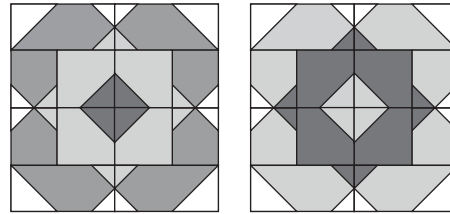
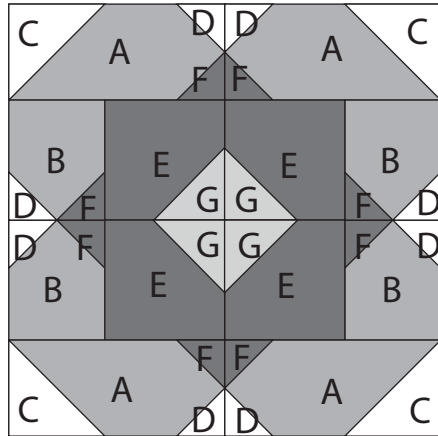


BH4 Block 28 - Blossom

Color/shading options.

Piecing & Cutting Notes:

- This block uses connector/flip-and-sew corners for the C - D - F - G triangles.

Cutting Instructions:

9" Finished Block:

- A - (4) rectangles - 2½" x 5"
- B - (4) rectangles - 2½" x 3"
- C - (4) squares - 2½" x 2½"
- D - (8) squares - 1½" x 1½"
- E - (4) squares - 3" x 3"
- F - (8) squares - 1½" x 1½"
- G - (4) squares - 2" x 2"

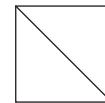
4½" Finished Block:

- A - (4) rectangles - 1½" x 2¾"
- B - (4) rectangles - 1½" x 1¾"
- C - (4) squares - 1½" x 1½"
- D - (8) squares - 1" x 1"
- E - (4) squares - 1¾" x 1¾"
- F - (8) squares - 1" x 1"
- G - (4) squares - 1¼" x 1¼"

All seams are a scant ¼" unless specified otherwise.

Assembly

- On the wrong side of the C - D - F - G squares, draw a line from one corner to the opposing corner.
 - Or use Diagonal Seam Tape as a guide.



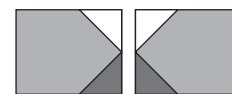
- With right sides together, align the C squares in the corners of the A rectangles as shown. Stitch on the line. Trim seam to ¼" and press the seam to the triangle.



Repeat with the D and F squares for the opposing corners - note the placement of the squares. Make 2 of each.



- Using the B rectangles and the D - F squares, join the D - F squares to the B rectangles as shown. Press the seams to the triangles. Make four units as shown - two of each.



- Using the E and G squares, join one G square to one corner of each E square as shown. Trim and press to the triangle.

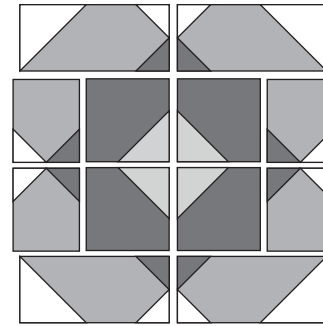

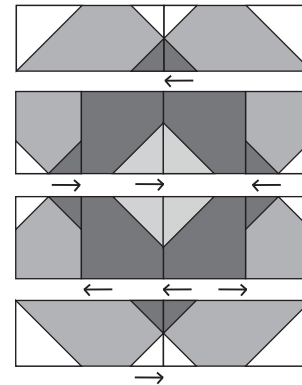

5. Lay out the units as shown.



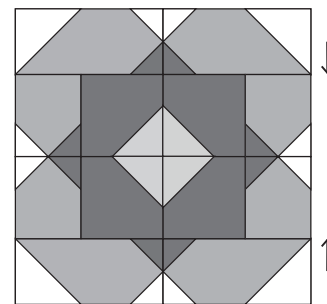
6. Join the units to make four rows. Press the seams in the direction of the arrows - or press them open.

Optional: When joining the pieces, flip some of the seams on the small triangles so they are abutting each other instead of going in the same direction.



7. Join the rows to complete the block. Press the seams in the direction of the arrows - or press them open.

- 9" block - block will measure 9½" x 9½".
- 4½" block - block will measure 5" x 5".



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Stitching with Joanna...

- The quilting tip I wish I'd learned when I first started is... find your quilting friends early! They will be the only ones that understand your obsession
- My best advice to new quilters is to... two things at the same time. #1- Relax, this is supposed to be fun. #2- Learn to sew an accurate ¼" seam allowance and your entire quilting journey will be a better experience!
- When it comes to quilting/sewing tools, don't get between me and my... Little House Pins!
- Don't tell anyone, but when I'm sewing, I don't worry about... sewing over pins. I know you guys are going to yell at me!
