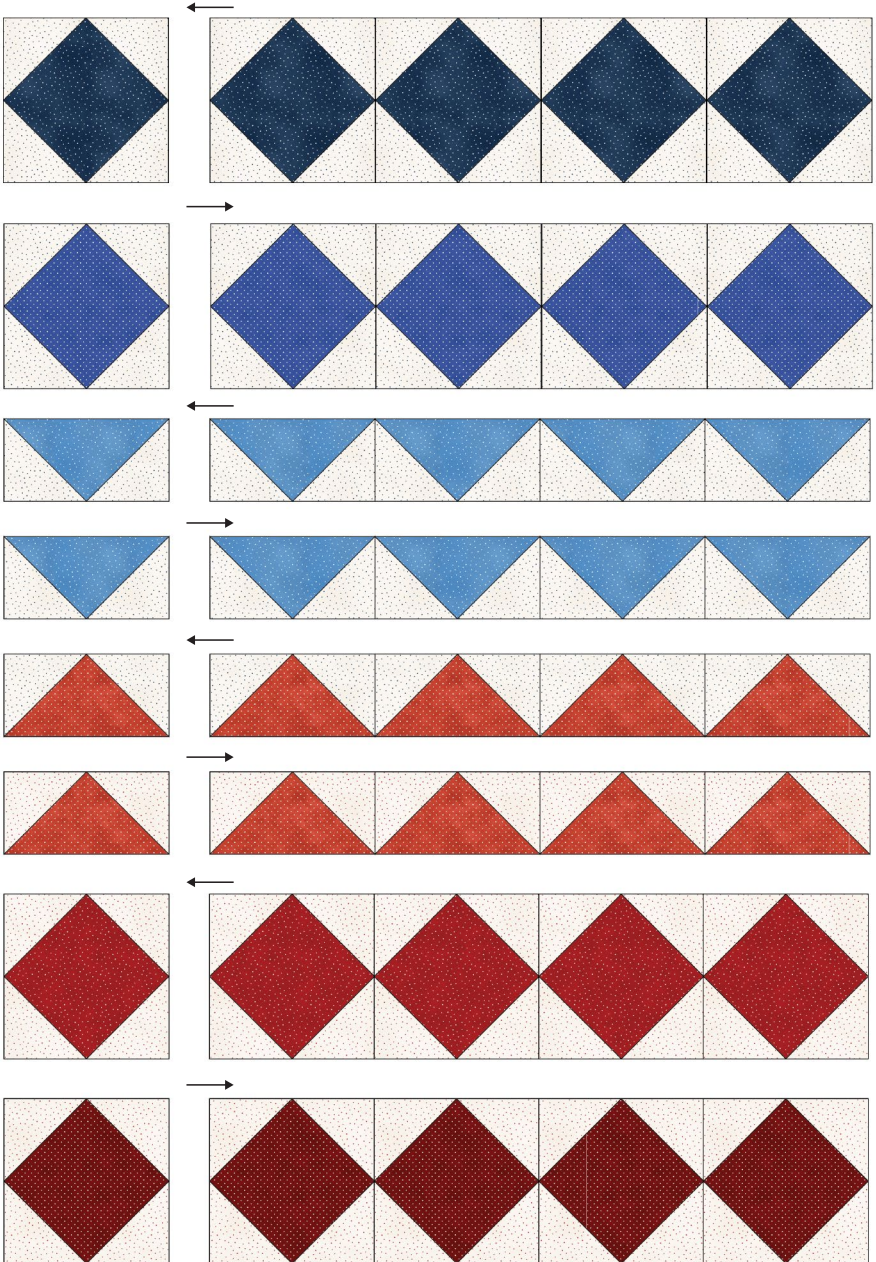

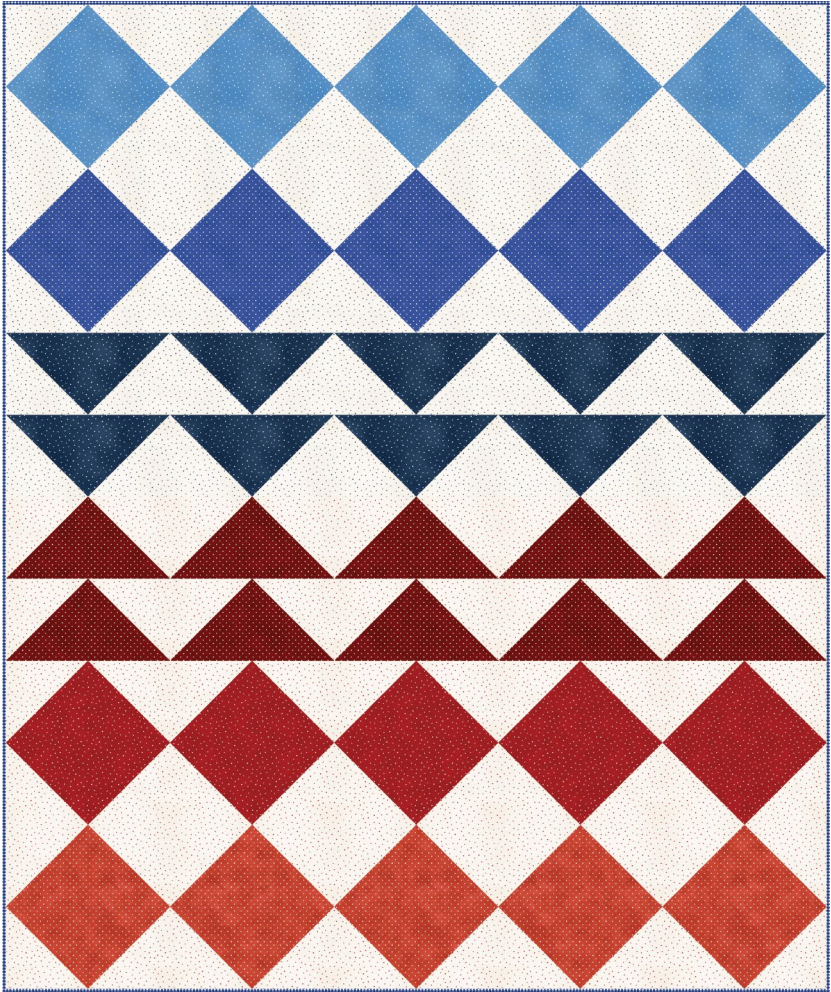

Quilt Top and Finishing

1. Sew the blocks together into rows as illustrated below. Press each row in opposite directions to nest.
2. Sew row to row. Press seams open.



3. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting and quilt top (right side up). Baste layers to secure. Quilt as desired. Trim the excess backing and batting.



4. Sew the binding strips together into one continuous strip. Press in half length-wise. Sew the binding to the quilt top with a 1/4" seam allowance. Turn the binding to the back side of the quilt and stitch down by hand with matching thread.
