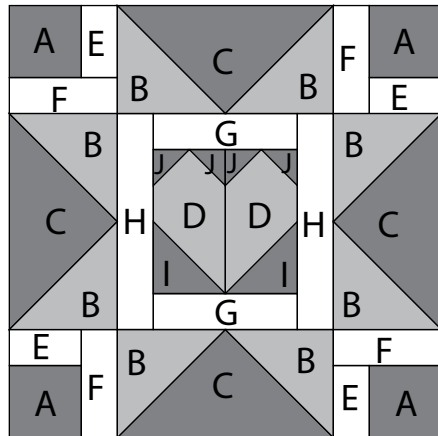


BH4 Block 25 - Heart

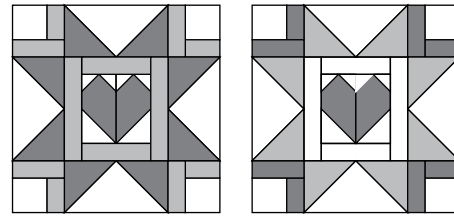

Cutting Instructions:

9" Finished Block:

- A - (4) squares - 2" x 2"
- B - (4) squares - 3 1/8" x 3 1/8"
- C - (1) square - 5 3/4" x 5 3/4"
- D - (2) rectangles - 2" x 3 1/2"
- E - (4) rectangles - 1 1/4" x 2"
- F - (4) rectangles - 1 1/4" x 2 3/4"
- G - (2) rectangles - 1 1/4" x 3 1/2"
- H - (2) rectangles - 1 1/4" x 5"
- I - (2) squares - 2" x 2"
- J - (4) squares - 1 1/4" x 1 1/4"



Color/shading options.

Piecing & Cutting Notes:

- This block uses connector/flip-and-sew corners for the I and J triangles.

4 1/2" Finished Block:

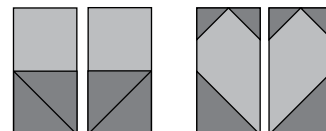
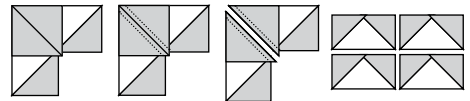
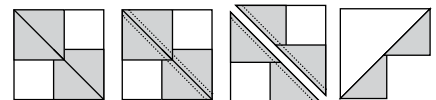
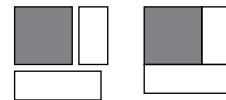
- A - (4) squares - 1 1/4" x 1 1/4"
- B - (4) squares - 2" x 2"
- C - (1) square - 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"
- D - (2) rectangles - 1 1/4" x 2"
- E - (4) rectangles - 7/8" x 1 1/4"
- F - (4) rectangles - 7/8" x 1 5/8"
- G - (2) rectangles - 7/8" x 2"
- H - (2) rectangles - 7/8" x 2 3/4"
- I - (2) squares - 1 1/4" x 1 1/4"
- J - (4) squares - 7/8" x 7/8"

All seams are a scant 1/4" unless specified otherwise.

Assembly

1. Select (1) A square, (1) E rectangle, and (1) F rectangle. Join the pieces as shown. Press the seams to the rectangles. Repeat to make 4.
2. Using the (4) B squares and the C square, make the flying geese units per the instructions on the General Techniques.

The geese will measure 2 3/4" x 5" or 1 5/8" x 2 3/4".
3. On the wrong side of the I and J squares, draw a line from one corner to the opposing corner - or use Diagonal Seam Tape as a guide.
4. With right sides together, align the D squares in the corners of the A squares as shown. Stitch on the line. Trim seam to 1/4" and press the seam to the triangle.

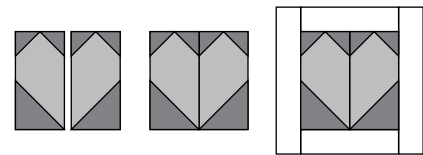


Repeat for (4) J squares at the top.

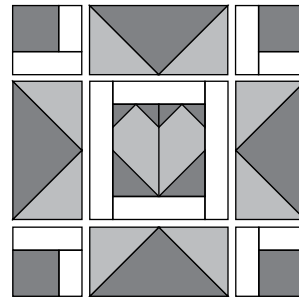

5. Join the two halves of the heart. Press the seam to one side - or press it open.

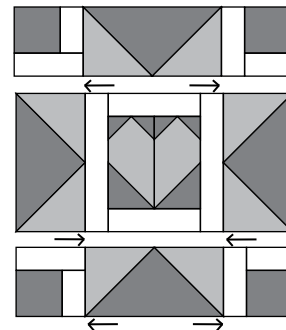


Join the G and H rectangles to the sides of the heart as shown. Press the seams to the outer rectangles - or press them open

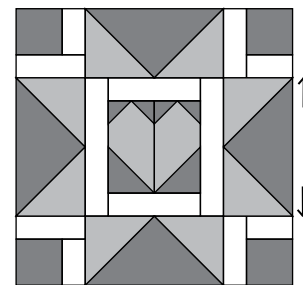
6. Lay the pieces out as shown.



7. Join the units to make three rows. Press the seams in the direction of the arrows - or press them open.



8. Join the rows to complete the block. Press the seams in the direction of the arrows - or press them open.



- 9" block - block will measure 9½" x 9½"
- 4½" block - block will measure 5" x 5"
